I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Freeborn H. Brooks, all of my real estate for and during the term of her natural life, and after her death to be divided as follows:- viz:-

To Sarah Ellen Brooks, the two small lots adjoining N. B. Watkins and Richard Kerns, as the fence now stands, also seven acres of land adjoining the said lots, extending west sufficient to include the said seven acres.

I give to my son Clarke J. Brooks, enough land on the south side of his present farm, so as to make the said farm certain one hundred acres.

I give to my grand-children, Frederick M. and Clarke Brooks, children of my deceased son Henry T. Brooks, the remainder of my real estate to be equally divided between.

My son, Clarke J. Brooks, is to have the grass on the meadow bottom of the land conveyed to my said Grand-children, extending as far down as the fence now stands, adjoining his present farm for the term of nine years, unless the said Clarke J. Brooks shall die or make disposition of his farm.

DR. BROOKS IS DEAD

Dean of Medical Profession in County, and One of Its Best-Known Citizens Passes Away at Bedside of Patient Early Saturday.

Had Been Engaged in Active Practice Since 1883, and Was Organizer of County Medical Society. Prominent in Politics and Public Affairs. Funeral Services on Monday Largely Attended.

Dr. Frederick Manning Brooks, dean of the medical profession in Fairfax county, and probably the oldest practicing physician in the State, died suddenly about 6:30 a. m. Saturday morning last at the home of Harlow Rice at Burke. Dr. Brooks had administered a hypodermic to Mr. Rice, and was waiting for the medicine to take effect, when he was stricken and died at his patient's bedside. Dr. E. S. Waring, of Fairfax, was summoned, and pronounced Dr. Brooks dead.

Dr. Brooks was a native of Fairfax county, and was born at Pope's Head, December 23, 1858. He was the son of Henry T. and Helen Hoag Brooks. He had one brother, Clarke Jacob Brooks, who predeceased him dying April 27, 1923. His mother lived to the advanced age of 87 years, and died September 4, 1923. His father was commissioned a captain of volunteers 6th Brigade and 2nd Division of the Virginia Militia in 1862. Capt. Brooks also served as Clerk of the Court here, and was postmaster at Fairfax courthouse, being appointed to the latter position April 26, 1862. Dr. Brooks attended the private schools at the Courthouse, and later the early public school at Pope's Head. He received the degree of Doctor of Medicine from the University of Pennsylvania on April 13, 1883.

Immediately upon his graduation he returned to his native county and began the practice of his profession in June, 1883. He continued in active practice until the date of his death, a period of 58 years. He was the founder and organizer of the Fairfax County Medical Society, the oldest county medical society in the State of Virginia, and served for many years as its president and then as its secretary. He was a lifelong member of the Republican party, and served as chairman of the Republican County committee for over 30 years, holding this position at the time of his death. He was three times nominated by his party as a candidate for

Congress.

He served as a member of the County School Board from Lee District for many years and was Vice President and later Chairman of the board from September, 1922, to June, 1932.

He was one of the original organizers of the National Bank of Fairfax, which was chartered and began business on August 2, 1902. He was elected vice-president of the bank in January, 1903, and served continuously as such until January, 1912, at which time he was elected its president, which position he held at the time of his death.

Dr. Brooks was never married, and lived for many years on his farm situated about half way between the Courthouse and Fairfax Station.

He is survived by the following cousins: Mrs. Edith L. Wilt of Hermiter County, New York; Mrs. May Coon, of Philadelphia; Henry B. Jones, Frank E. Jones, C. P. Jones and Howard Jones of Fairfax County; Mrs. Bessie Hutchison and Mrs. Nellie Fisher, also of Fairfax County; Mrs. Charles Washburn of New York; Messrs. George and Sheldon Gifford of Schenectady, N. Y.; and Dr. Benjamin Jones of Greenville, S. C.

His funeral took place Monday last at 2 p. m., from his late home. The Rev. Herbert Donovan, former Rector of Truro Episcopal Church, Fairfax, and now of Christ Church, Charlottesville, officiated. Active pallbearers were Alex Haight, Garnett Ford, O. W. Chesley, Edgar Littleton, James E. Nickell and Albert Coumbe. The honorary pallbearers included the members of the County Medical Association, Dr. R. E. Feagans and Dr. E. S. Waring of Fairfax; Dr. J. H. Ferguson, of Clifton; Dr. Ford Swetnam, of Alexandria; Dr. Sigmund Newman of Vienna, and Dr. J. T. Vaughan, of Washington. Wilson M. Farr, R. R. Farr, Judge A. C. Ritchie, John M. Whalen and John W. Rust were also among the honorary pallbearers. Burial was in Flint Hill cemetery.

He was three times nominated by his party as a candidate for

Congress.

He served as a member of the County School Board from Lee District for many years and was Vice President and later Chairman of the board from September, 1922, to June, 1932.

He was one of the original organizers of the National Bank of Fairfax, which was chartered and began business on August 2, 1902. He was elected vice-president of the bank in January, 1903, and served continuously as such until January, 1912, at which time he was elected its president, which position he held at the time of his death.

Dr. Brooks was never married, and lived for many years on his farm situated about half way between the Courthouse and Fairfax Station.

He is survived by the following cousins: Mrs. Edith L. Wilt of Hermitage County, New York; Mrs. May Coon, of Philadelphia; Henry B. Jones, Frank E. Jones, C. P. Jones and Howard Jones of Fairfax County; Mrs. Bessie Hutchison and Mrs. Nellie Fisher, also of Fairfax County; Mrs. Charles Washburn of New York; Messrs. George and Sheldon Gifford of Schenectady, N. Y.; and Dr. Benjamin Jones of Greenville, S. C.

