John Case resided in Windsor, Conn. until 1669, when he was one of company that settled Simsbury, Hartford Co., Conn. He was appointed constable for Massacoe (now Simsbury) by the General Court October 14, 1669, being the first person that ever held office at that place. He represented his town at the General Court in 1670, and several times afterwards. His house in Windsor (probably built by a former owner) was on the corner of Mill Highway and Bloomfield Avenue, where the Methodist Episcopal Church is now (1908) standing. His lot extended on the avenue about 33 rods, about 14 rods on the mill road. His lot "where on his house standeth" had not been recorded before 1669. "It was first given to Benjamin Newberry, now Captain, and had been possessed by several owners before." He sold his house, and lot, and shop, to Nathaniel Cook in 1689.
