GENEALOGY OF THE DAVENPORT FAMILY

TWENTY-FIFTH GENERATION

Ormus de Dauneporte, born in 1086, and assumed the local name in the County of Chester, England. He witnessed a charter of enfranchisement of Gilbert Venables, in the time of William II., or Henry I.

TWENTY-FOURTH GENERATION

Richard de Dauneporte, born in 1136, to whom Hugh Kevelioc, earl of Chester, granted by charter the chief forestership of the forests of Leek and Macclesfield, about 1166, and who had a moiety of the township of Marton by marriage, about 1176. His wife was Amabilia, the daughter of Gilbert Venables, baron of Kinderton, whose father, Gilbert Venables, was the Norman grantee of Kinderton, Davenport, etc., before 1086.

TWENTY-THIRD GENERATION

Thomas de Davenporte, living in the time of Henry II., or before 1189.

TWENTY-SECOND GENERATION

Richard de Davenporte, to whom Randle Blundeville, earl of Chester, granted by charter acquittance from suit in the Shire and Hundred Court, for himself and heirs, between 1209 and 1226. (Issue of Richard de Davenport: Amicia Davenporte, Vivian de Davenporte, Walter Davenporte, and Peter Davenporte)

TWENTY-FIRST GENERATION

Vivian de Davenporte, to whom Randle Blundeville, earl of Chester, granted by charter, the grand sergeancy of the forests of Leek and Macclesfield, between 1209 and 1226, the also acquittance of juris of County and Hundred. Married Beatrix, daughter of Bertrand de Hulme. (Issue of Vivian de Davenporte: Roger Davenport of Davenport, Edward de Davenport de Newton, Richard de Davenport, Robert de Davenport, Beatrix Davenport, and Thomas de Davenport)

TWENTIETH GENERATION

Roger Davenport of Davenport, who married Mary, daughter of Robert Salemon of Wythington, with whom her husband had a moiety of Wythington, also a part of Tunstede and Wultroke (Wheltrough).

By an inquisition taken before Reginald de Gray, 16 year of Edward I. (1288), it is found that Roger de Davenport held his sergeancy in the Hundred of Macclesfield in the Bach etc., and that he shall find eight sergeants (one a horseman) to keep the peace, who shall come at the king's summons, at their own cost in the county, and at the king's cost when they shall have passed the Dee, or gone out of the county. The same Roger, in 1248, witnessed a deed of Alexander Wythington. He seems to have died in 1291. Issue of Roger de Davenport: Peter de Davenport, Sir Thomas Davenport of Davenport, John de Davenport, Ellen Davenport, and Henry Davenport of Marton.

NINETEENTH GENERATION

Sir Thomas Davenport of Davenport, knight, married, first, Agnes, daughter of Thomas de Macclesfield, who was born in 1287. She was the mother of his issue. His second wife was Roesia, daughter of Ralph de Vernon, and Widow of Sir William de Brereton. Sir Thomas died in 1320, and his widow survived him in 1322. Issue of Sir Thomas Davenport: Sir John Davenport, Thomas Davenport de Wheltrough, Roger Davenport, senior, Peter Davenport, Roger Davenport, Mallicent Davenport, and Roesia Davenport.

EIGHTEENTH GENERATION

Thomas Davenport de Wheltrough, to whom his father gave lands in Withington, Wheltrough, Marton, etc., etc., who became the ancestor of the Davenports of Wheltrough, Henbury, Coventry, Bromhall, and Woodford, (now also of Capesthorpe.) He married Elizabeth who survived her husband in 1339. Issue: Thomas Davenport, John Davenport, Sir John Davenport, and Alice Davenport.

SEVENTEENTH GENERATION

Sir John Davenport, (called also Jenkin, to distinguish him from his elder brother of that name,) knight, justice of Lancastershire, 1384, and who became the purchaser of Henbury. He married Elizabeth, daughter and coheir of Peter Legh of Betcherton. Issue: Margaret Davenport, Thomas Davenport, John Davenport, Nicholas Davenport de Widford, and Griffin Davenport.

SIXTEENTH GENERATION

Thomas Davenport, ancestor of the Davenports of Henbury, named 1st, in the Henbury entail, 1366, and 3d, in the Woodford entail, 1371. He married Margaret, daughter of Hugh Venables, who was afterwards married to Sir William Newport. Issue: Hugh Davenport and Thomas Davenport of Butley.

