DIETZ Data



CONRAD DIETZ was born in 1711, son of John Dietz of Hinterweindenthal, Duchy of Deus Ponts, Germany. He married Catharine Bracker on November 11, 1734, born June 14, 1705, daughter of George and Susanna Bracher of the village of Reinschweiler. They lived in Alt Weiler until 1738, when they crossed the ocean to settle in Hellam Township, York County, Pennsylvania, on a farm of 300 acres of virgin timber, building themselves a log cabin. It was on this farm a cemetery was established when an outbreak of dysentery developed. The parents and three of their children fell victims to it. Conrad died August 25, 1758, at 11 P. M. The mother, Catharine, died at 4 A. M. August 26. One child remained, John George, from whom the entire Dietz family in this section sprang.

John George Dietz, born November 4, 1737, married April 20, 1761, Anna Magdalena Schmidt (now Smith), daughter of Henry and Margaret Schmidt. She was born in 1743, and died January 4, 1805, leaving a large family of twelve children. John George died March 10, 1823. Both are buried in the Dietz cemetery. Their children:

THESE few brief items were left dangling from the last issue of the "Searcher", being excerpts from the scrapbook of Flora Simonds, late of West Branch, Iowa.

GEORGE BOONE, born near Reading, Pa., removed to Salem, Ohio, in 1852; married Sarah Coffee in 1854; moved to West Branch, Iowa, 1870. Died April 4, 1907.

AARON GRUWELL, born in Stark Co., Ohio, June 8, 1817. Parents came from Chester Co., Pa.; grandparents came from France because of religious persecution. Married Bathsheba Slater July 6, 1837, Marlborough, Ohio, born Jan. 21, 1816, Ulster Co., N. Y. Four sons and two daughters: Isaac Newton, Hannah, Brinton T., Alice, Timothy and Abram Clark. Moved to Cedar Co., Iowa in 1854. Celebrated 67th wedding anniversary in 1904.

RACHEL TAYLOR HUGHES, born Nov. 1, 1809, near Toronto, Canada, daughter of David and Elizabeth Taylor. Died 13 May 1906. Married George Hughes April 5th, 1825; moved to Iowa in 1853 and lived in Salem, Iowa, for 25 years. 15 children: Angeline (deceased), Mrs. Lavina Boggie, Martha, Mrs. Elma Sadler, Mrs. Elizabeth Mahaney, Mary, Mrs. Sarah Quaintance, Mrs. Agnes Nash, Mrs. Mattie Hillis, Clark, John, Joseph, Charles, Jared, Edwin.

ALBUM OF FRIENDSHIP

FRIENDS of Agnes Ione Bensley inscribed "grave and uplifting messages, guides to the good life", in her autograph book. She was born in Springville, New York, June 9, 1842. Her granddaughter, Barbara P. Carrington, of San Marino, California, now treasures this little gem, and contributed the following names and information regarding the persons signing in the album.

Agnes Ione Bensley was the daughter of Eaton and Agnes (McCaa) Bensley. She married in Chicago, Illinois, on February 14, 1866, Madison Crandall Scobey, born in Ashford, New York, on May 8, 1829, son of Alexander and Sarepta (Boss) Scobey.

All towns, with the exception of Chicago, of course, are located in western New York State. Relationships indicated are to Agnes.
