Note 1615. Thomson, Descendants of Thomas Thomson of Farmington, Conn. **Thomas Thomson**, born in England about 1617, may be that youth of eighteen years who embarked in the Abigail at London, England, July 1, 1635; a land owner at Hartford, Conn., 1639; married, at Hartford, April 14, 1646, **Ann Welles**, born Essex County, England, about 1619, daughter of Governor Thomas Welles of Connecticut. Mr. Thomson joined the church at Farmington, Conn., Oct. 13, 1652; made a will and died in Farmington, April 25, 1655. Inventory, £549 5s. 8d. (Hartford Probate Records). The widow, **Ann**, married, second, July 16, 1656 (?), **Anthony Hawkins** of Windsor and Farmington, Conn., as his second wife (first wife was Isabel Brown), and had children: **Sarah**, born 1657, died 1678, unmarried; **Elizabeth**, born 1660, married **Paul Brinsmead**; **Hannah**, born 1662, married, after 1680, **Richard Seymour** of Stratford, Conn. **Anthony Hawkins** died in 1675, and the will of his widow, **Ann**, was proven Dec. 2, 1680. The children of **Thomas** and **Ann (Welles) Thomson**, probably born in Hartford, except last two in Farmington, and all living at their mother's death, were: **Beatrice**, baptized Jan. 17, 1647, married **Parker** and settled in Farmington; **John**, born 1649; **Thomas**, born 1651;

Mary, born June 7, 1653, married, May 20, 1673, **Samuel (2) Hawley** of Stratford, Conn. (**Joseph (1)** and wife, **Katharine Birdsey**); **Esther**, baptized June 17, 1655 (posthumous), married **Samuel Ordley**. (See Savage's Genealogical Dictionary, vol. iv., page 288.)

John (2) Thomson (**Thomas 1**), born in Hartford, Conn., 1649; died in Farmington, Conn., Nov. 21, 1711; married, there, Oct. 24, 1670, **Mary Steele**, born Nov. 20, 1647, daughter of **John** and **Mary or Mercy (Warner) Steele**, and granddaughter of **John** and **Rachel (—) Steele**. **John Thomson** made freeman in Farmington, 1670. Administration on his estate granted Feb. 9, 1712, to **John Thomson** and **Thomas Hart, Jr.** Inventory taken March 3, 1712, £174 1s. 3d. (Hartford Probate Records.) Children born in Farmington, Conn.: **John**, born Dec. 29, 1671; **Thomas**, born June 30, 1674, though another account says Jan. 18, 1675; **Samuel**, born Dec. 28, 1676; **Joseph**, born March 25, 1679, died May 14, 1679; **James**, born May 30, 1680, baptized Oct. 1, 1682; **Ebenezer**, born Nov. 23, or by another report Dec. 21, 1684; **Nathaniel**, born Jan. 16, 1687. (See Savage's Genealogical Dictionary, vol. iv., page 288.)

Thomas (2) Thomson (**Thomas 1**), born in Hartford, Conn., 1651, died in Farmington, Conn., Jan. 3, 1709;

married first, Elizabeth Smith, born about 1653, daughter of Arthur and Margaret (—) Smith of Hartford; married, second, ~~Abigail~~. He was made freeman in Farmington, 1677. On Dec. 14, 1705, his wife Abigail threw a pair of shears at her husband, the point of which penetrated the brain, causing his death in a few days. She was convicted of the crime and after one or two reprieves the sentence was executed. Her daughter Mercy was born while she was in prison. Administration on his estate was granted to his son, Thomas Thomson. Inventory taken Jan. 18, 1706, by John Thomson, Sen., Samuel Woodruff and Joseph Hawley, 456 pounds, 13 shillings and 5 pence. Distribution to five living children and two grandchildren April 1, 1708. (Hartford Probate Records.) Children by first wife, born in Farmington, Conn.: Elizabeth, married John (3) Woodruff (John 2, Matthew 1), Thomas, born March 25, 1679; Arthur, born Oct. 17, 1680, died young; Philoletheros, baptized Nov. 12, 1682, died young; John, born Dec. 14, 1684, died young; Margaret, born Feb. 20, 1687, died young; Anna, born Feb. 10, 1689, married John (3) Norton (John 2, John 1; Samuel, born Oct. 18, 1691; Daniel. Children by second wife: Child, born and died young; Mercy, born March 15, 1706, in prison. (See Savage's Genealogical Dictionary, vol. iv., page 288.)

