

## CRUTTENDEN

REF.: Abraham Cruttenden of Guilford, Conn., and Some of His Descendants  
N.E. Gen. Register, Volume 52, p. 466

1. Abraham (1) Cruttenden was one of the first settlers of Guilford and was one of the twenty five signers of the Plantation Covenant in 1639. It is said that he came from the county of Kent in England and had been a neighbor of William Chittenden, whose widow he afterwards married. He was probably married in England about 1630 and was probably about 28 or 29 years old at the time of the settlement of Guilford. He died in January 1683, aged about 73 years. None of his children's births are recorded in Guilford, though some must have been born after he came to that place. On April 30, 1646, he was appointed "overseer of the mill by dams or floodgates." on June 6, 1651 he was chosen assessor and on June 9, 1653, townsman. In addition to his homelot he owned, "a parcel of upland twenty acres abutting to the common woods," a "parcel of marsh land to the South ten and one-half acres" and a "parcel of upland over against the mill" containing 19 acres. The name is also spelled Cruttenden. He married first Mary \_\_\_\_\_, who d. 1664; second, widow Joanna Chittenden May 31, 1665. She died August 16, 1668. His children were all by his first wife as follows
  - i. Mary(2), b. about 1632; died September 11, 1669; married Deacon George Bartlett of Guilford September 14, 1650. He died August 3, 1669.
  - ii. Abraham, born about 1635; died September 25, 1694. More below
  - iii. Thomas, born about 1637; died Feb. 8, 1698. He was a tailor and never married. On Feb. 20, 1689-90 he gave land to his nephew Abraham(3).
  - iv. Elizabeth, born about 1639; married 1. Capt. John Graves in 1670. (He came from Hartford to Guilford and died Dec. 31, 1695.) (2) John Sperry of New Haven (3) Benjamin Bennett or Burnett
  - v. Isaac, born about 1643; died July 13, 1685. He resided on his father's homelot in Guilford; married, Lydia, daughter of Anthony Thompson of New Haven Sept. 20, 1665. After his death she married Dea. John Meigs who died Nov. 9, 1713. He was an active member of that party in Guilford which favored union with Connecticut. She was born July 24, 1647 and died December 1729. Nine children.
  - vi. Hannah, born about 164-; married George Miland of Guilford in 1665. He died December 31, 1692.
  - vii. Deborah, born about 164-; married \_\_\_\_\_ Hatch and died April 20, 1658.
2. Abraham (2) Cruttenden, Jr. (Abraham(1)) of Guilford was one of the smaller farmers of the town. He married Susannah, daughter of Mr. Thomas Griegson, on May 13, 1661. She died September 8, 1712. Their children were
  - i. Abraham(3), born March 8, 1662; died May 14, 1725. Of Guilford. Was assessed £185 2 6. in 1716 and had a two acre homelot which was given him by his uncle Thomas. He married Susannah, daughter of John Kirby, May 6, 1686. She died October 1729. Six children
  - ii. Sarah, born August 21, 1665; died October 1692; married Thomas Robinson, Jr., of Guilford October 3, 1686. He died July 2, 1712.
  - iii. Thomas, born Jan. 31, 1667/8; died September 14, 1754. See below.
  - iv. John, born August 15, 1671; died May 16, 1751. Of Guilford. Married May 6, 1703, Bathsheba, daughter of Isaac Johnson. She died April 25, 1752. Seven children.
  - v. Joseph, born April 9, 1674; died Feb. 6, 1753. Ensign Joseph Cruttenden of Guilford married Mercy, daughter of Jonathan Hoyt, May 2, 1700. She was born Feb. 10, 1678 and died Jan. 3, 1750. He was made ensign May 13, 1728. He was assessed at £88 13.6 in 1716. Six children
3. Lieut. Thomas(3) Cruttenden of E. Guilford seems to have been a large landholder in the vicinity of the Hammonasset River. He married 1. Abigail Hull, daughter of John of Killingworth and Abigail Kelsey, Sept. 11, 1690. (She was born Sept. 30, 1669; died 1710); (2) Elizabeth, daughter of John Chittenden, \_\_\_\_\_ 1711. She died August 1, 1712. Thomas Cruttenden was chosen Lieutenant of militia October 21, 1716 and was assessed in that year at £108. 17. 0. He had nine children all but one of them by his first wife.

- i. Abigail, born December 23, 1691; died Nov. 6, 1735; married Samuel Buel May 3, 1711
- ii. Sarah, born Feb. 6, 1693/4
- iii. Thomas, born 1698; d. June 2, 1786; married (1) Lydia Darrow of Long Island October 4, 1726. (She died July 7, 1766). (2) Rebecca \_\_\_\_\_, who died September 21, 1787. He had 8 children and lived in Guilford.
- iv. Esther, born 1700; died April 24, 1778; married Ebenezer Benton of N. Guilford November 3, 1725. He died Feb. 11, 1776.
- v. Lydia, born 1704; married at Wallingford, Conn., in 1756, Ebenezer Hough of Goshen
- vi. Hill, born 1706; died September 24, 1794; married (1) Hannah, daughter of Stephen Bishop; (2) Submit, daughter of Nathaniel Parks of N. Guilford. She d. August 18, 1802. He had four children.
- vii. Susannah, born 1707; died September 15, 1751; married Timothy Bartlett, 1728. He died December 3, 1773.
- viii. Josiah, born 1709; died January 22, 1776; married Hester Murray, daughter of Jonathan, December 15, 1737. She died October 10, 1781. They had seven children.
- ix. Elizabeth, born 1712; died March 11, 1789; married John Crumpton of Guilford, July 20, 1732. He died June 29, 1790.

Deacon Samuel (3) Cruttenden (Isaac(2), Abraham(1)) of Guilford married Mindwell, daughter of Deacon John Meigs on September 8, 1702. She was his stepfather's daughter and died March 31, 1762. He resided on the original homelot, facing the West River. His children were eight.
