In response to the Editors note in the August issue of the "Eswau Huppeday" concerning the Order of Red Men the following is submitted.

The Order of Red Men is a fraternal organization much like the Masons. It was founded in 1765, out of the Sons of Liberty a group who worked "underground" to help establish liberty and freedom in the early colonies.

After the American Revolution their name was changed to The Improved Order of Red Men. The first Tribe organized under the Improved Order of Red Men in Baltimore in 1835 was designated as Tribe #1 and Chartered by the Maryland Legislature. The present national organization operates under a Charter granted by The Congress of the United States. This Charter was signed by President Theodore Roosevelt, April 17, 1906.

This non-profit Patriotic Fraternity is devoted to inspiring a greater love of the United States of America and the principles of American Liberty. The National Charity of the organization since 1991 is Alzheimers's Research.
