Samuel Newman and his wife being members of Montgomery Church in the County of Philadelphia, was the first member of any Baptist church that settled here. But in some small time after he was settled, John HARRISON, Senior being convinced of his duty to come to the holy ordinance of Baptism went for it somewhere towards New York, to a place called Oyster-Bay, but was received then a Member of no particular Church; but by a certificate of his Baptism, was recommended to be received, or associated into any church of that Order, where God in his Providence should shew most convenient for him.

We are having nice spring weather and the farmers are all busy plowing. Tell I did not see the piece he had marked around but there was a good many to tell me of it. I was not much frightened for I knew they did not dare pass such a bill as that. Even if they should in the dim future George would be back long before that time.

I am not making any calculations of moving down there though such a thing might be. George was well pleased with the country. The children are all home from school and each one trying to make the most noise. We have only had one letter from Clintons since we was there. Ask them if they have forgotten us since they got in their new home. Have you got your new house. Tell Mother to write me a great long Motherly letter. Nellie thinks every old lady she sees in a cap is Grandma. Don't you think could all come and see us just let us know when you will come and we will meet you at the train. Mary says when she gets done going to school she is coming back to get acquainted with her relation.
