

Franch of the Descendants of John

Porter of Windsor, Conn.

In Andrews': "The Descendants of John Porter, of Windsor, Conn.", Elkanah⁶ Porter (#1306) is listed as a son of Lieut. John⁵ (A453) of Lebanon, Conn. (Samuel⁴; James³; John²; John¹). This reference contains no further reference to Elkanah and his descendants, despite the fact that he had a large family, and lived for many years on the family homestead in Lebanon.

Amos⁷ Porter, youngest son of Elkanah⁶, was born in Lebanon (now Columbia), Conn., May 17, 1738. He married Mary Gary, also of Lebanon, in November, 1814. In 1836, he removed with his family to Parre, Orleans County, N.Y., where he died Oct. 10, 1866.

In 1860, Amos Porter wrote the account which follows, disclosing information hitherto unpublished regarding this branch of the Porter family. Except for the first sentence, which recounts an inaccurate ~~xxxxx~~ tradition regarding the origin of the family, the statements made appear reliable; many of them have been checked from other references, as will be seen from the notes which follow:

"An Account of the Origin of the Porter Family
by Amos Porter
Made for Luther¹ Porter in April, 1860

"My Greate Grandfather Thomas Porter came from England about 1665 and located at Taunton Mass. He had four sons viz Thomas, John, Joseph, and Simeon. My Grand Father came to Lebanon Conn. about 1710. Thomas and Joseph lived a few years in that town. Some three or four years after my Grand Father married Abigal Knapp of Salem, Mass. They had a large family of children viz John, Abigal, Simeon, Abiah, Elkanah, Hannah, Stephen, Abraham. John and Simeon located in Cornwallis Nova Scotia². Abigal lived to be 71 yr old - was never married. Hannah and Stephen died young. My Grand Father died in 1761. My father was born in 1737³. He married Hepzibah Allen in 1763. They had a large family viz Lovina born 1764, John in 1765, Lovisa⁴ in 1766, Sarah in '68, Asa in '71, Joshua⁵ in '74, Simeon in '76, Stephen⁶ in '78. In 1778 my father's wife died --- He afterwards married Anna Talcott of Bolton Conn. They had three children viz Jesse March 1736 - Amos May 1783 and Anna 1790 --- My G. Father lived till his death on the farm he bough in Lebanon -- My father lived on a part of the farm and died there. I lived on said land until 1836 - then I sold it and came to Parre Orleans Co. NY. to live. Uncle Abraham Porter lived and died on some of the farm that Grand Father bought. His son Dan Porter now lives on the farm. He has sold it to his son-in-law Mr. Rockwell and is to live with him the rest of his life, He being 76 years old. Abiah married Dan Carpenter of Coventry Conn.⁷ he sold his farm in Coventry and bought in Lebanon, conn. and there he died. She was near 90 years old. My father was 80 yrs old. Abraham was 59, Brother John 85, Sister Lovisa 87, Sister Sarah 85, Bro Asa 40. Bro Simeon 34. Bro Joshua 77. Bro Jesse 19.

My Grand Father and Great Grandfather were Tanners and Shoe makers by trade -- so were brothers John and Simeon. Two of Bro. John's

PART 4. Eliza's Maternal Line, PORTER and BRADSTREET

Eliza's mother was MARY VINCENT PORTER, born in 1812 in Lower Salem, Ohio, the seventh Porter generation in this country, descended from many prominent people in the Massachusetts Bay Company, including governors, ministers, military leaders, America's first woman poet, and the ancestors of United States presidents, generals, writers and judges.

Mary Vincent Porter's grandfather, Amos Porter of Danvers, Massachusetts fought at Concord in 1775 and for his military service was awarded land in Ohio, where he was one of the first pioneers, and where Mary was born.

Chapter 1, THE PORTER FAMILY of EARLY SALEM

THE PORTER FAMILY BACKGROUND

The name Porter is believed to have been given to this family in the time of William the Conqueror. WILLIAM de la GRANDE came over with William the Conqueror and was given land at Kenilworth, England. His son RALPH, (or Roger) le PORTEUR was Grand Porteur (similar to the present Lord Chamberlain of the Court of St. James) to King Henry I of England from 1120 to 1140. We do not have any line of descent from Ralph le Porteur; the next Porter we pick up is our emigrant to America, JOHN PORTER, born in Dorset, England about 1596. He would have been the 16th generation from Ralph le Porteur.