His funeral took place Monday last at 2 p. m., from his late home. The Rev. Herbert Donovan, former Rector of Truro Episcopal Church, Fairfax, and now of Christ Church, Charlottesville, officiated. Active pallbearers were Alex Haight, Garrett Ford, O. W. Chesley, Edgar Littleton, James E. Nickell and Albert Cumble. The honorary pallbearers included the members of the County Medical Association, Dr. R. E. Feagans and Dr. E. S. Waring of Fairfax; Dr. J. H. Ferguson, of Clifton; Dr. Ford Swetnam, of Alexandria; Dr. Sigmund Newman of Vienna, and Dr. J. T. Vaughan, of Washington. Wilson M. Farr, R. R. Farr, Judge A. C. Ritchie, John M. Whalen and John W. Rust were also among the honorary pallbearers. Burial was in Flint Hill cemetery.

Oldest Fairfax Physician Feted On 80th Birthday

Dr. Brooks began his medical career here in 1883. He takes an active part in public activities and is serving his 26th year as chairman of the Fairfax County Republican Committee. For more than a quarter of a century he has been president of the National Bank of Fairfax. For a number of years he was chairman of the County School Board and was a candidate of his party for Congress.

In the death of Dr. Brooks, the county has lost one of its best-known and best beloved citizens. Dr. Brooks was in a sense a sort of county institution. He was a typical representative of what is now a fast disappearing type—the old fashioned country doctor. For over two generations he served the people of the county, and when death came to him at last, it found him at the place where so much of his life had been spent—the bedside of a patient.

Few of us perhaps realize the hardships of a country doctor's life. He is obliged to travel regardless of weather, sometimes over all but impassible roads. He can never be sure of an hour of relaxation or a night's rest. He is obliged to treat his patients, deprived in many instances, of the aids which modern medical science has discovered to combat disease. That Dr. Brooks did all this for over fifty years, and continued his work after he had reached an age, when most men consider themselves entitled to spend the remainder of their days in ease and rest, shows clearly the devotion which he had for his profession.

P. M. BROOKS, Republican Candidate for Congress from the Eighth Congressional District, is a native born Virginian. He was born on a farm in Fairfax County in 1858. Dr. Brooks, as he is better known by that title, was raised and worked on a farm. He has spent his entire life in the county of his nativity. As a barefoot boy he tramped several miles to school, where he received his early education, later taking an academic course. He then took up the study of medicine and entered the University of Pennsylvania, graduating from that institution with high honors in 1883. After graduation he returned to his native county to serve and administer to the people with whom he was raised, and loved.

Dr. Brooks has taken an active and lively interest in public affairs in Fairfax County. When the State established a Health Department he was chosen County Health Officer, and has served in that capacity ever since. He has taken a Virginian's pride in the promotion and advancement of the public schools. He has been for many years, and is now an active member of the School Board. He is prominently identified with the business interest of his county, being a farmer, merchant and a banker.

He was one of the original founders and directors of the National Bank of Fairfax, and is its present president. He is a regular attendant of Jerusalem Baptist Church and is at present a member of the Board of Trustees of that Church.

In politics Dr. Brooks has always been a progressive, liberal in his views and broad in his ideas. He is opposed to the League of Nations because he believes that with its various articles it will hamper the freedom of America, and allies us in foreign entanglements, to the end, that it could call American troops to foreign soils to participate in settlement of

their disputes—and to avoid this foreign entanglement he firmly believes in America and loyalty to her traditions as laid down by the founders of our American Institutions and has brought this country to be the most grand and wholesome as well as the most patriotic government ever blessed by the Creator.

The welfare of the farmer is of great interest to Dr. Brooks and he believes that the agricultural department should be empowered to stabilize and protect his stock and products; should require such regulations of railroads as will distribute his marketable products to the end that there can not be in one section an over-production and loss, while in another section, scarcity of foodstuff, high prices, discontent and lack of transportation facilities. He believes in a square deal to organized labor and stands for the principles of a just compensation and protection to their institutions. He will also work for and advocate a better understanding between labor and capital.

Dr. Brooks is in favor of national aid for roads and public highways, and if elected promises to advocate and support any measures of that kind. He is in favor of a better school system in the State and adequate salary for teachers that will insure the services of the highest grade obtainable to teach the youths of our country.

The Fairfax Station community was bereft of one of its best citizens on Friday last when Emmanuel H. Jones was suddenly stricken with heart trouble.

Mr. Jones was apparently in the best of health. Only the evening before he had gone to Chantilly and purchased seeds for his garden. The next morning he complained of an affection which he had thought to be indigestion for several years past. After sending for his son, Clint, he became worse and telephoned for him to come as quickly as possible. When his son arrived, he had revived somewhat, but soon became worse and died before aid could be sought.

A daughter, Mrs. Nellis Fisher, lives in New York.

Mr. Jones led a life which was truly typical of the "Golden Rule." When his neighbors were troubled with sickness or other affliction, he was always prompt with whatever aid lay within his power. He visited the sick and generously gave of what he had. Certainly no man has ever closed his earthly days in this county who was more lived by his neighbors, and whose presence is more keenly missed.


Called by Death.



Henry B. Jones, Served 65 Years As Election Aide


