Bible Records

BIBLE OF MICHAEL DUSKIN, SR.
Wake and Orange Counties, North Carolina

This Bible is in the possession of Mrs. Wallace Hogue of Newbern, Alabama. Record were sent by Lizzie Woods of Newbern to Member Marie Parkhurst Morey of Lakewood California, who in turn supplied them to the "Searcher", with this notation: "Until this Bible record was discovered it was believed that William Duskin had had only one wife, Mary Jane Johnston, and that their oldest child was Mary Ann. However, we learned that Mary Ann was the only child by his first marriage and was raised with the children of the second as one of them. No one in the present generation ever remembered hearing of a first marriage. All this has now been documented, and we had some changing to do in our thinking, as we found we are descended from the first marriage and not the second, as we had thought. Just a bit of interesting searching!"
