## IN MEMORIAM:

### ELDRIDGE MAXON DA LEE

Eldridge Maxon Da Lee was born 16 June 1916 at Bissell, Lee County, MS. He died 18 Jan 1993 at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Jackson, MS after a short illness. He was laid to rest in the Verona Cemetery. He was an ex-Mayor of Verona, MS. His parents were Frank Da Lee and Minnie Kennedy Da Lee. He was married to Connie Montgomery and they had one daughter, Constance Hershfelt of Nettleton, MS, who survives him.
