EXCHANGES & LIBRARY PLACEMENT: Our publication is exchanged with other genealogical and historical societies and is placed in several libraries at no charge. Publications received are shelved in the Steele Memorial Library, Elmira, New York.

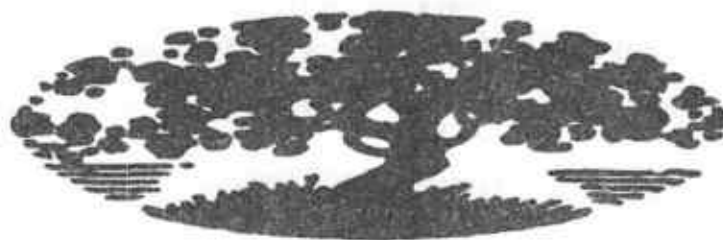
