INDEX TO EARLY HART COUNTY WILLS, 1819-1850

COPIED BY COLONEL BEN LABREE

[When the Hart County Court House, Munfordsville, was completely destroyed by fire on January 3, 1928, all Court House records were burned. The only old records, as far as is now known, are those that were, in their time, sent as official reports to Frankfort and are now preserved there in the Archives Department in The Kentucky State Historical Society. Some of these were published in *The Register of The Kentucky State Historical Society* in May, 1929, pages 473-493, namely: "Hart County Tax List—1819," and "Hart County Death Statistics, 1852-1861." The County was formed from parts of Barren and Hardin by an Act approved January 28, 1819. Its records up to the time of their destruction covered more than a century.

A short time before the fire occurred Colonel Ben LaBree copied the Index to Will Book A, which extended from 1819 to 1850. He then gave a copy of his copy to Mrs. Eugene H. Ray, who in turn presented her copy to The Filson Club. This we here print in full with the page number on which each began. The names are not in strict alphabetical order, but apparently in an undated chronological order, each name under its respective letter. There are only eighty-six wills according to this Index, for the period of thirty-two years. Nothing, however, indicates that this Index represents a selected list of names or is for any other reason only a partial list.

The Year Book of the Kentucky Society Sons of American Revolution, 1896, under the head of Hart County, gives the names of sixteen Revolutionary pensioners, only four of whom, aged about eighty, were still alive in 1840. It is probable none were alive in 1850. Of these sixteen names only two, John Defevers and John Wright, appear in the Index to Hart County Wills, 1819-1850.—*Editor*]:

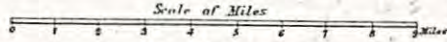

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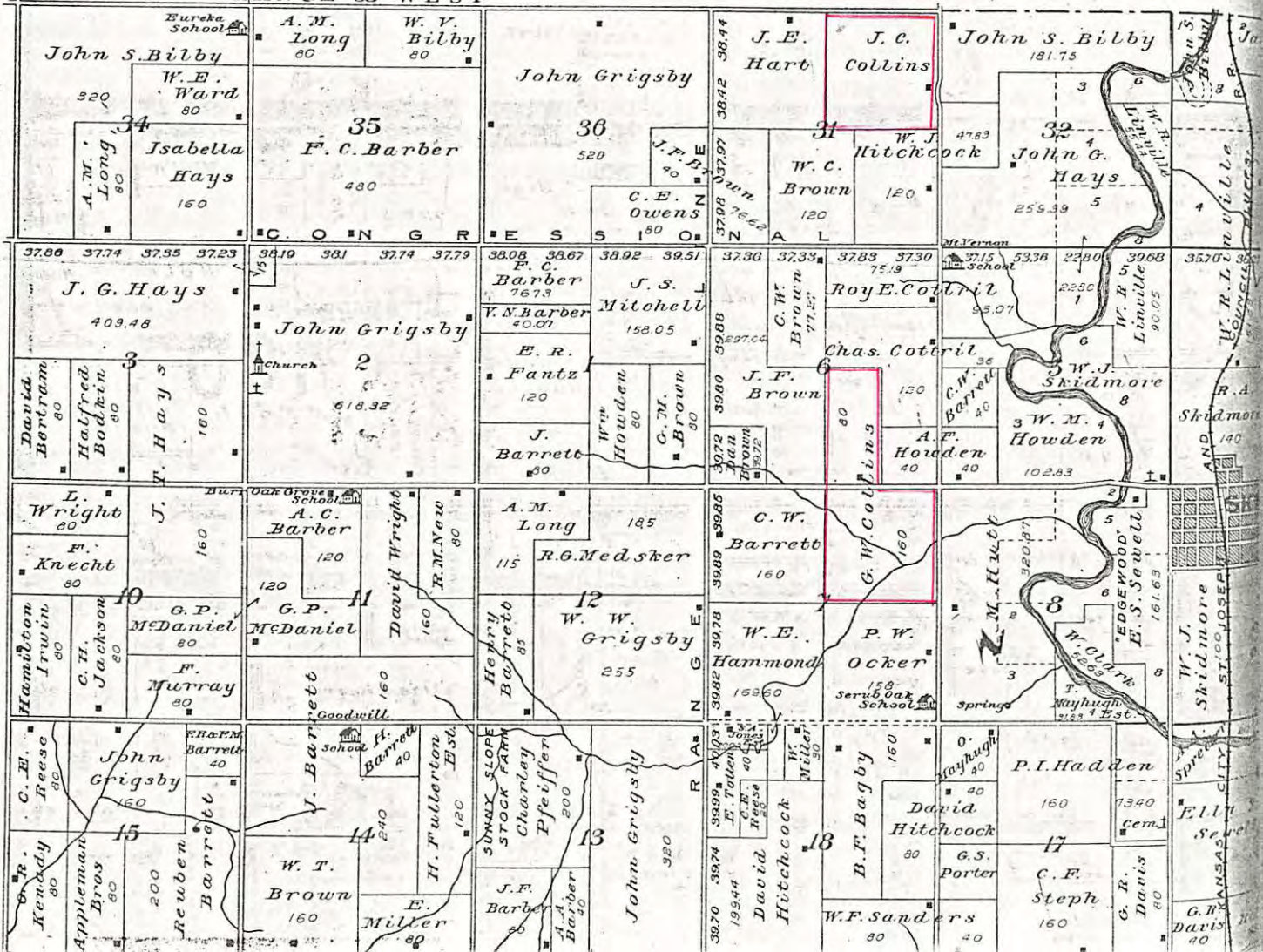

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were Methodists. He accumulated a valuable estate, consisting of five hundred and forty acres of fine bottom land, well improved with good and substantial buildings. He died in 1886, but his wife still survives him and continues to live on the old homestead. The children born to them were Charles O., J. H. and William B., all farmers; Ella L., the wife of our subject; James F. and George N., both farmers; E. M., who is living in the west; Mrs. Amanda McClurg, who died in 1891; Effa, at home; and Albert S.

