To the Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions wheras Abner Camp decd. died without making any provision for his family by will or other wise and whereas he was siezed of certain personal estate, stock and other provisions. Your petition being the widow of the said Abner Camp decd therefore pray your worship to appoint a justice of the peace and three free holding an connected with said widow to lay off and allow to have one years provisions out of the crop stock and provisions on hand and alas one wheel and cards and bed and furniture according to Act of Assemble in such cases made and provided as in duty bound. The will ever pray.

not sufficient of the Crop, Stock and Provisions on hand, to as-  
sess the value of the deficiency in money to be paid by the Ad-  
ministrator. And also to lay off and allot to the said widow, one  
Bed and its necessary furniture, one Wheel and a pair of Cards,  
if such articles be among the goods of her deceased husband,  
and put her in possession of the same, as her absolute property,  
and make report of their proceedings under their hands and  
seals to next Court.