FIFTEENTH GENERATION

Hugh Davenport of Henbury, who married for his first wife, Ellen, daughter of William Massey, Esq. She was the mother of his issue. His second wife was Jane, daughter of Sir Thomas Whootton of Chester, knight, Inq. post mortem, 1418. Issue: Thomas Davenport, Margery Davenport, Margaret, Davenport, Parnell Davenport, William Davenport, and John Davenport.

FOURTEENTH GENERATION

Thomas Davenport, of Henbury, who married Margery, daughter of Randle Mainwaring of Carincham. Issue: Thomas, Parnell, Agnes, William, John, Richard, and Ralph Davenport.

THIRTEENTH GENERATION

Richard Davenport, who appears from the pedigrees to have first removed to the County of Northampton, adjoining Warwickshire, and then to have settled at Coventry, in the latter county, about the year 1510. His wife was a daughter of Venables. Issue: Edward Davenport.

TWELFTH GENERATION

Edward Davenport of Coventry, who married a daughter of John Harford, Alderman of Coventry. In 1534, he was chosen to the city office of Chamberlain, and in 1540 to that of Sheriff. In 1550, he was chosen Mayor of Coventry, and during the time of his Mayoralty overruled all this county. Issue: Henry Davenport and Christopher Davenport.

ELEVENTH GENERATION

Henry Davenport, of Coventry, who married, first, Winifred, daughter of Richard Barnabit. She was the mother of his issue. His second wife was Elizabeth, daughter of Thomas of Gloucestershire. He was chosen Sheriff of Coventry, in 1602, and seems to have succeeded his younger brother as Mayor, in 1613. Issue: Barnabas, Edward, Christopher, Henry, and John Davenport.

TENTH GENERATION

John Davenport, who married Elizabeth Wolley. Issue: John and Christopher Davenport.

NINTH GENERATION

John Davenport, eldest son of John, and grandson of Henry, was born in the city of Coventry, in the year 1597, and in grammatical learning there educated. He entered Merton College with his brother Christopher, in 1613. After passing two years at Merton, he removed to Magdalen Hall, in the same University, where, continuing under severe and puritanical discipline for some time, he left without taking the degree of A.M., retired to London, and became a minister of St. Stephen's Church in Coleman Street, and a Puritan of much note. In 1625, he returned to Magdalen Hall, and for some time performed his exercise for the degree of Bachelor of Divinity, accumulated and took that degree at the same time that he received his degree of Master of Arts, and in a short time after returned again to London, where he was esteemed a person of excellent gifts in preaching and other qualities belonging to a divine. Here he labored for some years, till becoming a decided non-conformist, he resigned his charge at St. Stephen's, in 1633, went into Holland, and after some time returned to England, and sailed for America. Issue: John Davenport.

EIGHTH GENERATION

John Davenport of New Haven, was born during the residence of his father in London, and was an only child. He accompanied his parents to America, in the year 1637. During his father's abode in New Haven, he does

not appear to have been much engaged in public affairs, although Dr. Stiles, in his History of the Regicides, in speaking of the Courts of New Haven, about the year 1661, mentions him as one of the judges. He was not admitted a freeman at New Haven, till 15th of May, 1657. He was married, November 27, 1663, to Abigail, daughter of the Rev. Abraham Pierson of Branford, Conn., who was a sister of Rev. Abraham Pierson, the first Rector of Yale College. In 1668, he removed with his family to Boston, taking his letter of recommendation to the church there, from the church in New Haven. He was admitted freeman at Boston, in 1669. After his removal to Boston with his father, he was Register of Probate, from January 31, 1675, to August 17, 1676; but at the time of his death, which took place in the latter part of 1676, he is called a merchant. His wife survived him, and died at New Haven, July 20, 1718. Her grave is under the First (Center) Church. Issue: John, Elizabeth, Rev. John, Abraham, Abigail, and Mary.

Seventh Generation

Rev. John Davenport of Stamford, who was born in Boston, and baptized by his grandfather, on the 28th of February, 1669. He graduated at Harvard College, in 1687, and commenced preaching in 1690. In 1691, he was invited to become an assistant to the Rev. Mr. James of East Hampton, Long Island. In 1693, Mr. Davenport was called to the work of the ministry in Stamford, Fairfield County, Ct. In 1694, Mr. Davenport was ordained as pastor of the church in Stamford, and on the 18th of April, 1695, he was married to Martha, widow of John Selleck, formerly a Miss Gould, by whom he had seven children. She died December 1, 1712. His second wife was Mrs. Elizabeth Maltby, daughter of John Morris, by whom he had two children. Mr. Davenport for some time previous to commencing his labors in Stamford, taught the Hopkins' Grammar School in New Haven. He was a member of the Corporation of Yale College from 1707 till his death in 1731. Issue: Abigail, John, Martha, Sarah, Theodora, Deacon Deodate, Elizabeth, Honorable Abraham, and Rev. James Davenport.