DANIEL BROWN.

Daniel Brown, who is passing the closing years of a useful and well spent life in retirement from active labor at his pleasant home in Skidmore, was for many years prominently identified with the agricultural interests of this county and met with well deserved success. He was born in Rock Castle county, Kentucky, June 10, 1833, and is a son of Stephen and Barbara (Miller) Brown, the former also a native of that state, the latter of North Carolina. Stephen Brown was the second in order of birth in a family of ten children, the others being John, Jotham, Wilson, Jane, Jonas, William, Polly, Nancy and Betsey. The parents of our subject were married in Kentucky, and to them were born the following children: Mrs. Louisa Debord; John M., a resident of Kentucky; Daniel, our subject; James L., of Kentucky; Mrs. Arminta Thompson, whose second husband was a Mr. McMullen; Jonas, of Kentucky, who served three years in the Confederate army during the Civil war; William T., a farmer of this county; Henry W. and Mason M., both of Kentucky; and

Mary C., the wife of J. Hare, of Missouri. The father spent his entire life as a farmer in his native state, living peacefully and quietly and caring nothing for public notoriety. Both he and his wife are now deceased.

The early education acquired by Daniel Brown was mostly of a practical kind, and he remained under the parental roof until twenty-three years of age, when he married Miss Ruth Watson, also a native of Kentucky and a daughter of Thornton and Martha Watson, who always made their home in that state. The father, who followed farming and also conducted a country store, died at about middle age, and the mother in 1874. In religious belief they were Baptists.

Mr. Brown engaged in farming in Kentucky until 1865, when he removed to Peoria county, Illinois, where he operated rented land for four years. In 1869 he came to Nodaway county, Missouri, and purchased eighty acres of wild land, to which he subsequently added until he had four hundred and forty acres, three miles northwest of Skidmore, which he converted into a well improved and valuable farm. He engaged in general farming and stock raising with marked success until 1899, when he sold the place to his four sons for fifty dollars per acre and bought a handsome residence in Skidmore, where he is now living a retired life, enjoying the fruits of former toil.

Mr. Brown has been called upon to mourn the loss of his estimable wife, who died April 1, 1896. She was a faithful member of the Christian church, to which he also belongs. To them were born ten children, namely: Rhoda A., the wife of J. Collins; George M. and Jonas F., both

farmers of this county; Mrs. Martha Gillilan; Mrs. Betty J. Singleton; Charles W., also a farmer of this county; Hattie M., the wife of B. Bender; Carrie C., the wife of T. Martin; John F., a farmer of this county; and Nettie B., who is now keeping house for her father.

"Uncle Daniel," as he is familiarly known, is a staunch supporter of the Democratic party. He has always been a hard-working man, attending strictly to his own affairs, and being a man of good business ability and sound judgment he has accumulated a handsome competence, which now enables him to spend his declining years in ease and retirement. He is noted for his sterling worth and strict integrity, and he enjoys the confidence and high regard of all with whom he has been brought in contact, either in business or social life.

ROBERT B. GEX.

Among Nodaway county's most prosperous and substantial agriculturists is Robert Brooking Gex, who owns and operates a valuable farm on section 32, Hughes township. He was born in Gallatin county, Kentucky, October 26, 1850, a son of John A. and Henrietta R. (Brooking) Gex, also natives of Kentucky, where they still continue to reside. His paternal grandparents were Anthony and Cyrena Gex, the former a native of Switzerland, the latter of Kentucky, in which state both died. In early life Anthony Gex followed merchandising, but later engaged in farming and also operated large vineyards in the Ohio river valley in Kentucky. He was quite a prominent farmer and slave-owner of that locality. His children were Mary C., the wife of Dr. Hamilton; Sarah L., the wife of Dr. Pegs; Lillie,

the wife of J. Freeman; Caroline, the wife of B. Craig; John A., Lewis, Silas, Luke and Lucian.

When a young man John A. Gex also engaged in mercantile business and in flatboating to New Orleans, but after his marriage located on his present farm and has since given his attention to agricultural pursuits. He is a large land-owner and has one of the best farms in Kentucky. Prior to the Civil war he owned many slaves, but was a strong Union man and took no part in the struggle. In connection with general farming he is engaged in stock-raising, and has a fine herd of shorthorn cattle. He conducts his farm on scientific principles, and has made it one of the model places of the state. As a business man he has met with excellent success, and besides the property already mentioned he has considerable money in the bank and invested in stocks and government bonds.

Politically he was first a Whig and later a Republican, and religiously is a consistent member of the Christian church. For sterling worth and strict integrity he commands the confidence and respect of all with whom he comes in contact either in business or social life. He has always been one of the most prominent and influential citizens of his community and during the dark days of the Civil war was never molested by the southern sympathizers, being one of the few Kentuckians able to buy fire-arms and ammunition in either Cincinnati or Louisville without question. Some of his slaves were drafted and he paid for their substitutes. Though they remained with him and worked to repay him, he paid them their time in full after the war ended. He was a true type of the hospitable southern gentleman, and now in his old age is surrounded by a large circle of friends and acquaintances. He was born
