Gregory (page 87) shows that Anne married William Viars but in the Viars write-up (pages 64-67) shows "Susannah" as wife of William Viars and lists 7 children of that marriage. The first 3 are girls; other 4 are boys. On the basis of the approximate birth dates of the first 3 daughters, it appears Anne died about 1785. On the basis of birth dates of the 4 sons of William Viars, it appears he married "Susannah \_\_\_\_\_" not long after Anne's death.

- (1) Gregory shows Ann Shepherd married William Viars on page 87 but on page 64 he says William Viars married Susannah Shepherd and the 7 children of William Viars are all listed as issue of Susannah — the first 3 being girls and the last 4 being boys. William was a Revolutionary War veteran and much of Gregory's information is attributed to his pension record.
- (2) John Shepherd's will (below) lists Ann Viars or her 3 daughters as heirs. A possible explanation of this contradiction is that Ann died about 1785 and William married a Susannah \_\_\_\_\_. Therefore only the 3 daughters are shown herein as issue of William & Ann Shepherd Viars. Other possibilities include a) John had already given his grandsons "their inheritance" or b) the write-up on pages 64-67 pertain to another William Viars.
