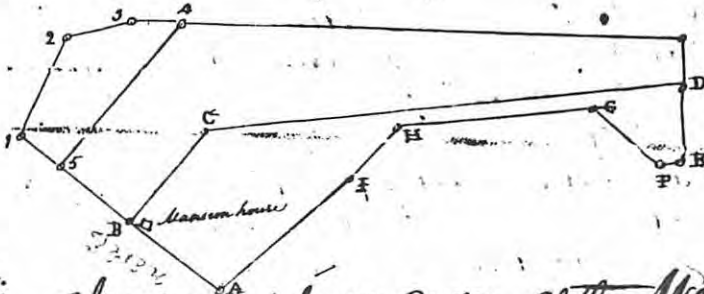

In obedience to orders of the Worshipful County Court of Mercer Co. made at their March term 1826 the other at their September term 1826. directing us the undersigned Commissioners to lay off & divide the lands of James Dunn Deed. between his children and executors We met on the premises on the 25th day of Decr 1826 This land being previously surveyed and the survey Dower allotted agreeably to the foregoing report by which it was ascertained that there was a residue of 80 acres subject to be divided between five children or executors

We proceeded after viewing the premises and deliberation had to allot to Joseph Ford and Elvir his wife (late Eleanor Dunn) one lot of 27 tract of land as follows. Beginning at a stake figure 1, a stake in the south 18th of the road before to Lawson Moore; thence with his line 91¹/₂ E 46 poles to a stake corner to said Moore at figure 2; thence with another of his lines 136¹/₂ N 28¹/₂ poles to a sugar tree corner to said Moore at figure 3; thence with another of Moors lines 152¹/₂ N 22 poles to a stake at figure 4; thence N 80 poles to a stake in the road at figure 5; thence North 88¹/₂ E 22 poles to the beginning containing three acres & being an equal one third part in value of the aforesaid residue of 80 acres

This balance of the said executors (by their Guardian) desiring that no further Division at this time be had we adjourned on the next day and beg leave to report to the Court &c

I give and bequeath to Robert Dunn, my Grand Son and Son of Samuel Dunn the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars in money and two new blankets, two sheets, one white counterpane and one quilt not quilted - said household articles are in the hands of my daughter Sophia Wingate -

I give and bequeath to my Grand Son Williamson Dunn, Son of Samuel Dunn, the sum of one hundred dollars -

I give and bequeath to my Grand Son Marion Dunn, Son of Samuel Dunn, the sum of one hundred dollars -

I give to my Grand Son, James H. Dunn, Son of Samuel Dunn, the sum of Fifty Dollars and my gold watch

I give and bequeath to my Grand Son, Samuel C. Dunn, Son of Samuel Dunn Fifty Dollars

I give and bequeath to my Son Oliver Dunn, Son of Samuel Dunn, the sum of Fifty Dollars -

My will and desire is that my executors hereinafter mentioned pay over the several amounts of money herein willed, to my Son Samuel Dunn's children and the interest that may accrue thereon as my said Grand Children may arrive at the age of twenty one years unless they should marry at an earlier age, then and that case

I give and bequeath to my grand children, Williamson Dunn and Nancy Dunn children of my son Davis Dunn, the sum of Fifty Dollars each to be paid over with its interest when they attain the age of twenty one years, unless they or one of them should marry before that, and upon their marriage, my Executors are directed to pay over the same, but should either my Grand Son, Williamson above named, or my Grand daughter Nancy above named die before they marry or arrive at the age of twenty one years, then my will is that the same be paid over to their Sister Francis Jane Dunn, that is if either dies, the share of the one living to go Francis Jane Dunn I also give said Francis Jane Dunn My desk and Tea chest, the same now in possession of her Father Davis Dunn and I also give to my said Grand daughter, Nancy Dunn, my bedstead & settee, now in her Father's possession it is further my will that the one hundred dollars herein devised to Davis's children to be paid out of what he owes me

My will is that my daughter Sophia Kingate have the use of one bed and bed clothing my silver table spoons & silver tea spoons, my Loom and appurtenances, and one big bed, new in her possession during her life, and after her death to go to her children, and the same is not to be sold by her or any other person I also give to my daughter Sophia Kingate, the interest in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, which I am Executor are to put at interest and pay the same over to my said daughter annually, and at her death the said one hundred and fifty dollars is hereby devised and willed to the children of my said daughter Sophia Kingate - It is my will that my Executors sell all my property & estate of every kind except such as is specifically devised by this will and if there shall be any thing left from the sale of my property & estate and for the collection of what is owing me after paying and discharging the Legacies and devises herein mentioned, then my will is that the residue be placed at interest by my Executors, and the interest annually paid over to my said daughter Sophia Kingate and after her death said residuary sum what ever it may be is hereby devised and willed to the children of said Sophia Kingate - I hereby nominate and appoint Samuel Brown and James Blair Executors to this my will