FIRST PORTER GENERATION IN AMERICA

JOHN PORTER of Salem, Mass. 1596-1676

JOHN PORTER was born about 1596 in Dorset, England. As a boy he played with a young neighbor, John Endicott, which no doubt influenced his whole life, as Endicott grew up to be one of the pioneers of the Massachusetts Bay Company, and governor in the Salem area in its early days. John Porter's wife, MARY ENDICOTT, may have been Endicott's sister.

England had been in turmoil for a long time, and the religious situation made it really intolerable. Henry VIII defied the Pope and declared the church was now The Church of England. His daughter Queen Mary went back to Catholicism; then Queen Elizabeth back to the Church of England. In the meantime on the continent Martin Luther started the Protestant Reformation. First one group and then another was persecuted for its beliefs.

Also in England there was overpopulation and the cost of living was high. The spirit of adventure was in the air, with the discoveries in the New World and the tales of plundering on the high seas. But England and Spain made an agreement to stop the plundering Spanish ships, so part of that adventure was over.

Then in 1607 a group of Englishmen set up a colony in Virginia, and in 1620 the Pilgrims came to settle in Plymouth, and the emigration was under way.

Between 1630 and 1640, 100,000 Englishmen emigrated--to Ireland, Bermuda, the Barbadoes--26,000 to New England; nearly four times that number to the West Indies.

The Mayflower Pilgrims, "Separatists," had entirely separated from the Church of England. But a large group of more loyal people in England wanted, instead, to "purify" the established church, which they felt had become a little unholy. Christmas, for instance, had become a riotous celebra-

tion, hardly recognizable as religious. These "Puritans" were sorely tried for their beliefs, and a movement started to set up their own colony in New England. They formed the Massachusetts Bay Company, and took some time to plan their settlement.

Thus when the Massachusetts Bay Company came to America in 1630 they were pretty well organized. They were merchants, ministers, men of every craft, including many who were well educated and with good estates. They sent a company of men in 1628 under John Endicott to prepare their settlement for them, and he took along enough extra clothing, bedding, etc. for 100 men. They landed at Naumkeag, which they called Salem, and started to tame the wilderness.

Two years later, in the spring of 1630, Gov. John Winthrop brought a fleet of 17 ships and 1000 people, landing his flagship "Arbella" in Salem June 12, but the situation was bad. Eighty had died in the last winter, many were sick and there wasn't enough corn and bread. He took his ships on, to settle in the Boston area.

There the water supply was poor, so they scattered to set up several nearby towns. The first two years were hard--Pastor Higginson and Gov. Dudley wrote that people were dying--the breaking up of virgin soil always brought on malaria and fever. Some died of "Scirvy," the cold in winter with insufficient heat or warm clothing and bedding, and the heat in summer.

By the third year most of the tents and dugouts and caves had been replaced by real houses, there was plenty of food and things were going well.

Everyone had ample land, and the leaders had large acreage--Winthrop 1800 acres, Dudley 1700, and Saltonstall 1600.

By the time John Porter came, he had some choice. He sailed March 20, 1635 on the "Susan and Ellen" with his wife Mary, son John, and his boss Ed Thoughagood (he was deputy clerk to Thoughagood).

They settled first in Hingham, in 1635, where he was a proprietor, deputy, constable and town officer. Four more boys were born to them there. He was said to be one of the six men from Hingham who served in the Pequot War in 1637 under Endicott. His land was said to be that occupied in 1895 by the Hingham Agricultural and Horticultural Society on East Street.

In 1643 he sailed up to Salem, and in the part now Danvers bought 300 acres from Elder Sharpe. He paid £ 50 sterling on May 20, 1643, the date of the transfer, & 30 the third month 1644 (may have

been May or June, as in those days the year ended March 25) and £30 the first day of the third month 1645. In 1650 he bought 500 acres, the farm of Emanuel Downing (whose father was Sir George Downing for whom Downing Street in London was named). He gave this as a marriage portion to son JOSEPH and son JOSEPH II left it (plus a negro boy) to his son JOSEPH II. On this was built the "Porter-Bradstreet" house, the last building in Danvers near the Topsfield line. This was the home from which Amos Porter left with the Ohio Company, to settle the new territory, in 1788.

