Boyd, Edwin: (son of Homer & Charlotte of Ohio) m. (Mo.?) ca 1875

Tina/Drucilla Ward (said to be desc. of Capt. Francis Drake); to area

of Cameron, Mo.

Bradley, Ann: m. (Pa.?) ca 1835 Jacob Kettle Fore (son of David H. &

Eliz. (Kettle) Fore of Bedford Co., Pa.); to Jefferson Co., Iowa & to

Gentry Co., Mo.

Brown, Thomas: m. (Mo.?) ca 1860 Rebecca Tucker. Their dau Alie m. at

Berlin, Mo. 1888 David Napoleon Fore, grandson of Jacob K. Fore.

Calvin, John: m. (Ky.?) ca 1815 Margaret Dorrison. Dau Ann m. William

Terrill (son of Robert & Mary (Lacy) Terrill; to Randolph Co., Mo.

Christian, John: m. Va. 1772 Judith Pate (dau of Jeremiah, gr-dau of

Matthew Pate); to Lexington, Ky. 1788; Rev. War soldier (not to be con-

fused with John C. also of Lexington who m. Judith Leek & was also Rev.

soldier.)

Coleman, Thomas: m. Va. ca 1750 Millicent Winn (dau of John & Mary

(Pledger) Winn.

Ford, Wm.: b. N. C. or Tenn.? 1802; m. Rebecca Tibbets 1822. (See Beal-

mear, above. William Ford's mother may have been a Winchester.

Fore, David H.: m. Elizabeth Kettle (when & where?); desc. in McConn-

ellsburg, Pa., Iowa, Mo., Okla., Calif. May be from Fuhr/Fuhrer, German.

Lacy, Thomas: b. Wales ca 1665; m. a Rice/Rhuys (Va.?) Anc. of Mary Lacy

who m. Robert Terrill.

Lampton, Wm.: b. County Durham, England 1724; m. Martha/Patsy Schooler

of Va.; to Clark Co., Ky. (Anc. of Samuel L. Clemens/Mark Twain)

Lane: Temperance Lane m. John Sutton of Va. (q.v.)

McKinsey, William: (son of John & Bridget?) b. Md. 1775; m. 1796 Nancy,

dau of Wm. & Patsy (Schooler) Lampton, above; res. Clark & Campbell Cos.,

Ky. Was Wm. bro of David McKinsey of Campbell & Kenton Cos., Ky.?

Robertson, Melissa: m. Gentry Co., Mo. 1861 Hays Bradley Fore, son of

Jacob K. Fore; to Medford, Okla. where Melissa d. 1915. Her parents?

Sears, Thomas: m. Va. ca 1750 Eliz. (who?); desc. to Ky., Ill., Mo. A

gr-grandson, Wiley, m. Mo. 1830 Nancy Ryals & their son Silas Watson

Sears m. 1863 Samantha Griffin, dau of Joseph & Sarah (Gross) Griffin

of Macon Co., Mo. Dau Martha Sears m. George Bealmer, grandson of Alfred

& Mary (Ford) Bealmer. Bealmear a French name? Or German?

Sutton, John: Rev. War soldier; desc. listed in Sutton-Lane book by Golds-

borough & Fisher, pub. 1941 in Lexington, Ky.

Spaht, Karl/Charles: b. Baden-Baden, Germany 1830, to U. S. 1847; m.

Atherine, dau of Conrad Klein b. Germany & Melinda (Wise) b. Alsace-

orraine; dau Ida Spaht m. Mo. 1904 Homer Boyd, son of Edwin above.

Terrill, Timothy: (son of Richmond?) b. New Kent Co., Va. 1658; m. Elizabeth Foster, dau of John; their son Robert m. Mary Foster; a son Edmund Terrill m. Culpeper Co., Va. 1760 Margaret/"Peggy" Willis (see Willis); son Robert Terrill m. Mary Lacy 1799 Va.? Ky.? (Note two lines from Terrill-Lacy -- Beale-Terrill & Terrill-Calvin.)

Watts, Frances/Fanny: m. Thomas Yager (Va.?) See below.

Willis, John: (son of William & Sarah) m. Stafford Co., Va. 1734/5 Elizabeth Plunkett of King George Co., Va. Who were her parents? Dau Margaret m. Edmund Terrill, above: Margaret res. Ky. 1816 with dau Luoy & husband, Rowland Botts.

Winn, Thomas: m. Dorothy Hines; son John res. Westmoreland Co., Va. had son Richard b. ca 1670 m. Sarah (who?) and had son John who m. Mary Pledger. (See Coleman.)

Ward, Drucilla/Tina: m. Edwin Boyd ca 1875. Who were her parents?

Yager, Thomas: m. ca 1815 (Va.?) Frances/Fanny Watts; to Randolph Co., Mo. where Fanny res. 1850 with son Thomas Watts Yager & bride Sarah (Blackford). Census gives age of Thomas Yager 60, Fanny 63, Thomas W. 29, Sarah 19; in same household was Susan Cash, 13.

Some Notes and Comments:

Beale: Of several families studied, most likely seem to be either William Beal (1667-1714) of Bucks Co., Pa. through grandson Benjamin (b. ca 1725, d.s.p.); or John Beal of Hingham, Mass., from Norfolk, England to Boston, Mass. on the Diligent, arrived Aug. 10, 1638. Our Thomas Beale b. Feb. 14, 1784 (where?) had bro William; both in War of 1812, from Frederick Co., Va.; became separated and never got together again. No other known ch, and no data on Samuel and Sarah.

Bealmear: Perhaps from Samuel of Maryland who m. a Magruder and went to Ky.; had bro, Maj. Francis Bealmear b. France, d. Md. 1782; Rev. War service; m. Elizabeth Brewer, dau of John and ? (Pierpont) Brewer of Annapolis. Were there other brothers? Names of Francis, Samuel, Claude, Daniel, Harriet run in lines of Maryland and Missouri families. A Richard Claude Bealmear/Belmer of Macon Co., Mo. m. 1852 in Randolph Co., Mo. Mary Jane (Burton) Malone, widow of Robert. We cannot place Richard in our family. He d. July 6, 1893/8 (date on monument not clear), age 74, bur. Oakland cem., Moberly, Mo. Ch: Sarah Martha, m. a Midcap/Metcalf; Alice Zayda, m. James T. Fallow/Blue; James/Jim, unm.

McKinsey: David M. McKinsey witnessed deeds, Campbell Co., Ky. 1828 and 1833 together with William McKinsey, Jr. for William McKinsey, Sr. (my gr-grandfather). David b. Md., d. Fiskburg, Ky. (Kenton Co.) April 16, 1859, age 79. Parents, John and Bridget. Was David bro of Wm. Sr.? Other bros? David's wife not known; his ch: Susan, m. Spencer Faulkner; Joseph T. McKinsey, m. Susan Jane (who?); Mary, m. Thomas Ragan; Anna McKinsey; I. R. McKinsey (Isaac?) (m. Virginia E. Southgate?)

Joseph T. McKinsey/McKenzie and wife, and the Faulkners and Ragans, res. Kenton Co., Anna and I. R. (widower?) res. Boone Co. in 1868 when they sold house and lot in Independence to M. G. Bagby of Independence.

I. R. McKenzie m. Boone Co., Ky. 1869 Virginia M. Platt. Same man?
