Also found in this file are a group of copied pages from *Tyler's Quarterly Historical and Genealogical Magazine*, Richmond, VA, Vol. XVI, No. 1 & 4, July 1934 and April 1935. When I came across this Bible in the file of unpublished Bibles, I felt this would be a good time to give information about the Banks family. Recently I've had numerous emails from people trying to locate copies of "*The Banks of Elbert County*" compiled by Mrs. Sarah Banks Franklin of Rome, GA. Since she has been dead for many years, there have been questions as to whether there are copies of the 3rd Edition still available or is it out of print. By coincidence I heard from a Mr. Ross Banks who lives in Elbert Co., GA and he was able to give me a much needed answer to these questions about this particular book. Mrs. Franklin's daughter lives right here in Athens, Mrs. Annette Jackson, 255 Greystone Trl., Athens, GA 30605. According to Mr. Banks, this volume hasn't been available for about 10 years and there doesn't appear to be any plans for a reprint.

In the early years of *FAMILY PUZZLERS*, my mother published a good bit about the Banks family of Elbert Co. and also became the publisher for Mrs. Franklin of that 3rd Edition of her book. In looking through the Banks family file, I've found that there are many issues of FP which contained information about this family or one of it's allied families, i.e. Traylor issues. There are also several Bible