Eventually John became the largest landowner and richest man in the area, owning most of what is now the town of Danvers. His estate when he died in 1676 was over £2600. The land included parts of Salem, Wenham, Topsfield and Beverly.

He went back to Hingham to get his family for the move to Danvers. The Salem Daily Gazette for July 17, 1895, reporting on a large Porter Family gathering in Danvers, tells that this meeting held in the Unitarian Church, was close to the very point of land on which John Porter is supposed to have landed, on the present little brook formerly the Porter River, running into the Naumkeag (Nahum Keike, a Hebrew name meaning "the bosom of consolation") for which Salem was first named.

Here he built his home, which held his descendants for 200 years until it burned Sep. 19, 1865.

The house was typical for its day, two stories in front, slanting in the back as a lean-to, to one story in the rear. It faced due south with the door in the center, marking the noonday sun. Up through the center ran the chimney, providing fireplaces for the rooms on each side in both stories. Downstairs there were two large rooms, each with two windows looking down to the sea. Back of these were bedrooms, and back of these the kitchen. On each end were doors, plus an entry at the east end. Small windows were on the ends in the attic and first and second stories, and each end of the kitchen. There were bedrooms upstairs, and an open attic. The kitchen also had a fireplace. The front and sides, between the woodwork, were faced with brick. Near the northeast end of the building was the well. (See picture of Bradstreet house, p. 10).

Daily life: Chairs were unknown in ordinary English households until a generation or so before the sailing of the Mayflower. Hats were worn at meals and the use of table forks did not become general until the last of the 1600's. Gov. Winthrop had brought over a fork in 1630, carefully preserved in a case, which is supposed to be the first and only table fork in the Colony at the time. Food

was placed in the mouth with the knife or the fingers. Washing the hands and face was not considered essential on rising from bed in the morning and few of the laboring classes in any country in Europe washed their faces every day.

They had little ornamentation -- it was notable that Hilliard Veren of Salem (d.1668) had three pictures in his hall chamber.

John may have chosen Salem to be near his friend (and perhaps brother-in-law) John Endicott, and other friends from Dorset, Dorchester, England who had settled there. Perhaps he chose the land along the river as the best place to build his tannery-- he was the first tanner in New England.

Prior to this each family tanned such leather as they had by a crude, tedious method. A hemlock log was hollowed out and strips of hide placed in it. They were covered with oak bark, pounded by hand with a mallet, and left to cure.

He also farmed his extensive land, and of course spent much time on civic affairs and his church.

Three more children were born here, and of course John continued his civic affairs, as selectman for many years, and deputy for Salem in the General Court. He was said to have been a good citizen, a man of piety and integrity.

He died Sept. 6, 1676.

John married in England, about 1633, MARY ENDICOTT, born 1602, and their first child, John, was born there before they sailed for America. Mary joined the church in Salem in 1644, and died there in 1676, the same year as her husband.

Mary was 33 when they moved to Salem, with a babe in arms and four other boys all under nine years of age, all with Biblical names. She spun the yarn, wove the cloth and made the clothes. She was teacher, both of reading and writing and of religion. Picture her busy at the large chimney with the hanging crane and iron pot, preparing food for her hungry husband and (by 1649) eight children -- six of them boys -- occasionally stopping to turn the hour glass which stood on the shelf above. She was dressed simply, even when going out, according to the local rules: "No sleeves were to be worn more than $\frac{1}{2}$ ell* in the widest part, and no lace

*an ell was about 45 inches in England

or other trimmings allowed."

She may have had four books: the Bible, the "Bay Hymn Book," the Catechism of 1641 and an almanac.

The eldest son, John II, never married. He was said to have been a mariner. Records show that John, Sr. exported at least two shipments of leather to the Barbados--perhaps John II was in charge. In his will, the father mentioned his "grievous son John."

Son Benjamin, who died at 50, and son Jonathan, never married. Samuel became a mariner and settled in Hingham. Joseph carried on the tanning business and it was his great-grandson Amos Porter who was at Concord, and moved out to settle Ohio. Israel, of Salem, had a child Elizabeth who married Joseph Putnam and was the mother of Gen. Israel Putnam of Revolutionary War fame. Daughter Mary married Lt. Thomas Gardner, whose sister Abigail was married to the Rev. John Wise* of Ipswich, later thrown in jail with another Porter ancestor, John Appleton, for opposing "taxation without representation."