John (3) Thomson (John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Dec. 29, 1671; died there Aug. 9, 1741; married first, in Farmington, Nov. 2, 1699 Margaret Orton, daughter of John Orton and his first wife, and granddaughter of Thomas and Margaret (Pratt or Pell) Orton; married second, Ruth Steele, who died in Farmington, in May, 1751, daughter of John (3) and Ruth (Judd) Steele. The will of John Thomson is dated July 5, 1737; proved Sept. 16, 1741, by son

Ezekiel Thomas, executor; inventory taken Oct. 26, 1741, 1097 pounds 8 shillings and 6 pence. The will of widow Ruth Thomson is dated April 20, 1751, Samuel Steele, a kinsman, executor; inventory taken May 29, 1751, 252 pounds, 13 shillings and 6 pence. (Hartford Probate Records.) Children by first wife, born in Farmington, Conn.: Margaret, born Oct. 11, 1700; died before June, 1768, married — Beach and had children; Nathaniel, born Feb. 20, 1702, died in Farmington, June 15, 1765, married Ruth Hopkins, who died in Farmington, Feb. 12, 1788, aged eighty-one, no issue, daughter of Caleb Hopkins; John, born April 5, 1704; Joseph, born June 18, 1705, died in Farmington, April 18, 1735, unmarried; Hannah, born Oct. 6, 1708, living in 1788, married first, Jonathan Bird, and, second, — Webster, had a daughter, Lydia Bird; James, born Jan. 29, 1711; Ezekiel, born Sept. 5, 1713; Solomon, born April 11, 1716; Hezekiah; Eunster, born April 17, 1721, died before 1788, married in Farmington, Jan. 29, 1741, James Judd.

~~Eunster~~ ~~Thomas~~ (3) Thomson (John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., June 30, 1674, or Jan. 13, 1675; died there July 17, 1748; married there Jan. 15, 1707, ~~Elizabeth~~ ~~Charles~~, who died there Dec. 4, 1727. Children born in Farmington, Conn.: Mary, born Dec. 26, 1707, died March 3, 1713; ~~Eunster~~ born July 13, 1710.

Samuel (3) Thomson *not copied forward* (John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Dec. 28, 1670; died there Jan. 18, 1739; married Feb. 17, 1707, Hannah Lathrop of Wallingford, Conn. He made his will Jan. 17, 1730, and names his wife Hannah and five sons and five daughters. Will proved March 3, 1739, by son, Samuel Thomson, executor. Inventory taken Feb. 23, 1739, 1332 pounds, 17 shillings and 4 pence. Distribution in 1742. (Hartford Probate Records.)

Children, born in Farmington, Conn.: Daughter, born May 27, died June 4, 1708; Samuel, born April 13, 1709; Ebenezer, born Jan. 9, 1711; Ruth, born Sept. 11, 1712, married — Judd; Mary born July 28, 1714, married in 1735 Samuel (4) Woodford (Joseph 3, Joseph 2, Thomas 1) of Farmington (Avon), Conn.; Daniel, born Aug. 9, 1716; Thomas, born Oct. 6, 1718; Bechlah, born May 1, 1721; Barnabas born Nov. 13, 1723; Hannah, born Aug. 30, 1725; Anne, born March 1, 1728.

