Will run along for now,and get copies to send with this.Let me say this,I am a very casual person,please call me Virginia or Ginger which ever you feal comfortable with. The period does not alway work on this machine,and I am not a typist so please excuse errors.If I have forgotten something, and I'm sure I have, drop a line and I will get it off if I have it.. Next time your at the post office you might pick up some stamps for me, I would like to return some to Mr Baxter and also have some on hand. I imagine \$4 or 5 Dollars should do it.

ROBERT RUSSELL-SARAH ADAMSON

Thoughts on and about group sheet-

- 1- Information on group sheet from family bible, Civil War records, Cemetery Records, Court Records. I am comfortable with all except birth place of Sarah Adamson. Can not find Gordenshire, England. There is a Gorden, Scotland do you suppose this may be it? I guessed at her year of birth from the age at death.. She died at Canaan/Creston even though her Husband lived in Akron. She had two sons and one daughter living in the Canaan area at the time.
- 2- According to Thomas Russell's Civil War Discharge he came to U.S. in Jan. 1858. Wrong- He applied for citizenship after the War, copy included. Haven't found any for Robert Sr. or Robert Jr.
- 3- Robert Sr and Jr buy property 3 Aug 1858, Thomas never owned much property as his wife inherited a lot when her parents died. Thomas and Emily lived with her Mother all that time. Thomas was a carpenter by trade. He lost three fingers in the war, he then seems to farm the rest of his life. Robert Sr. was a Brickmason, Robert Jr was listed as a Carpenter also on 1860 Census. Later (1870) Merchant..
- 4- Thomas Russell father of Robert Sr. may have been in the construction trade also as children quite often followed their fathers. I do not know if Thomas & Sarah Russell came to Canada. I did find in The Crown Land Records (R.G.I. Series C-I-1) a Thomas Russell 7 Jan 1830 also one dated 29 Sept 1842 North Gower.. One was to buy land from the Crown 1842. The one in 1830 excerpted as follows: Petitioner contracted to open a Road through the Gore of Toronto and part of the Township of Albion ect-----.
If this is my Thomas Russell it would put him in Canada by 1830. Group Sheet for Thomas shows children born in England 1811, 1813 & 1815. Beyond this I haven't found proof of other children born to this couple. I have been reading early church records in and around Loftus and find a lot of Thomas and Roberts in Whitby and Lythe which are close to Loftus. They must be towns of some size as I find more tradesman than usual. Also the name Francis appears in this area and Robert Sr names his last son Francis. I am waiting for the 1734 -1837 rolls to come, I have the 1600 to 1734 and the one one after 1837.
- 5- Back to Robert Sr. group sheet- Mary Guillet came to U.S. July 1864, no husband, three small children. Widow I presume. In a letter to his parents 1862 Thomas suggested his brother George wait till he returned from the war to visit. Beyond this I do not know what happened to George, maybe he helped sister Mary to move to U.S.? Don't know any thing about Hannah Elizabeth may have died or married, a little young but possible. Jane Bateson was from Cavan, Robert Jr. probably came with his family to help settle build a house then went back and married Jane. I found this info in the Durham County Marriage Registers of Ontario Vol 14 1858-1869. At the time of Robert Sr. death only Mary, Sarah, Henry, Robert JR and Thomas as Admin.. were mentioned, if George were alive I am sure he would have been mentioned even if he was'nt left anything. I have the will.

Page 2 of this book please stay with me. Thank you.

- 6- On the group sheet for Thomas & Sarah Russell ----- The marriage of a Hannah Russell to Nicholas Hagerman, Hope Twp. Durham Co. was on L.D.S. Roll 1,276,182 Marriage Bonds also on that roll I see an Eliza Russell wife of Jno. Graham Durham Co. 22 Jan 1831, again a little early but possible
- 7- As to Religious affiliation I am not sure. English records are Church Of England but as we both know all birth,death and marriages had to be recorded in that church. York in this area had quite a few Methodist churches. I have not looked at Non Conformist records yet. Will do after I look at the middle tape I mentioned before.I can say I am just now getting into church records in Wayne Co. Ohio . Thomas Russell my 1st Great Grandfather belonged belonged to the Jackson Pres. Church but I am sure it was only because that is where his wife belonged all her life,He was suspended in 1872 for failing to attend or support this church, I don't know if he ever went back. If Emily had her way I'm sure he did. This was quite a love match and as stubborn as I'm sure Thomas could be I bet Emily got her way. You should see her will:WOW it is great. Thomas died first and left a small piece of property to Emily, no will
- 8- Have often wondered where the family entered the country? My guess would be Buffalo,N.Y., then a boat to Cleveland,Ohio and on to Wayne Co. by land.I wonder why Wayne Co ? Did other families from Canada come to Wayne Co and they followed? A neighbor by the name of Van Dorn was from Canada, have't looked into it as it is not my line .
- 9- I am interested in all collateral lines for Russell and Adamson at this time, may follow some later on if I could find living relatives..