Other outstanding descendants of John Porter were President Grover Cleveland, Zerubbabel Porter, who established the first shoe factory in New England, (in Danvers), and Gen. Moses Porter of Revolutionary War fame. Moses was born in Danvers in 1757. He joined the artillery company of Capt. Trevett and was in the battle of Bunker Hill, was under Washington when he beleaguered Boston, was in the battle of Brandywine and was wounded in an engagement with the British fleet on the Delaware River. Undaunted, he served on the Western Frontier for many years, and was in the noted engagement on Aug. 20, 1794 when Gen. Wayne routed 2000 Indians with 900 men. In the war of 1812 he held the rank of Brigadier General and was entrusted with many important affairs. He died in the service, in Cambridge, in 1822. Gen. Porter was longer in the American service than any other officer of his grade, and had the distinction of being one of the first artillery officers. A stern officer, he was still the urbane gentleman of the old school.

John had a brother, Richard Porter, who settled in Weymouth, Mass. and became well off and a leader. They came over together from England. A cousin, John Porter of Warwickshire, married to Margaret Odding, arrived in Boston about two months later in the "Ann and Elizabeth" from London. He had to leave Massachusetts Bay and settle in Rhode Island when he spoke out in sympathy with the Rev. John Wheelwright and Mistress Anne Hutchinson and their followers.

SECOND PORTER GENERATION IN AMERICA
JOSEPH PORTER I, tanner of Salem 1638-1714

JOSEPH PORTER I, born in Hingham and baptized on Sep.9,1638, was the son of JOHN PORTER and MARY ENDICOTT.

He inherited his father's farm and carried on the tanning business John had started. He died Dec.12, 1714, leaving a will dated Jul.15,1713, in which he deeded the farm and a negro boy to his son JOSEPH II. (Although young Joseph may have died first).

He married, on Jan. 27, 1665, ANNE HATHORNE, the daughter of MAJOR WILLIAM HATHORNE and ANNE SMITH. She was born Dec. 12,1643 in Salem, and died sometime before her husband. They had six sons, seven daughters. (See Chap.2, HATHORNE, p. 6,7).

THIRD PORTER GENERATION IN AMERICA
JOSEPH PORTER II of Salem, yeoman 1681-1714

JOSEPH PORTER II was born we think on Oct. 23, 1681 in Danvers, the son of JOSEPH PORTER I of Salem and Danvers and ANNE HATHORNE of Salem.

It seems he must have worked with his father on the Downing farm and perhaps in the tannery. He was known as a yeoman (a man of some property and/or respect). His father's will, dated Jul.15,1713, left him the farm, but we wonder about this as his death was listed as Dec. 8,1714 (at 34), four days before his father's death.

There is some confusion as to the Porters who brought the name from England to this country. Some were among the very early settlers of New England and some came later, but apparently they were all Protestants and there is no evidence of any Porters among the first settlers in Virginia and Maryland. Comparing the various sources of information, the following is the best list I am able to obtain of the early emigrant Porters.

