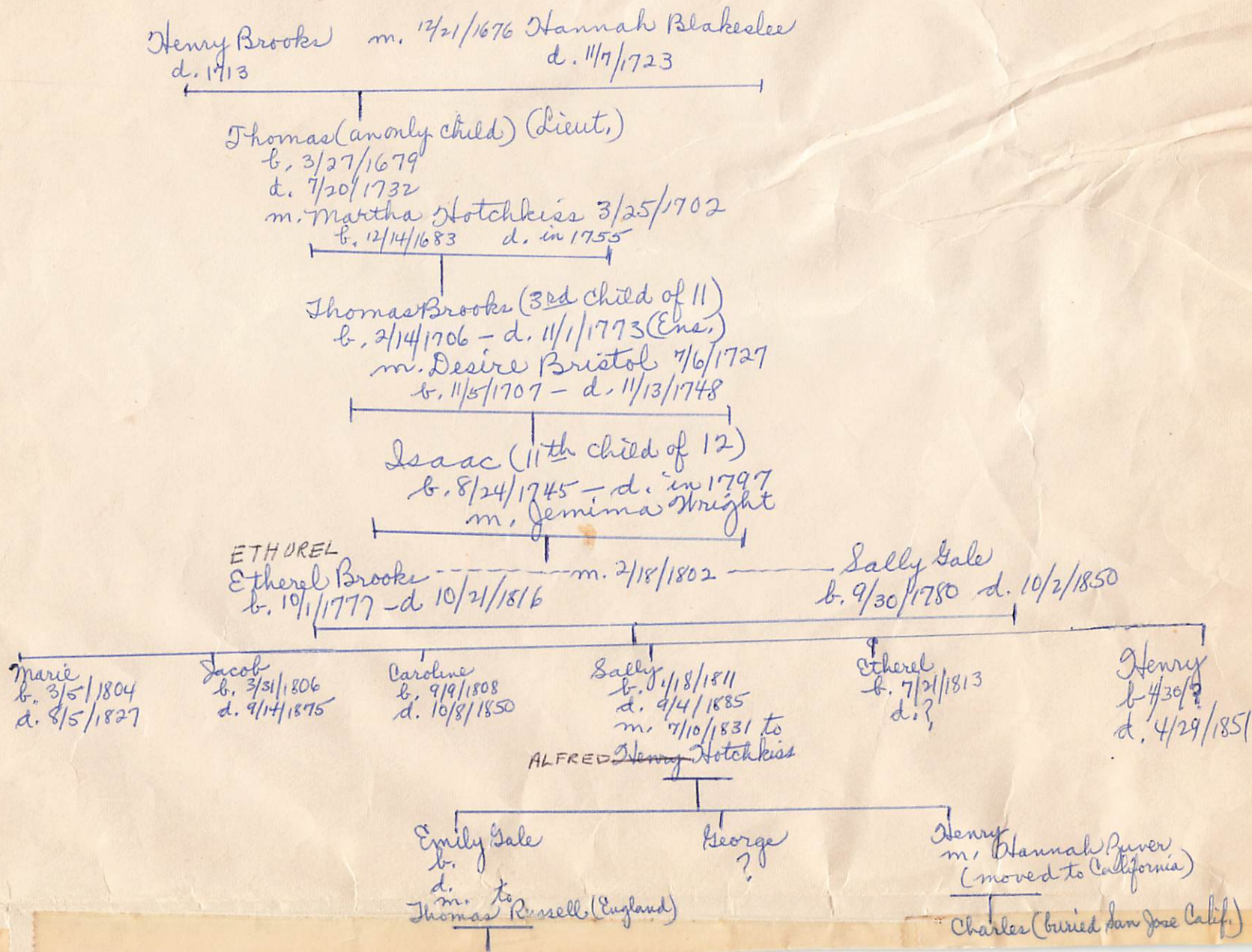


Earliest records of Brooks Family that can be traced directly down to Marie Russell Whitmore was found in "Families of Ancient New Haven" by D. L. Jacobus (Pages 336/339) in Connecticut State Library.

