Lilley, Dexter M., was born in the town of Richland September 28, 1865. The great-grandfather...Abner Lilley was one of three brothers that came from Scotland to this country. He settled in Cambridge, Connecticut, and in 1777, March 8, married Sibble Hale. To them three children were born, Olive, Phineas and Abner. He was a soldier in the great struggle for Liberty in the Revolutionary war and was killed near its close. Phineas Lilley, the grandfather, was born at Cambridge, Connecticut, November 29, 1779. He married Amy Sampson November 1, 1802, and settled in the town of Sandy Creek. He was a farmer and carpenter, also a member of the Presbyterian Church. Their children were Cynthia, Abner, Levi, Oren, Dyanthia, Alfred, Emily, Olive and Mary. He was a soldier in the war of 1812, and died February 2, 1855, in the town of Richland at the age of eighty-seven years....
