

Baltimore: Genealogical Pub. Co., 1965. (Originally pub. Chicago, 1928.)  
Account of settlers brought from Scotland by Capt. Lachlan Campbell in  
1738, '39, & '40. 89 families, incl 258 persons, plus 112 single persons, for a  
total of 470. They were promised 1000 acres per adult and 500 acres  
per child. After over 25 years of petitioning, they were granted the  
Argyle Patent of 47,450 acres. Individual grants were much smaller  
than promised. Lists 21 individuals and grants. No Rogers.  
Also lists original recipients of Turner Patent. No Rogers. The  
Turner Patent, was granted to <sup>35000 acres</sup><sub>37 group of scots from (50) scottish</sub> members of the Argyle group who  
came from Petham, MA and settled near them. Both grants in 1764.