This early record shows two brothers, John and Henry Brooks as having lived in New Haven, Connecticut. No birth dates nor former residences are shown. John had 7 children, all daughters. Henry's line runs down to the present day.

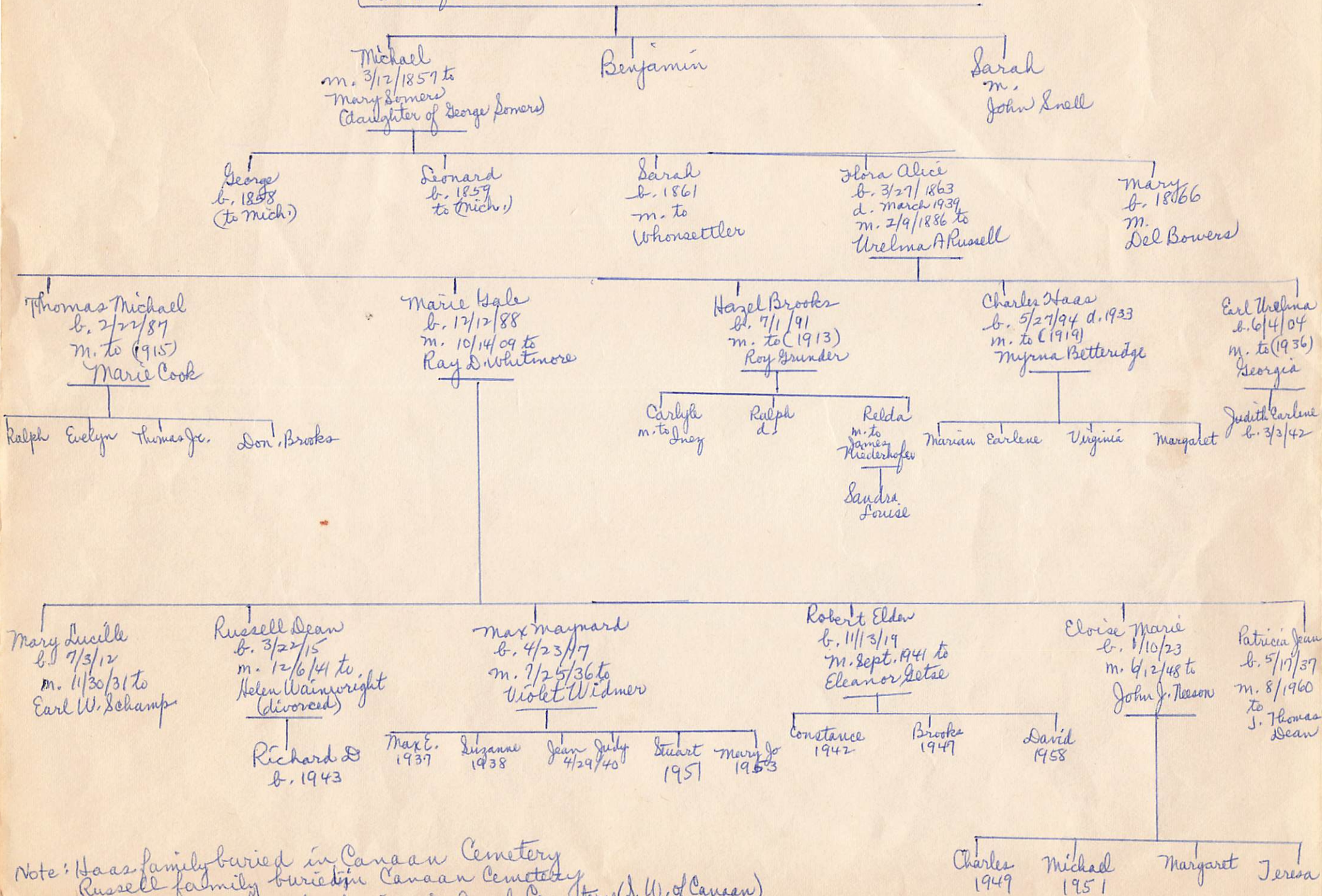
