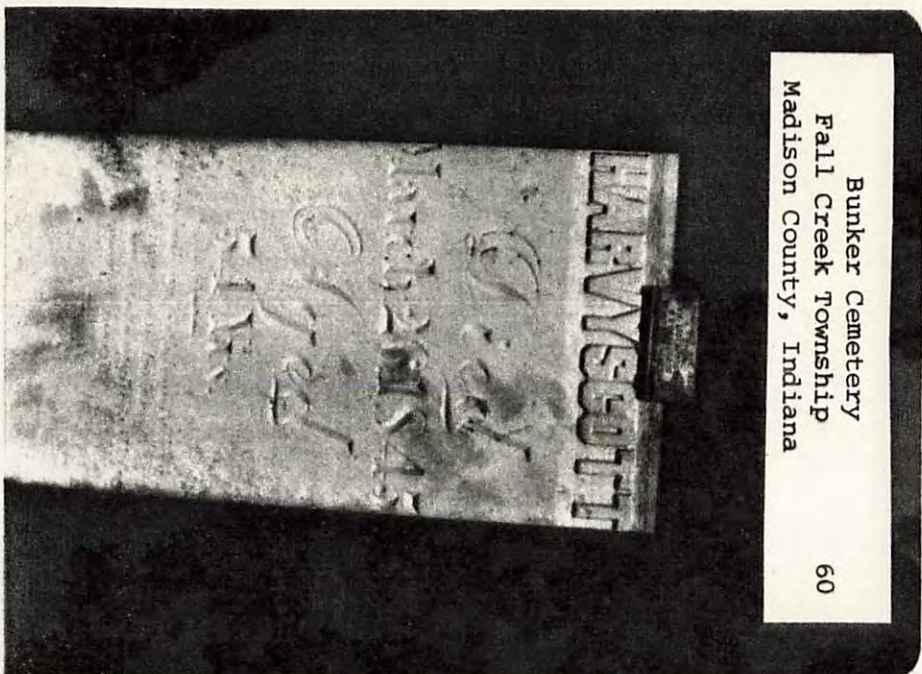

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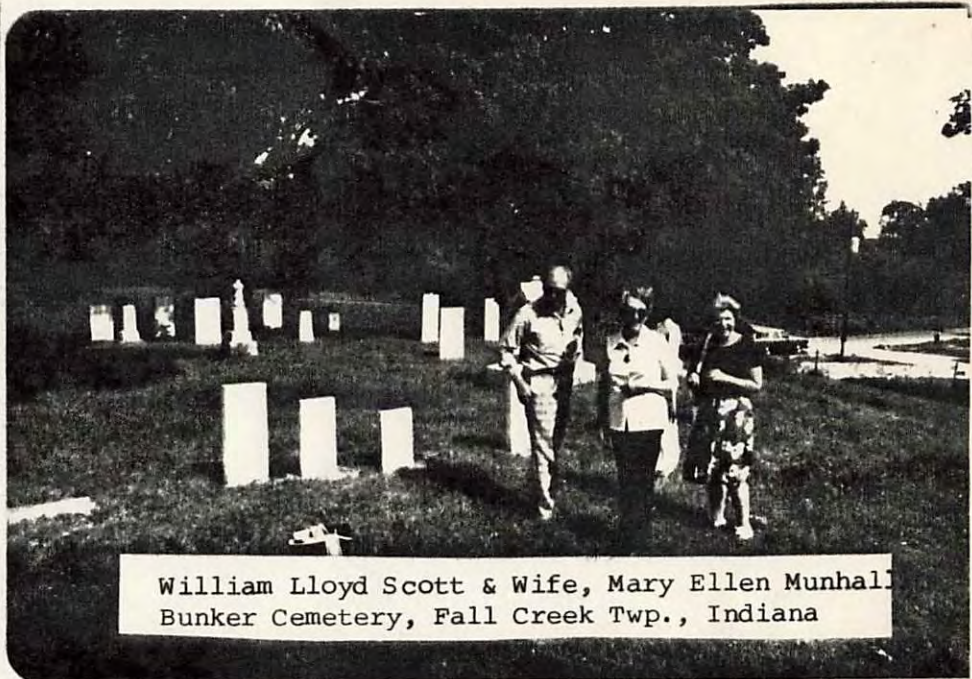

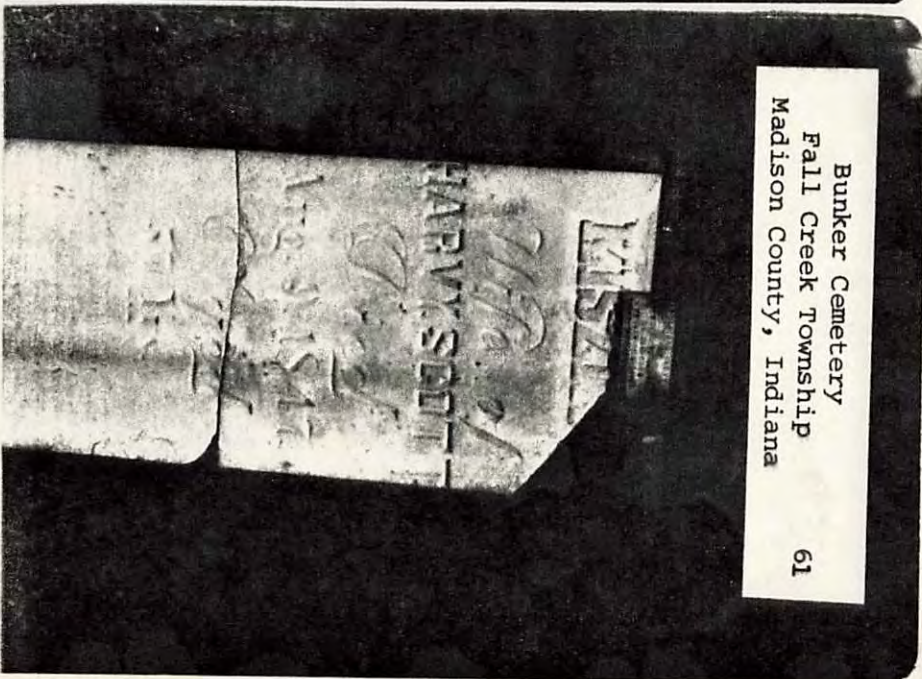

My will is that my Executor rent out my mill property and receive the rent and keep the repairs in good order and the expense of so doing charge to my estate. My will is that what money I now have in the house be kept and reserved to pay what I may owe and discharge what may recovered against me on account of my being security for loans if any should be recovered against me and also what money is due me.


