Thanks to Mrs. Marbry we know that Robert was the son of Robert Sr.


Robert DONALDSON b ca 1725 Orange/Caswell/Person Co., NC (Robert didn't move, the county boundary lines did) d ca 20 Mar 1770 same. He married Hannah ______ she b ca 1746-1749 North Carolina. He arrived in what is now Person Co., North Carolina before 1754.

Robert's Will was probated April term, 1770. In the Will he names his wife, Hannah, sons, Thomas, Robert, next line reads daughters, Margaret wife of William Ray, 'undutiful daughter' Mary, 2 shillings, next line reads, "Hannah, Elizabeth, Jean, Ritterson (? Catherine), Sarah and Robert, I allow equal shares. Executors wife Hannah and William Ray, 'overseer' Thomas Donaldson. Witnesses Honor Nicks, Elizabeth Thomas and Thomas Douglass. Hannah lived for another 19 years following Robert's death. Her Will was dated 3 Aug 1789 Caswell Co., NC.

Another daughter, Rachel, was not named in Robert's Will and may not have been born at the time of Robert's death. She is mentioned in Hannah's Will as are two grandsons, Robert to whom she gave a bay mare and a cow and calf and Barnet Donaldson to whom she gave a cow and calf.

Robert entered 315 acres of land in Orange Co., NC, 12 Mar 1754. He also appears on the 1755 Tax List of that county.

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

ARTICLE VI - GENERAL MEETINGS

- Section 1. The Society shall meet ten (10) times a year regularly.
- Section 2. The annual meeting and election of officers shall be the November meeting.
- Section 3. Special meetings may be called by the President or upon request of three (3) members of the Executive Board.
- Section 4. A quorum shall consist of at least seven (7) members and include at least one Executive Board Member.
- Section 5. Roberts Rules Of Order shall be the Parliamentary Authority except in such cases as are governed by the Constitution and By-Laws.
- Section 6. A simple majority of members present and voting shall be required to decide issues.
- Section 7. The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by an affirmative vote of two thirds of the members at any regular meeting, provided that the proposed amendment or amendments have been presented in writing to the membership at a previous meeting.
- Section 8. A new book shall be placed in the library in the memory of a deceased member. Said book shall be inscribed inside with the deceased members's name.
- Section 9. This Constitution and By-Laws supercedes any previous Constitution, By-Laws and Amendments.

ROBERT AND MARTHA WALKER DONALDSON

Robert DONALDSON was born ca 1754 in Orange/Caswell/Person Co., NC and we mentioned above that Robert didn't move, it was the county boundary lines that shifted. He died in Tennessee about 1830. Robert and Martha WALKER were married ca 1782 in Person Co., NC, she the daughter of Moses and Anna (Agnes) WALKER. It was through Moses WALKER Will that we proved Martha as Robert's wife. Robert saw military service during the Revolution -(Elijah H. DONALDSON's obit tells that he was wounded in the thigh by a musket ball which broke the bone and was hospitalized for 3 months.) Information regarding his service is a little confusing - there are 2 Robert DONALDSONs. This Robert was a Pvt. in Charles POPE's Company of the North Carolina Militia.

 Buckley DONALDSON b ca 1783 Orange Co., NC d 1842 Hardeman Co., TN. He m Dida Mira ARMSTRONG, 2 Feb 1811 in Williamson Co., TN. He served in the War of 1812 (land Grant (9594 for 4 acres; #10383 - 25 acres) and is found in early Williamson CO., TN deed records. A note shows that in 1816 he was branded on the hand with the letter "M" for the felonious slaying of James SKELLY. 29 May 1822, Buckley DONALDSON of Wayne Co., TN and Willis DOLSON of Hickman Co., TN sold land in Williamson Co., TN to Daniel RAGSDALE. His Will dated 18 Jan 1843 was filed in Will Book 2, Hardeman Co., TN.

Barnett made an affidavit in March 1855 stating that he was drafted in 1814 for 6 month service in Capt. Dalton's Company during the War of 1812. He was mustered out at New Orleans shortly after the Battle of New Orleans, 8 Jan 1815. He received bounty land for his service. In 1817 he appeared as an Ensign in the 1818 Hickman County Militia.