- A - 1611 Abel Porter, said to have come to Boston in 1611. Only one casual reference, doubtful authenticity. Probably confused with N.
- B - 1622 Samuel Porter, "an ancestor of William Trotter Porter, settled at Plymouth in 1622" (4-13). No other mention, doubtful authenticity.
- C - 1633 John Porter of Roxbury, Mass., born England, came Roxbury (Dorchester), Mass. Nov. 5, 1633. Moved to Boston. He was a follower of the Rev. John Wheelwright and because of this was required in 1637 to give up his arms. In 1638, probably because of religious persecution, he moved to Rhode Island and is mentioned in the Rhode Island Charter in 1643. His wife was Margaret Odding. (5) (6)
- D - 1635 John Porter of Hingham and Salem, Mass., born Dorset, England, 1596 and said to be 16 generations in the direct line of descent from William de la Grande (4). Sailed with his wife Mary, from Weymouth, England, March 20, 1635 in ship Susan and Ellen. He settled at Hingham in 1635 and was granted a house lot and farm in 1637. In 1644 (or 1643) he moved to Salem. Died Salem, September 6, 1676. He was a Puritan and the first tanner in New England. His house stood until 1865. (3-4-5-6-9)
- E - 1635 John Porter of Dorchester, Mass. and Winsor, Conn. was probably born in Warwickshire, England, about 1612. He sailed from London with his wife Rose, May 1635 (other accounts say in 1630 (4-8)) in the ship Ann and Elizabeth. He landed at Boston and may have stayed there for a time, but settled at Dorchester and moved to Winsor, Conn. in 1637. He died at Winsor in 1648. He was a follower of the Rev. John Wheelwright and because of this was subjected to persecution and required to give up his arms. He is said to have been a cousin of John Porter of Hingham and Salem (D) and 16 years younger. He may possibly be the same man as John Porter of Roxbury, Mass. (C) but this is not likely.
- F - 1635 Richard Porter, came from England and settled at Weymouth, Mass. in 1635. His wife's name was probably Ruth and he was probably married after arriving in this country. (2) He was probably a brother of John Porter of Hingham and Salem (D) (2-3-4-5-9)
- G - 1636 Edward Porter, settled at Roxbury, Mass. in 1636, later moved to Boston. (17)
- H - 1636 Jonathan Porter, settled at Salem, Mass. in 1636, later moved to Huntington, Long Island. (17)
- I - 1637 Jonathan Porter, settled at Salem, Mass. in 1637. Possibly the same as (H). (17).
- J - 1637 Roger Porter, settled at Watertown, Mass. in 1637. He went back to England and returned to Massachusetts again in 1638. His wife's name was Grace. (17)

- K - 1638 Nathaniel Porter, settled at Salem, Mass. in 1638. (17)
- L - 1640 Robert Porter of Farmington, Conn. was the son of a Puritan minister and a brother of Thomas (H) and Daniel (I) Porter. He came from England, settled at Farmington in 1640 and died there in 1689. His wife was Mary Scott and he was one of the 84 landed proprietors of Farmington. (9-10)
- M - 1640 Thomas Porter of Farmington, Conn., son of a Puritan minister and brother of Robert (G) and Daniel (I) Porter. Came from England, settled at Farmington in 1640 and died there in 1697. (9)
- N - 1641 Abel Porter, said to have been born in England and to have come to Boston in 1641. No other data. Probably the same as (A).
- O - 1644 Daniel Porter, of Farmington, Conn. Son of a Puritan minister and brother of Robert (G) and Thomas (H) Porter. He came from England, settled at Farmington in 1644 and died there in 1690. His wife's name was Mary. He was a "Chirurgen" and "Bonesetter," licensed as such in 1654. In 1661 it was ordered that his salary be paid out of the public treasury and in 1671 his salary was increased to 12 pounds per annum. See also the Daniel Porter genealogy following. (3-9-14)

- P - 1645 Samuel Porter, settled at Winsor, Conn., date unknown, but moved to Hadley about in 1659. His wife's name was Hannah. He died 1689. (17)
- Q - 1645 Thomas Porter, settled at Hartford, Conn., date unknown. He married wife Sarah in 1644. Died 1697. (17)
- R - 1647 George Porter settled at Salem, Mass. 1647. (17)
- S - 1665 Thomas Porter of Taunton, Mass., born England, emigrated to America and settled at Taunton in 1665. He was a tanner and shoemaker. (7)

This I believe to be a complete list of the early Porters, but there were many who came over later, among whom I find references to the following:

- T - ? Four brothers are said to have come from England, two of whom settled in Maine and two in New Brunswick.
- U - 1720 Robert Porter emigrated from Londonderry, Ireland, to Londonderry, N. H., about 1720. Later he moved to Pennsylvania. He had 14 children, one of whom was General Andrew Porter (1743-1813) who had 13 children of whom David Rittenhouse Porter was President of the Lehigh Valley Railroad and a Governor of Pennsylvania, James Madison Porter founded Lafayette College and Robert Porter was a judge. (4-13)
- V - 1779 Robert Porter, born England 1759, came to America in 1779. Served in the Revolutionary War. Married Elizabeth Hancock. Died Alleghany Co., Penna.
- W - 17- John Porter emigrated from Ireland in the 18th Century, his descendant Albert Gallatin Porter (1824-1897) was Governor of Indiana, Comptroller of the Treasury and Minister to Italy.