SIXTH GENERATION

Deacon Deodate Davenport, of East Haven, born in Stamford, October 23, 1706. He was married in 1730 to Lydia Woodward, daughter of the Reverend John Woodward. He died December 3, 1761. Issue: Sarah, Martha, William, John, Deacon Samuel, Roswell, and Lydia Davenport.

FIFTH GENERATION

Deacon Samuel Davenport of East Haven, born 1740, and was married in 1766, to Mary Street. He died July 9, 1810. Mrs. Davenport died December 21, 1803, aged 66 years. Issue: Sarah, Roswell, Hezekiah, Martha, Mary, and Street Davenport.

FOURTH GENERATION

Sarah Davenport, born in East Haven, January 31, 1767. Married Ira Smith, in 1784. Issue: Polly Smith, Enos, John, Davenport, Hezekiah, Nancy, Lorinda, Fanny, Sarah, Isaac, and Lura.

Stanley Julius Morrow was born May 3, 1842. He married Isadore Ketchum. Issue: Earl Stanley. *Pease Ancestral Home*

Dear Davenport or other interested persons:

You are now reading what I trust shall be the first of many issues of the DAVENPORT Newsletter. Someone may ask: "Why and for what purpose is such a publication needed or necessary?" Various motivations have caused a good many people throughout the world to be interested in their family history either out of curiosity or the desire to join some patriotic organization. While it is true that in almost any city or town in our country there is always to be found either few or many DAVENPORTS, it is my belief that if we but go back three or four generations there must have not been so many. It is the purpose of this Newsletter to make available to all who wish it a good cross-section of information on DAVENPORTS from all eras and all sections of our country. From all the efforts it may come to pass that you will discover either a long lost or unknown relative. Possibly its greatest value may come to those with an interest in genealogy; however, others may find it interesting to read of any DAVENPORT our combined research may uncover. While it is easier for me to find listings which have to do with Texas DAVENPORTS than perhaps any other state, please do not feel that this is just a Texas-rooted publication. I make a habit of constantly doing some genealogical research both in the local library and the library in Dallas, Texas.

My plan is to make an index card from all DAVENPORT entries made in the Newsletters and also another file will be maintained from the ancestor or pedigree chart submitted to me from those subscribing to the service. The latter would be immediately checked on receipt of a new subscribers ancestor chart and both that person and any previously listed subscriber would be notified if a common ancestor is found. Too, we may try to have some family reunions on an annual or biennial basis.

Another question which may arise is: "What is he going to do with all that money. In order to reach more DAVENPORTS and get more names in the file for all our benefit, it is my plan to send from time to time complimentary copies of the Newsletter to individuals and to Genealogical Societies, Libraries, Publications, and Columns. There are available for a fee, of course, lists of persons doing research on any given surname it is my intention to get lists of names from these sources. An offer will be sent to each one concerning my services. I constantly read genealogical publications and anytime a DAVENPORT is listed as a genealogist or someone is shown to be working on a DAVENPORT line they are contacted about the newsletter. To date I have sent some 200 letters to individuals and Genealogical Societies, Publications, and Columns. I do not expect to get rich-merely to support my habit-and to share with others any information found in my searches. Not too far from me as well as the previously mentioned Dallas library are The Texas Archives in Austin, Texas (by no means limited to Texas), an excellent library in Houston, Texas as well as Shreveport, La. plus the branch of the Federal Archives in Ft. Worth, Texas.

These are just some of my intentions, objectives, and efforts to help those interested. It may well be that you have no interest whatever in researching your family tree, but you have a relative who is. Perhaps you would see fit to send this material to them for their reaction to the service. Too, I am in need of information such as is found on the following pages-information about your DAVENPORT relatives should you care to share it. At any rate thank you for reading this far and I trust you shall have a good day

QUERY:

Thomas W. DAVENPORT: Known facts about him.... He was born in North Carolina in 1861. His father was born in North Carolina and his mother was born in South Carolina (1880 Census). He grew up in the Household of Hudson B. DAVENPORT and his wife, Mary Melissa. They were married before 1860 and were in the Anderson County census each year after that. In the 1880 census Thomas W. DAVENPORT is listed as a "boarder" Thomas W. DAVENPORT was a member of the Baptist Church. He had "own" cousins in the N. W. part of South Carolina around 1900. We know their names. He had no brothers or sisters. He was a master mechanic and fixer and worked in several different cotton mills in that part of S. C. and N.E. Ga.

