Tradition says the Eatons were Britons. Caesar invated first in 55 B. C. At the second invations Caesar captured Stockade near modern St. Albans, where the Eaton family records are found. The English history of the Eaton Families is traced from Blanqui Thane of Loohabar, A. D. 1000. His son, Fleance married Genta, princess of North Wales and the family comes down directly to William Eaton who m. Jane Hussey and d. before 1584, leaving sons John, Nicholas and Peter. John Eaton, of Dover, son of Nicholas, emigrated to America in 1635; William, of Staple, son of Peter, emigrated in 1637; John, emigrated with his wife Anne and six children before 1640; Theophilus, son of Richard, emigrated in 1637. There was, however, an earlier emigration in 1620 on the Mayflower and to Massachusettes, by Francis Eaton, a carpenter from Bristol, who was among the signers of the compact.

#1. William Eaton, with wife, Martha Jenkins, and 3 ch. and one "servante" embarked for New England before 6-9-1637 in the Hercules & Sandwich. Settled in Watertown, Mass. where he was proprietor in 1642; then to Reading; freeman 1653; d. 1658 at 54 He was from Staple, County Kent, England.

The name of Eaton is of Welsh and Saxon origin, a place name meaning hill or town near the water.

It also contains the descendents of Francis Eaton, of Plymouth and the Mayflower; of John Eaton of Dover, England, who came to America in 1635; of the Nova Scotia Branch of Eatons from Salisbury and Haverhill and in Salisbury, Mass. as early as 1640.; of Richard Eaton, Vicarof Great Budworth, Caeshire, Eng; of Thomas Eaton of Monmouth, N. J., who came from Goodhurst, Kent Co., England and came to America before 1670; of the Eatons of Radnorshire, Wales, who emigrated to Delaware and Pa. 168385. from 1683 to 1685.; of the Irish Branch, headed by John Eaton, son of John of England,, and who settled in Chester Co., Pa. in the middle 1700s.
