ARTICLE I.

I DECLARE THAT I HAVE TWO NATURAL-BORN CHILDREN, NAMELY MY SON, CHARLES H. GILLIS, AND MY DAUGHTER, MARTHA D. TAYLOR. IN ADDITION TO THE TWO CHILDREN MENTIONED, MY DECEASED WIFE AND I TOOK INTO OUR HOME A CHILD WHOM WE DID NOT ADOPT BUT WHOM WE RAISED AND REGARDED AS A DAUGHTER, WHO IS NOW MARRIED, AND WHOSE NAME IS RUTH M. ARTICLE II.

I DIRECT THAT I BE BURIED IN THE CEMETERY LOT I OWN IN WESTMINISTER MEMORIAL PARK, WESTMINISTER, CALIFORNIA NEXT TO MY DECEASED WIFE, LAURA M. GILLIS. I FURTHER DIRECT THAT AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER MY DEMISE, MY JUST DEBTS AND EXPENSES OF MY LAST ILLNESS AND FUNERAL BE PAID.

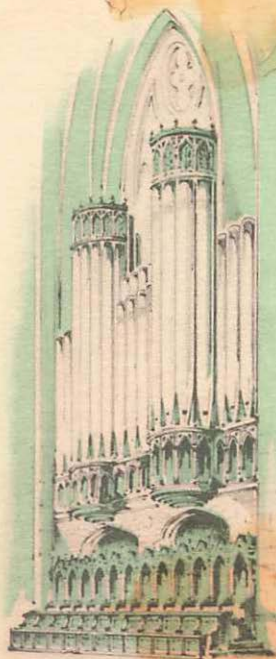

That this is to further certify that there has been deposited with said Westminster Memorial Park the sum of SIXTY Dollars, in trust to be invested, as authorized by law, with other funds of like character, and the proportionate net income therefrom to be used in the "Endowment Care" and protection of the herein described interment property, the investment of such funds and the expenditure of the income therefrom shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of California.

That this conveyance and all rights, title and interest hereby conveyed in the property above-described, is subject to all laws and ordinances, to the rules and regulations of Westminster Memorial Park as they now exist or may hereafter be amended or adopted and to the following conditions, provisions, restrictions, rules and regulations, and the Grantee covenants and agrees that:

(a) No transfer, conveyance or assignment of any interest or rights acquired by Grantee shall be valid without the written consent of Grantor and being thereafter recorded on its books.

(b) No monument or other memorial, tree, plant, object, decoration or embellishment of any kind shall be placed upon, altered or removed from the above-described property by the Grantee without the written consent of the Grantor. All grading, landscaping work, and improvements of any kind, and all care on the above-described property, shall be done, and all trees and plants of any kind shall be planted, trimmed or removed, and all interments, disinterments and removals, including all openings and closings of graves, shall be made only by Grantor with its equipment. All interments shall be made subject to the use of the type of an outer container as shall be designated by Grantor in its rules and regulations.

(c) Grantor at the expense of Grantee and as a charge against the above-described property, may repair or remove any memorial which in its opinion is improper or offensive, in violation of paragraph (b) above, or which has become dangerous or dilapidated; and may remove any tree, flower or plant, or other object or embellishment that become unsightly or dangerous, and dispose of same.

(d) Grantor shall not be liable for loss or damage on account of any delay in making interments or for any loss or damage to the property conveyed herein occurring by reason of any act of God, the elements, war, common enemy, thieves, vandals, strikers, malicious mischief makers, unavoidable accidents, nuclear explosions, riot, act or order of any military or civil authority.

(e) The enumeration herein of certain conditions, reservations, restrictions and rules and regulations shall not be considered as the only limitations, but the Grantee shall always hold all his interest and rights limited by and subject to the rules and regulations and by-laws of Grantor now existing or which may by it hereafter adopted either as amendment, alteration or the adoption of new ones. These rules and regulations are on file for inspection in Grantor's office and are specifically referred to and herein inserted as if set forth in full.

(f) No monument, memorial, or other structure extending above the surface of the ground shall ever be erected on the property in which the interment rights are hereby conveyed, and no memorial tablet constructed or composed of material other than bronze or granite, or of a size or design not in conformity with the rules and regulations governing said Westminster Memorial Park, shall ever be placed on the property. All inscriptions, including markers, tablets, crypts or niche name plates, shall be subject to the approval of and acceptance or rejection by Westminster Memorial Park.

