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PREFACE:

The late Dr. Alden G. Beaman had a dream of making genealogical research in Rhode Island more assessable. At great personal sacrifice, he published 25 volumes of genealogical resource materials. Before his death, he requested that his family continue these publication and specifically to publish an index to all the wills in Rhode Island from 1636 to 1850 as published in the Rhode Island Genealogical Register (RIGR). We are pleased to honor his wishes and make this volume available to Rhode Island researchers. This volume took over twenty years to compile in this manner. There are over 12,000 wills and probate records indexed in this volume which includes all the wills in Rhode Island from the beginning of Rhode Island in 1636 to 1850.

The will index is set up alphabetically using the following format.

The first column (left) is the testator(rix)'s name. The next column is the year the will was written [in a few cases where the will date is not known, the year the will was proved is given]. The next column is the city/town of the probate record (see below for abbreviations of towns) (except in volumes 13 and 14 this is the town of residence of the testator). The last column is the reference to the RIGR stating the volume and page the abstract of the will is found. In a very few cases probate records other than wills were indexed. These records have the letters "pr" following the year.

For example: the first will written in Rhode Island (that we located) was that of Anthony Paine who wrote his will on 5 May 1649 in Portsmouth. The abstract is found in RIGR volume 2 on page 161. It is listed as follows:

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It is interesting to note that the first will written by a woman in the State of Rhode Island was that of Alice Couland, wife of Ralph Couland. She wrote her will on 9 month 1664 in Portsmouth. Her will is located in RIGR 2:162. Following is the first couple that wrote wills: Zachary Rhodes, Sr and Joanna Roades (Rhodes). His will was dated 28 Apr 1662 and is in RIGR 11:62; hers was dated 9 Nov 1666 and is in RIGR 10:45. They were both of Providence.

Variant spellings have been consolidated under what the author considers to be the most commonly used spelling for volumes one, two, and five through eleven. In volumes three, four, twelve and thereafter, with the assistance of a computer, we have each name as it is spelt.

Following is a listing of where abstracted Rhode Island town records can be found in the RIGR, volumes 1-15. If one is interested in the records from a certain town during a certain time frame, one merely has to look up the town and the type of record in this listing to see if these records have been abstracted in the RIGR. The RIGR volume and number are given in each case, with the number in parentheses. For example, if one is looking for a Barrington will proved about 1830 one should look in RIGR volume 4, number 1. This is for volumes 1-9 which are in quarterly form. Volumes 10-15 are annuals; therefore, only the volume is listed. All wills in Rhode Island have been abstracted to the year 1850 in volumes 1-15.
