ANDREWS Family Records, from an ancient Bible printed in England in 1730 A. D., the entries being made nearly a century later. They were copied for "The Searcher" by Elizabeth Fuller Jago of Laguna Beach, California, and the listing was accompanied by a note of explanation written by Homer M. Parsons, who has the book in his possession. It reads, "The leather-bound Bible, printed in 1730 (the title page of the New Testament bears a date two years earlier, MDCCXXVIII) was the property of Gertrude Mary (Shouler) Rumsey, a descendant of the Thomas Palmer Andrews whose marriage to Sarah Harris May 11, 1820, is the first entry in the list of family records. The Andrews family, and the later Shoulers and Rumseys, claimed collateral descent from Lancelot Andrewes (1555-1626), prominent among the translators

of the King James version of the Bible. The four children of Mary Gertrude Rumsey died without issue, and the Bible found its place on my shelves when my wife, born Ethel Gertrude Rumsey, died in 1956. William W. Rumsey became a Baptist missionary, taking his wife and two children to Jamaica, where the two youngest daughters were born. While there he discovered a cave which had been used by Arawak Indians of an unknown earlier era as a burial ground. He assembled two or three of the skeletons, one of which is in a museum in Kingstown, another in the West Indian room of the British Museum. Sending his family back to England, he came to the States, preached his way through Rush Medical College in Iowa, and when his family rejoined him they settled in Napa, California. He owned the first automobile in that city—a Pope-Hartford!
