D.K. Bryant 's grandmother was Elizabeth Aten. His mother went to Geneseo, N.Y. and attended a normal school there after she graduated from High school in Yankton, S. D. She told of an old War of 1812 uniform head piece that was there so someone must have served in that war. His mother said the Aten's were Pennsylvania Dutch.

Do you remember who else was in Livingston Co. New York? On the end of the Reunion Notes was a note about Peter and Garrett and the different Counties. Among them Livingston, N.Y.

Adrian Hendrickse Aten born in Utrecht Holland about 1630. Died in Brooklyn, N. Y. about 1708. Known children:- Marritje, Paul, Annetje and Helena of whom no record is available. Also Hendrick who married Maria DeMott and had two children: John married Lisbet Thomas and Thomas born about 1674, married Elsje Schillman and died 12/10/1757. Children of Thomas and Elsje:- John, Jannetje, Mertien (of whom there is no record available) and Adrian born 9/4/1695, married Jacobje Middagh, died 5/16/1782. Children:- (Adrian and Jacobje) Annetje born 8/25/1719, Cathalynne 1/27/1726, Marritje 1/15/1728, Cathalyntje 7/29/1730, Jan and Gerardus 12/22/1732, Judick 7/9/1735 and Adrian 11/7/1737. Also Dirck born 8/22/1721 died 1808. Known children (of Dirck):- Adrian (or Aaron) who was born in 1753, married Martha Beers in 1776 died 4/20/37 and is buried at Hopewell Cemetery, Allegheny County, Pa. (Aaron is the ancestor of the Eatons who live on the Backbone Road just over the Beaver County line)

The correct ancestral name of this family is ATEN but about the beginning of the nineteenth century some of the family seemed to become ashamed of their Dutch ancestry and began to call themselves EATON.

Hendrick (son of Adrian and Jacobje) born 9/3/1723, married Mary Bellos died about 1782. Children:- John born 4/9/1777 died 12/1/49; Sarah married Thomas Beers; Hendrick - no record available; George (no record yet available as to birth, marriage or death) George came West with his brother Thomas and very likely in company with his cousins Aaron and Richard. Children:- Henry born 1805 died 1885 married Sarah Hood buried at Hopewell. He was a river captain, Ally. Co. Prothonotary 1860-1863; grandfather of John P. Eaton of Sewickley, Mrs. R. A. Taylor of East McKeesport. John no record. Charles married Suzanne Meloney. Margaret and Sarah no record. Jane married Samuel Meloney Jr.

Thomas Aten son of Hendrick and Mary Bellos Aten - next page.

Richard Aten head of the family branch located near Enlow married Nancy McMurtrie; born 1766, died 1829, buried at Montours; others of this branch are buried at Carnot. Among the living are Jennie A., Paul M and Charles R., R F D Coraopolis; Dr. John Aten, Ambridge and Rev. Henry Aten. (This branch of the family retain the correct name of Aten)

Washington County Atens - Bulger, Midway and Candor - retain the ATEN spelling. A good guess is that they are descendants of a cousin of our Thomas Aten. Expect to get them correctly later.
