THE OLD NATIONAL ROAD

(This 24 April 1904 article was found in 1979 at Uniontown, OH in a trunkfull of memorabilia which belonged to a distant cousin in Jean's Brown family)

Original Route of the Long Famous Old National Road

One thousand miles of modern highway, running from Baltimore on the east to Jefferson City, Missouri, on the west, a road which will rival the Appian Way of Italy, will be the result if a bill now pending in congress is passed. It was introduced by Representative Pearce, of Maryland, and provides first for the appointment of a commission to make investigation and report the probable cost of placing the old National Road in good condition, it further provided that the government shall loan to the various states through which the road passes a sum not to exceed \$10,000 per mile for restoring the road to good condition. The loan is to be made without interest and is to be repaid one twenty-fifth each year.

The road was started after an act of congress in 1804, authorizing President Thomas Jefferson to appoint a commission to investigate and report on a feasible route. The commission was paid \$4 a day each, which was to include all their expenses. The sum of \$4000 was appropriated to pay for other necessary expenses; of a civil engineer, etc. In making its report the commission said it took the liberty to employ one packhorse man and horse, humbly asks apology for having done so without authority and asks congress to pay the bill. The construction of the road and its maintenance until 1844, when it was turned over to the various states through which it passed on the condition they keep it in good shape, cost the United States government \$6,824,919. There were opponents of the project who advised against construction of such a military highway on the ground that in case of war it might fall into the hands of the country's enemies. In those days a successful invasion of the country was thought to be among the possibilities of the future. The road, until 1834, was under the control of the war department.

The old National Road - sometimes named the National pike or the National turnpike - ran originally from Cumberland through Frostburg, Sand Springs, Piney Grove, Little Crossings and Grantsville into Pennsylvania, at the latter point crossing the Braddock road; Petersburg was its first town in Pennsylvania, and it passed through the southwestern portion of that state, touching Newbury, Somefield, Mt. Augusta, Mt. Washington, Monroe Springs, Monroe, Uniontown, Searights, Brownsville, Beallsville, Washington, West Alexander and into the small northern spur of West Virginia.

It crossed this spur to Wheeling, crossed the Ohio to St. Clairsville, thence went through Morristown, Fairview, Washington, Cambridge, Concord, Zanesville, Grariot, Etna, Reynoldsburg to Columbus. From Columbus it went westward to Springfield and across the state through Lewisburg, Centreville and Gettysburg to the Indiana line, across it and into Richmond, Ind. From Richmond it went west to Indianapolis, through Terra Haute, across into Illinois, across that state and southwestwardly to Jefferson City. It was not completed entirely to Jefferson City, although it was surveyed that far. Later a section of the road was completed between Baltimore and Cumberland.