Elizabeth (3) Thomson (Thomas 2, Thomas 1), born probably in Farmington, Conn., by or before 1677, died there Nov. 30, 1705; married John (3) Woodruff, born in Farmington, 1669; died in Kensington Society of Farmington, 1727; son of John (2) Woodruff and wife Mary — and grandson of Matthew (1) Woodruff and wife Hannah —. John (3) Woodruff married second, Mary — and from 1706 to 1718 had children, viz: Susannah, John and Joseph (twins), Simmons, Margaret, Abigail and Anne (twins), Elijah, all of whom, together with Elizabeth and Mary, children by his first wife, are mentioned in his will, dated Feb. 9, 1727. Inventory taken June 11 and will proved August 1, 1727, wife Mary executrix. (Hartford Probate Records). Children of John and Elizabeth (Thomson) Woodruff, born in Farmington, Conn.; Elizabeth, born April 17, 1697; Mary, born Jan. 31, 1699; Phebe, born May 31, 1702, who probably died young, as her name does not appear with Elizabeth and Mary, who shared in the distribution of the estate of their grandfather, Thomas Thomson, made April 1, 1703.

Thomas (3) Thomson (Thomas 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., March 25, 1670; died there, March 29, 1735; married first in Farmington, Nov. 16, 1705, Abigail (3) Woodruff, born there March 8, baptized March 30, 1684; died there,

Aug. 6, 1720; daughter of John (2) Woodruff and wife (Mary?) — and granddaughter of Matthew (1) Woodruff and wife Hannah —. He married second in Farmington, May 25, 1721, Elizabeth Judd, who survived him. In his will, dated March 17, 1735, he calls himself Thomas Thomson of Thomas — will proved May 6, 1735, with inventory of 1018 pounds, ten shillings and sixpence. Eldest son, Timothy Thomson, executor and guardian to his brother Thomas (Hartford Probate Records). Children by first wife, born in Farmington, Conn.: Elizabeth, born Aug. 8, 1700, died July 9, 1793, married, Feb. 5, 1730, Samuel (4) Hart (Thomas 3, Stephen 2 Stephen 1) of Farmington (Avon). (See Hart Genealogy, page 170; Sarah, born July 3, 1708, died March 4, 1733, married, Oct. 15, 1730, as his first wife, Timothy (4) Hawley (Joseph 3, Samuel 2, Joseph 1) (see Hawley Genealogy); Abigail, born Sept. 3, 1710, died Dec. 7, 1760, married, July 18, 1734, as his first wife, Daniel (4), Hart (Stephen 3, Stephen 2, Stephen 1) of New Britain, Conn. (see Hart Genealogy, page 168); Timothy, born Oct. 31, 1712; Anne, born March 27, 1715, died May 7, 1718; Phebe, born Aug. 25, 1717, died in Farmington Nov. 26, 1747, unmarried; Thomas, born July 15, 1720, died in Farmington, Dec. 19, 1745, unmarried. His will, dated Dec. 18, 1745 names his brother Timothy Thomson, executor, his friend, Abigail Woodruff and his sisters, Elizabeth Hart, Abigail Hart and Phebe Thomson. Hartford Probate Records.

Anna (3) Thomson (Thomas 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Feb. 10, 1689, married there, May 1 or 6, 1708, Sergeant John (3) Norton, baptized in Farmington, April 6, 1684; died in Kensington Society of Farmington, 1762; son of John (2) and Ruth (Moore) Norton and grandson of John (1) and first wife Dorothy (—) Norton. His

wife Anna survived him. His will is dated April 5, 1748, son Job Norton, executor, proved Oct. 13, 1752, when the widow and all the children, except the Gldeons, were living. (Hartford Probate Records.) Children (Norton) born in Farmington, Conn.: Gldeon, born Jan 12, 1709, died Oct. 1, 1712; Charles, born Oct. 17, 1710, married; Gldeon (2), born Sept. 5, 1713, died in Farmington, March 26, 1742, married there, April 15, 1736. Martha (4) Thomson (Samuel 3, Thomas 2, Thomas 1); John, born Nov. 16, 1715, married —: Anna, born Jan. 13, 1718, married in Farmington, Feb. 20, 1735, as his first wife, Judah (5) Hart (John 4, John 3, John 2, Stephen 1) of New Britain, Conn. (See Hart Genealogy, page 48.), Job, born Feb. 19, 1720; Roger, born March 15, 1722, married; Ruth, born March 18, 1724, married Josiah Burnham; Sarah, born June 1726, married Moses Deming (see Deming Genealogy); Lucy, born March 31, 1728, married John Kirby; Mary, born May 20, 1730, married James Bidwell.

