## THE ENGLISH ANCESTRY OF WILLIAM ACYE OF ROWLEY, MASSACHUSETTS

From the manuscripts of the late TRACY E. HAZEN, Ph. D., of New Tork, N.Y. Prepared for publication by Donald L. Jacobus, by permission of Dr. Robert Hazen of Thomaston, Conn. The English records were obtained by the late Prof. Tracy E. Hazen. Mr. Jacobus has prefaced them with a tentative pedigree to aid in interpreting the documents.

The surname Acye was often spelled Asee in the early records, Acie and Acye in the later ones. The origin of the family was found in Yorkshire in the neighboring parishes of Kirk Ells and Cottingham, and the baptismal record of the emigrant, William Acye, has been found in the former. It is believed likely, but not proved, that the following were brothers and sisters:

- 1. Bryan Acye, see below.
- Peter Acye, see below.
   Agnes Acye, married at Kirk Ella, 11 July 1566, Robert Rysom. Land bought of Robert Rysom, referred to as "uncle," was mentioned in the will of Peter Acye, son of Peter (No. 2).
- Acye, married at Kirk Ella, 24 Nov. 1566, Robert Watson.
- Bryan Acye, born probably by 1530, buried at Kirk Ella, 29 Jan. 1565/6. The name of his wife has not been learned, and the only proved children are the three who were baptized at Kirk Ella; but since two of these are presumably the Sybil and Ralph who mar-ried at Cottingham, it seems a likely hypothesis that the William and Thomas Acye who had children baptized at Cottingham in the next generation were older sons of Bryan, particularly as William named a son Halph, while Thomas witnessed the will of Ralph.
