The Rev^d **John Avery** of Truro their first Settled pastor. Must have Married to **Miss Ruth Little** about the Time of his Ordination, I think in May – AD 1710 –

His Eldes Son **John** married a **Miss Mary Dem**— [*over something crossed out*] They Settled in Boston. They had two daughters one married a **M^r Collings** of Rhode Island and settled there. The other married a **M^r Price** and settled in Boston. They had allso an only son **John Avery**. He was Deputy Secatery of the State, the whole time of the Revolutionary war. He was chosen the first Secretary of the State, of Massechuset, after its organisation into a State by a Constitution, and continue[d] their Secretary by choice a number of years.

Ephriam son of **John and Ruth Avery** was a clergyman, settled in Brooklin State of Connecticut. He was pastor of a prisbyterian church there. He married a **Miss Lathrop**. **Ephriam** Died in the prime of life.

Ruth eldest daughter to **John and Ruth Avery** – Married to a **Mr Parker** clergyman of Plimton **Miss** pastor of a church there and died there She left several children and Husband to mourn her loss

Samuel Averys Widdow married to **Jeams Collings** of plimmoth Massachusets and had a number of children and Died there in a good old age perhaps about 85.

His Widdow's name was **Hannah Snow** – She was of Truro – She lived a number of years after his death a Widdow And than Died and was buried in Truro