Samuel (3) Thomson (Thomas 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Oct. 18, 1691, died probably in Kensington Society of Farmington 1773, married in Farmington, June 20, 1716, Mary Porter. He probably had a second wife, as on Dec. 27, 1773, Sarah Thomson, widow of Samuel, writes a letter from Kensington, asking to have her daughter, Martha Norton, and her grandson, Stephen Norton, take the administration of the estate of her late husband, which they did the same day. Inventory 1078 pounds, 14 shillings and 1 penny. (Farmington Probate Records.) Child, probably by first wife, born in Farmington, Conn. Martha, born Dec. 17, 1717, married in Farmington April 15, 1736, her first cousin, Gldeon Norton (see above). Children, probably by second wife, born in Farmington, Conn.: Sarah, born March 10,

1772, died May 1, 1725; Hannah, twin to Sarah, died March 19, 1722; Samuel, born March 21, 1726, died April 7, 1726; Stephen, twin to Samuel, died March 18, 1737.

Daniel (3) Thompson (Thomas 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., between 1693 and 1700. Some Daniel Thomson married, Jan. 28, 1729, Ruth Hopkins of Hartford, Conn., and the following children were born in Farmington to some Daniel Thomson, viz.: Sarah, born June 28, 1728; Eliezer, born April 1, 1731; Elijah, born Sept. 21, 1732.

John (4) Thomson (John 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., April 5, 1704, died there 1775; married there, June 7, 1731, Joannah Gridley, daughter of Thomas. Her will is dated July 18, 1800; proved Sept. 5, 1803. The will of John Thomson is dated March 7, 1770; proved Oct. 7, 1775. Son John, executor. Inventory, 1000 pounds. (Farmington Probate Records.) Children probably born in Farmington, Conn.: Priscilla, died Jan. 18, 1734; John, 1736, married Mary —: Luke, 1754; Johanna, married Eli Andrus; Lydia; Rebeckah; Ruth; Sarah; Lucy.

James (4) Thomson (John 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Jan. 20, 1711; died there Dec. 16, 1785; married there, Nov. 10, 1741, Martha Secon (?) of Simsbury, Conn.; died in Farmington, Jan. 26, 1789, aged seventy-two. (Gravestones in old cemetery in Farmington.) Farmington records give a James Thomson's marriage to Mary Lewis, Oct. 30, 1741, and the death of Mary, wife of James Thomson, as April 24, 1740. James (4) Thomson's will is dated March 10, 1763, and names wife Martha, a brother Nathaniel, deceased, and his children Abel, Mary, Martha and Huldah (all married). The widow and son, executors. Will proved Feb. 15, 1766. The widow, Martha Thomson, made will Jan.

26, 1787; proved Feb. 16, 1789. (Farmington Probate Records.) Children born in Farmington, Conn.: Mary, born Oct. 7, 1742, died Oct. 10, 1749; James, born June 15, 1744, died Oct. 8, 1749; Huldah, born Dec. 15, 1746, died Oct. 8, 1749; Abel, born Feb. 19, 1749, married, 1775, Ruth Gridley, and 1793, Sybil Hart; Mary, born April 26, 1751, married Solomon Whitman, Jr.; Martha, born Oct. 18, 1753, married Elijah Lewis; Seth, born Aug. 2, 1755, died May 11, 1776; Huldah, born June 27, 1758, married James Judd, Jr.

