HE HAD 4 BROTHERS WHO WERE GOSHEN BAPTIST PREACHERS AND ONE OF THEM TAUGHT REV. COLBY WHOSE WIFE AND CHILDREN WERE KILLED BY THE INDIANS ONE SUNDAY MORNING WITHIN 200 RODS OF THE FORT--LETTER FROM ALBERT T. MORRIS, EATON, IND., MARCH, 1984.

NOTES

BENJAMIN SUTTON, JR. MOVED TO WASHINGTON COUNTY, PA. (NOW GREENE COUNTY) WITH HIS PARENTS IN 1771. HE ENLISTED IN THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR 1 APR 1777, AND SERVED AS A PRIVATE IN CAPTAIN JOHN MINORS' COMPANY, COLONEL ZAC. MORGAN'S PENNSYLVANIA REGIMENT; TROOPS ENGAGED ON THE WESTERN FRONTIER AGAINST THE INDIANS. HE WAS DISCHARGED 1 DEC 1777. THEN IN 1778 HE VOLUNTEERED AT GARARD'S FORT IN WHITELY CREEK AND SERVED 8 MONTHS IN CAPTAIN SAMUEL SWINDLER'S PENNSYLVANIA COMPANY UNDER GENERAL MCINTOSH, AND ASSISTED IN BUILDING FORT MCINTOSH AND FORT LAURENS. BENJAMIN SUTTON, JR. MARRIED SARAH TINGLEY IN 1779 AND MOVED TO MONONGAHELA CO., WEST VIRGINIA AND THEN TO MAYSVILLE, MASON CO., KY. IN 1788, ABOUT THE TIME THE TOWN WAS FOUNDED. IN 1794 HE BOUGHT SEVERAL LOTS IN MAYSVILLE, KY. THAT WERE ON A STREET WHICH IS NOW NAMED FOR HIM. HE MOVED TO BROWN CO., OHIO AFTER SEVERAL YEARS AND HERE WAS FIRST JUSTICE OF THE PEACE OF BYRD TOWNSHIP FOR 30 YEARS. AFTER HAVING RESIDED IN DECATUR ABOUT 10 YEARS, BENJAMIN SUTTON, JR. AGAIN JOINED THE ARMY WHEN THE SECOND WAR WITH GREAT BRITAIN BEGAN. HE SERVED AS A SERGEANT IN NATHAN HATFIELD'S OHIO MILITIA, AND HIS OLDER SON, TINGLEY, SERVED AS A QUARTERMASTER IN THE WAR OF 1812. (ROSTER OF SOLDIERS OF OHIO IN WAR OF 1812). BENJAMIN SUTTON, JR. APPLIED FOR A PENSION AT DECATUR, OHIO, 29 APR 1833 AND IT WAS GRANTED 16 SEP 1833.

ALL CHILDREN BORN IN BROWN CO., OHIO. ELIZABETH (BETSEY) MORROW WAS BORN 2 JAN 1790 (CENSUS RECORDS OF ADAMS CO., OHIO, 1850); SHE IS BURIED IN THE NEW YORK CEMETERY, WAYNE CO., IOWA. SHE LEFT BROWN CO. OHIO AFTER TINGLEY DIED AND AT LEAST 2 OF HER SONS TOOK HER TO UNION TWP., WAYNE CO., IOWA. THEY ALL HAVE GRAVEMARKERS IN THE NEW YORK CEMETERY. ELIZABETH MORROW DIED 18 NOV 1869--79 YR. 10 MO. 16 DAS. IS SHOWN ON THE GRAVESTONE. --LETTER FROM ALBERT T. MORRIS, EATON, INDIANA, MARCH, 1984.