Family hearsay about him... His mother died at, or soon after, his birth. His Father fought in the Civil War but before he left to fight, he gave the baby to the above DAVENPORTS and asked them to care for him if he (the father) did not return from the war. This happened and he assumed their surname. His real name was WITT or WHITT or some similiar sounding name.

Possibilities.... In the 1850 census there is a family of Thomas Cox and in it is the above Mary, who married a Hudson B. Davenport. She had a younger sister in that census, Martha aged 6, who could have been the mother of Thomas. I can find no marriage record of this. This item picked up from another publication and run as a courtesy to Mrs. George F. Crawford 620 Hummingbird Lane Alexandria, La. 71301. She is the daughter of Thomas W. DAVENPORT.

Queries are welcome but obviously must be shorter than the one above.

Hello Grayson Mitchell,

As I volunteer at the Resource Centre of the B.C. Genealogical Society and as an avid family historian, I happened to be browsing yesterday in the Connecticut Ancestry for August 1992 and came upon your short piece titled "Eunice Buxton's Husbands Were Not Brothers".

Reading it, a chord of recognition was struck and when I got home, I delved through a trunk in the basement for a framed document which I bought many years ago, probably on a trip in New England.

The document is a deed to property in Stamford, Fairfield County, Connecticut and is dated 9 January 1737/38 and contains the names of John Davenport (seller), Samuel Scofield (buyer), Joseph Scofield (deceased father of buyer), Sam'l Hait (witness) and Abraham Davenport (witness).

The enclosed photocopy of the contents of the deed I typed many years ago, as I considered the deed a curiosity, being in its entirety a single sentence! (As I had framed it, I didn't want to take the frame apart to photocopy it for you, sorry).

The document is on a single sheet of heavy paper 8" x 13" folded lengthwise into quarters and crosswise in half. There is the remnant of a seal in red wax in the lower right hand corner.

From what I gather in the document and your article, it would seem to me that this document pertains to Samuel, son of Joseph, grandson of Daniel, and brother-in-law of Samuel Hoit.

Enclosed also is a photocopy of portraits of John and Abraham Davenport from the Stamford Historical Society, which I have kept with the framed deed.

I thought you might be interested in this little bit of serendipity, the kind of thing which seems to keep us all going.

Know ye that I John Davenport of the town of Stamford in the County of Fairfield within his majesties Colony of Connecticut in New England for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ninety pounds money current of sd Colony to me in hand before the ensuing here of well and truly paid by Samuel Scofield son to Joseph Scofield decedent of Stamford aforesaid the receipt whereof I do here by acknowledge and am therewith fully satisfied and contented have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do fully and absolutely give grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm to the sd Joseph Scofield his heirs and assigns forever thirty acres of Land in the border of Stamford aforesaid lying upon and near unto the upper end of Newfield ridge so called and thus bounded with by Newfield high way North by the high way and by sd John Davenports own Land Easterly by sd John Davenports own Land and South by sd Davenports own Land to have and to hold the said granted and bargained premises with all the appurtenances privileges and commodities to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Scofield above named to his heirs and assigns to them and their only proper use benefit and behoof and also I the said John Davenport do for my self my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the sd Samuel Scofield his heirs and assigns that at and until the enfeoffing of these presents given heirs at the premises as aforesaid in fee simple and have good right to the bargain and sell the same in manner and form as is above written and that the said Scofield and his heirs and assigns shall and may from henceforth and for ever by force and virtue of these presents lawfully peacefully and quietly have hold use occupy possess and enjoy the said demised and bargained premises with the appurtenances thereof free and clearly acquitted and discharged of from all former and other rights grants bargains sales Leases mortgages and off and from all other incumbrances whatsoever made done or suffered to be done by me the sd John Davenport my heirs or assigns at any time before the delivery of these presents and further more the said John Davenport by these presents and my self my heirs for ever to warrant and defend the above granted premises to him the sd Samuel Scofield his heirs and assigns against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of January 1797