Ezekiel (4) Thomson (John 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Sept. 5, 1713; died there, 1760; married Catharine —, who with Hezekiah Thomson and John Tillotson were named administrators of her husband's estate on March 4, 1760. Inventory, 541 pounds 1 shilling. Distribution Jan. 3, 1764 (Hartford Probate Record). Children, born in Farmington, Conn.: Elizabeth, born April 4, 1747, not mentioned in the distribution of estate; Isalah, captain, (Avon), Sept. 24, 1752, married Lydia — and lived in Bristol, Conn.; Reuben, captain (Avon), June 16, 1758; Eleanor, mentioned in the distribution of estate.

Solomon (4) Thomson (John 3, John 2, Thomas 1,) born in Farmington, Conn., April 11, 1716; died there, 1789 or 90; married Susannah —, who died in Farmington, June 10, 1761. Administration on his estate granted Feb. 1, 1790 to son Nathaniel Thomson. (Farmington Probate Records.) Children, born in Farmington, Conn: Ethan, born Oct. 8, 1746, died Feb. 3, 1750; Susannah, born Jan. 10, 1752; Nathaniel, born Nov. 21, 1753; Delightful, born March 8, 1757; married Bissell (5) Woodford, born in Avon, Conn., April 9, 1754, son of John (4) and Sarah (Phelps) Woodford (Joseph 3, Joseph 2, Thomas 1); Theodocla,

born Dec. 9, 1759; son, born and died June 19, 1761.

Hezekiah (4) Thomson (John 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born probably in Farmington, Conn., about 1718 or 1719; married —. Children, born in Farmington, Conn.: Joseph, born June 24, 1745, died July 6, 1747; Hannah, born April 14, 1744, died Sept. 4, 1748; Mabel, born June 7, 1749; Joseph (2), born Oct. 20, 1751; Hezekiah, born June 28, 1754; Hannah, born Sept. 4, 1756; Lothrop, born Sept. 3, 1760; Ann, born Feb. 10, 1762.

Samuel (4) Thomson (Samuel 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., April 13, 1709; died there, 1793; married first, Hannah (4) North, born in Farmington, July 27, 1711, daughter of Thomas (3) and Hannah (Woodford) North, granddaughter of Samuel (2) and Hannah (Norton) North and great-granddaughter of John and Mary (Bird) North.

Hannah Thompson is named in the will of her father, Thomas North, of Farmington, of July 2, 1747, which was proved Aug. 27, 1755. (Hartford Probate Records.) Samuel Thomson probably married second, after 1755, Eunice —, as she is named in his will of Sept. 6, 1785. Affidavit of his death made Dec. 26, 1793. Will proved Jan. 6, 1794. Sons Samuel and Eben, executors. (Farmington Probate Records.) Children by first wife, born in Farmington, Conn.: Mercy, born Jan. 23, 1739, married — Andrus; Hannah, born Dec. 10, 1740, died Jan. 9, 1741; Hannah, born May 10, 1742, died June 10, 1742; Elizabeth, born July, 1743, died Aug. 17, 1743; Samuel, born June 29, 1744; Sarah, born Dec. 16, 1746, married March 3, 1774, as his second wife, Ellaha (4) Woodruff (Hezekiah 3, Samuel 2, Matthew 1) of Southington, Conn., and later of Pittsford, Vt.; Susannah, born May 26, 1749, died Sept. 3, 1751; Lot, born May 4, bap-

died May 10, 1753; married Anna Hart and lived and died in Avon, Conn.; Ebenezer (or Eben), born Aug. 4, 1755, married first, Azubah Hart, sister of Anna above, second Amella —, and third Rhoda Hart, lived and died in Farmington, Conn.

Mary (4) Thomson (Samuel 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., July 28, 1714, married, 1735, Samuel (4) Woodford, born in Farmington, March 30, 1712; died there, Sept. 18, 1758; son of Joseph (3) and Lydia (Smith) Woodford; grandson of Joseph (2) and Rebecca (Newell) Woodford, and great-grandson of Thomas (1) and Mary (Blott) Woodford. He lived in Farmington (Avon).