All the above conditions, reservations, restrictions and rules and regulations are binding upon Grantee, his heirs, devisees, executors, administrators and assigns, and are enforceable only by Grantor or its successors in interest. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to restrict the use of any other portion of the cemetery than that herein conveyed to Grantee.

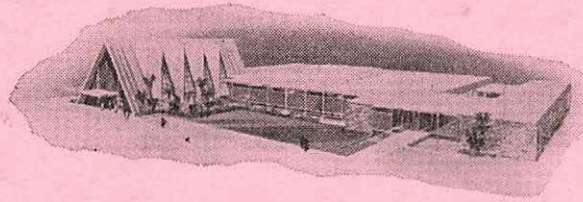

FUNERAL SERVICE AGREEMENT

DATED: 10/28/61

This Trust Agreement is entered into between GENEVA GILLIS, Trustor, or in such other manner as he or she may designate in writing, and F. Calvert Strong, Lauren H. Conley, George B. Honold, John H. McWhinney, Milton G. Bennett, Trustees hereinafter collectively referred to as trustee.

Trustor desires to create a separate trust estate in the amount of \$ 465⁰⁰, for funeral services to be provided at Mortuary in Westminster Memorial Park, and delivers to Trustee herewith, without consideration, the sum of \$ 50⁰⁰, and will pay to said Trustee, without consideration, the additional sum of \$ 12⁰⁰, or more, per month, beginning on the 4th day of DECEMBER, 19 61, until the trust estate hereby created is fully accumulated and paid in. The amount deposited in the trust estate created hereby shall be held, administered and distributed by the Trustee in accordance with the general terms hereinafter mentioned:

A. Upon presentation by Mortuary in Westminster Memorial Park of proof of death of the Trustor hereunder, and a statement that the funeral services have been rendered and interment or entombment or cremation has been completed pursuant to Trustor's Advance of Need Instructions, a copy of which is attached hereto, the Trustee shall pay to Mortuary in Westminster Memorial Park the amount due pursuant to such agreement. Should the cost of such services be less than the amount in the trust estate, such excess shall be paid to the estate of the Trustor, or if the estate shall have been closed, to the distributees thereof. Should the cost of the services be more than the amount of the trust estate, then the Trustee shall purchase and pay for such services as Mortuary in Westminster Memorial Park, or its successor in interest, shall certify in writing to Trustee as being the services then available which are most nearly similar to those designated by Trustor at a price which does not exceed the total of the trust estate.

B. The Trustee is hereby authorized to invest and reinvest all sums deposited hereunder (and such additional sums as Trustor may desire to add, if any) during the lifetime of Trustor, in such manner as may be provided by the laws of the State of California for the investment of cemetery endowment funds and trust funds, including investment in the obligations, notes and securities of Mortuary in Westminster Memorial Park, and said sums may be comingled with other funds of other like trust estates held by Trustee. No income shall be payable on said trust funds and any received by Trustee therefrom shall be used by it for maintenance of the trust estate.

C. The Trustee shall insure the unpaid balance of the trust estate to be created under this agreement. The insured must be at least 21 years of age and not over 64 years of age. Said insurance shall become effective as soon as Trustor has paid in 10% of the trust estate that said Trustor desires to create hereunder. Said insurance protection shall be for a maximum of 60 months on the unpaid balance. The insured person must also be the signer of the contract.

D. This trust may be revoked by Trustor at any time upon reasonable written notice to Trustee, and at the expiration of a reasonable time the corpus of the trust estate then held by Trustee shall be distributed to Trustor, or in the event of his prior death, to his estate, or if his estate has been closed to the distributees thereof, less the reasonable cost of establishing this trust and the reasonable cost of necessary services and expenses incurred by, or allowable to the Trustee.

E. In the event of the death or resignation of a Trustee, remaining Trustees may appoint a successor Trustee to fill this vacancy and if none is so appointed, then a successor Trustee may be appointed by Mortuary in Westminster Memorial Park.

F. This trust shall absolutely cease and terminate on the death of Trustor.

G. The Trustee in the discharge of its duties is authorized reimbursement from the principal or income of the trust fund for the reasonable cost of expenses as are necessary and proper in the proper establishment, management and administration of the trust estate.
