& her name was Celestia Swift & she

died within a few years. I was not at

her funeral but knew of it at the

time. He had no children by this second

wife but had two by the first wife

After the death of his second

wife he married a girl by the name

of Lydia Ann Sutton whom I have

known for a number of years and

I personally know that she had never

been married up to that time. She was

quite young at the time of her

marriage to Parnallee. She had one

child by him & girl. They lived together

as man & wife until seven or eight

years ago when we left Hudson Mich.

I never heard of there being any divorce

between them or there had been. I think I

would be known of it being a relative

Mr Parnallee was what I would call

a perfect wreck. He died shortly after his

discharge from the army. I think within

a couple of years after he came from the

army he had a severe sick spell - he always

claimed was result of his army life & he

was always a wreck after war. I do not think

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he was ever able to work after that spell
 & always walked with a cane & had a hard
 time to get along. He acted like a man with
 paralysis. For several months after this
 bad sick spell he could not speak very well.
 I also know that he left his property
 & she had no property as long as I lived there.
 She was not able to work at home & did not
 know how to learn much and they both had
 work done along as that & probably knew
 they had nothing except the little of what
 she had nothing that I ever knew of