The will of Samuel Woodford is dated May 16, 1758, and names wife Mary and four sons and four daughters; the wife and son Amos, executors. Proved Nov. 6, 1758. Inventory Nov. 7, 1758, is £503 7s. 6p. Distribution made Oct. 29, 1765, when the widow is deceased. (Hartford Probate Records.) Children born in Farmington, Conn.: Samuel, born Dec. 20, 1735; married, March 15, 1757, Lucy (5) Thomson (Timothy 4, Thomas 3, Thomas 2, Thomas 1) of Farmington (Avon), Conn.; Amos, born 1737, died Dec. 11, 1759, unmarried; Mary, born Sept. 15, 1741, married, Dec. 8, 1763, Michael Segar of Simsbury, Conn.; Ruth, born Nov. 4, 1744, married, Dec. 8, 1763, Lemuel Roberts, Jr., of Simsbury, son of Lemuel and Abigail (Beman) Roberts; Rhoda, born Aug. 23, 1746, married, Feb. 27, 1763, Nathaniel Roberts of Simsbury, brother of Lemuel, Jr.; Daniel, born 1748, died April 12, 1777; married May 30, 1771, Ruth Thomson of Avon, daughter of Barnabas and Ruth (Hart) Thomson; Solomon, born March 8, 1751, married, Jan. 6, 1774, Mary Ford of Avon, daughter of William and Thankful (Rowlandson) Ford; Hannah, born July

22, 1753, married, 1775, Isaac Blakesley of Woodbury, Conn.

Daniel (4) Thomson (Samuel 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Aug. 9, 1716; died there Nov. 19, 1797; married Eunice —, who died in Farmington, Feb. 7, 1812, aged ninety-six. (Gravestones in old cemetery in Farmington.) His will is dated March 3, 1795; only son Jonathan, executor, and to inherit all lands, stock and farm utensils; proved Feb. 13, 1797. Children, born in Farmington, Conn.: Esther, married Thomas Hooker; Jonathan, born May 8, 1760; Lucy, baptized Jan. 5, 1760, in Northington Parish, married Solomon Langdon.

Barnabas (4) Thomson (Samuel 3, John 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Nov. 13, 1723; died there Sept. 18, 1770; married there, June 10, 1748, Ruth (5) Hart, born in Farmington, Dec. 26, 1724; died there Nov. 1, 1792; daughter of Joseph (4) and Mary (Bird) Hart of the Northington Parish of Farmington, granddaughter of Serceant Thomas (3) and Elizabeth (Judd) Hart (Stephen 2, Stephen 1).

Barnabas Thomson was a farmer in the Northington Parish of Farmington (since 1830 Avon) and lived about a mile north of Cider Brook, between Talcott Mountain and the Farmington River. He was one of the founders of Northington parish church in 1751. He was called lieutenant. The farm is still in the possession of a great-great-grandson. He and wife are buried and have gravestones in the Cider Brook Cemetery in Avon.

His will is dated Sept. 27, 1775, in which he says he is "now building a new house," wife Ruth and sons Barnabas and Levi named as executors; proved Oct. 8, 1776; amount of estate £1144 2s. 2d. His widow Ruth signed her will April 4, 1781, which was proved Dec. 20, 1792. Son Asa Thomson, executor. (Farmington

Probate Records.) Timothy (4) Thomson (Thomas 3, Thomas 2, Thomas 1), born in Farmington, Conn., Oct. 31, 1712; died there, May 29, 1795; married, Anna —, who died in Farmington, May 11, 1793, in the seventy-seventh year of her age. They are buried and have gravestones in the Cider Brook Cemetery in Avon. He was a farmer in the Northington Parish of Farmington (now Avon), and was one of the founders of the church there in 1751.

His will is dated Oct. 24, 1794 and was proved July 6, 1796, Son, Thom-

as Thomson, executor. (Farmington Probate Records.)
