SOLDIER, HUSBAND, FATHER, CARETAKER

Flavius Gustavus Arrowsmith (Gus to his friends), was born 15 Jan 1839 in Pennsylvania to Edward Arrowsmith and Sarah Field. He learned the trade of printer while working for a newspaper in Easton, PA. He later held a case on the Philadelphia Daily Express. When the civil war broke out, he was quick to volunteer for service. Within eight days of the attack on Fort Sumter he joined the 1st regiment Pennsylvania Volunteers Company D as Corporal on April 20, 1861. He soon found himself in the famous Battle of Bull Run on July 21st. At the end of his three month tour with the First Regiment of the Pennsylvania Volunteers, he enlisted with the Federal Army as sergeant in the 110th and 115th Regiments of the Pennsylvania Infantry. He remained in the service until the end of the war.

He was wounded several times while serving and nearly lost his life at the Battle of Gettysburg. He had three gunshot wounds in his left leg and was struck in the forehead head with a conoidal musket ball while at Gettysburg on July 2, 1863. On July 11th he was sent to McClellan Hospital in Philadelphia and was released April 14, 1864 after nine months in recovery. A monument for the 115th Pennsylvania Volunteers carries his name as Sergeant of Company G.

On July 5, 1863 three days after being severely wounded, his wife Mary Anna (Brannon) Arrowsmith passed away leaving a daughter Anna Ida Arrowsmith born Sep 22, 1862.

After being discharged June 24, 1865 he took his daughter west to Quincy, Illinois. He had Aunts, Uncles and a grandmother Arrowsmith in Adams County. In Quincy he married 22 Oct 1868 Mary Kimball a daughter of Edward B Kimball, a Quincy pioneer and close friend of John Wood. See the Descendant Chart for Flavius for more information on his family.

Flavius found work as a printer in Quincy working for the Quincy Whig for thirty years. He was released from his job when the linotypes were used to automatically set type. Flavius then found work with printing shops in Quincy. Flavius was a republican and served as an election judge.

About 1900 Flavius turned his attention to work with The Associated Charities, being in charge of the office of the association. Through the Quincy Daily Journal; Jan 12, 1900, Page 7, Flavius put out the need for donations and support from the citizens of Quincy. By April 14th 1900 Flavius closed the charity work for the year telling a reporter that 250 families were saved from want and misery the past winter.
