THE DESCENDANTS OF MATTHEW EBERT

1. MATTHEW EBERT, b. Germany, Oct. 2, 1732 or 1733,d. Frederick, Md., Feb. 9, 1789; m. first, Frederick, Md., Ap. 7, 1761, CATH. MAGD. MAUS or MAAS; second, Frederick, Md., 1766, ELIZABETH CATHERINA, dau. of George and Appolonia WEISHAAR.

Matthew (Mathias) Ebert arrived at Philadelphia from Rotterdam on the ship, Edinburgh, James Russell, Master, and took the oath of allegiance on September 5, 1748. (Strassburger I, p. 372.) With him on this ship was Jacob Ebert, who may have been his father or his brother. Matthew was born in Germany on October 2, 1732 or in 1733. (The notice of his death in the records of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick, Maryland, original now in Lutheran Seminary at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania - hereafter cited as Ev. Luth. Gettysburg - says he was born in 1733. A transcript of this record, in the Maryland Historical Society at Baltimore - hereafter cited as Ev. Luth. Trans. - indicates the date of October 2, 1732, i.e. 56 years, 4 months and 7 days before his death on February 9, 1789.)

On April 7, 1761 he married Cath[erina] Magd[alena] Maus or Maas in the German Reformed Church in Frederick, Maryland. (German Ref. Ch. Records, transc. Md. Hist. Soc., p. 1126; Ev. Luth. Gettysburg; Brumbaugh II, p. 509.) Four children were born to this union, of whom one son was living at the time of Matthew's death. (Ev. Luth. Gettysburg.) The date of the death of Catherina Magdalena is unknown.

In 1766 he married Elizabeth Catherina Weishaar, the daughter of George Weishaar and his wife Maria Appolonia (who may have been the Appolonia Brooner who arrived at Philadelphia and qualified on October 14, 1731.) Matthew and Elizabeth Catherina had eleven children, of whom six sons and one daughter were living at the time of his death. (Ev. Luth. Gettysburg.) Matthew (spelled Matthis in the church record) was a member of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Frederick, Maryland as early as 1764 when he made a contribution as a member. His children by Elizabeth Catherina were baptized in this church from 1768 to 1787. He and his wife were communicants there from time to time. At one time he was proposed as an elder but was not elected.

Matthew Ebert died in the late afternoon of February 9, 1789 in Frederick, Maryland "of pains in his limbs from which he had suffered very much for eighteen months." (Ev. Luth. Gettysburg.) His will, signed on February 4, 1789, conveyed his house and lot in

Frederick to his wife, Catherina and mentioned his son, George and his "remaining seven children." (Frederick Co. Md. Rec.) It is not clear whether this includes George, i.e. all of his living children by Elizabeth Catherina or those other than George and including his son by his first wife.

His widow, Elizabeth (Catherina or Catherine) appears as a communicant of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick in 1790 and the name Catherina or Catherine Ebert or Eberts appears among the communicants until 1816, the year in which she died. Her will, made on June 20, 1816 and probated on July 20, 1816 named sons, Michael, Joseph, George, Christian, Matthis (i.e. Matthew) and Jacob and granddaughter, Margaret Weaver, daughter of Maria Appolonia, then deceased. There is no mention of Jeremias who, by inference was dead or of Johannes or Wilhelm who are known to have died while small. (Fred. Co., Md. Rec.; Ev. Luth. Gettysburg; Ev. Luth. Trans.) In 1817 deeds among the heirs mention Christian, Jacob, Matthew, Michael, George and Joseph as being each entitled to one-sixth of the estate of their mother, Elizabeth Catherine Ebert (also spelled Ebbert and Ebberts.) The above deeds and another dated February 26, 1819, mention Susanna [Stimmel], wife of Jacob; and Elizabeth [Carmack], wife of Joseph. In 1817 George lived in Baltimore. (Fred. Co. Md. Deeds, Liber 4JS, pp. 268-269; Liber 5JS, pp. 584-587; Liber 8JS, p. 289.)

The parentage of Elizabeth Catherine Weishaar may be inferred from the church records, particularly those of baptism. George Weishaar and his wife, Maria Appolonia, appear as sponsors of Christian, the first child of Matthew and Catherine Weishaar Ebert, of their daughter, Appolonia and of their sons, Jeremias and Wilhelm, while Maria Appolonia, widow of George Weishaar, sponsored another son, George Adam, in 1785. George Weishaar and his wife, Appolonia, were communicants in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Frederick in 1780. They appear as the parents of a daughter, Anna Maria, born February 16, 1765.

George Ebert lived in Baltimore on April 7, 1817 at which time he executed a deed to his brother Joseph of Frederick, Maryland for property bequeathed by Matthew and Catherine Ebbert. Signed "George Ebert," all other spellings, "Ebbert". (Frederick Co., Deeds, Liber 8JS, p. 289.)

The baptismal record in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Frederick, Maryland gives the above birth date. His gravestone gives the date as July 24, 1782 and the family bible of Fred Ebert gives it as July 24, 1783. The 1850 Census, Morgan County, Ohio, indicates 1785 or 1786, an evident error. He was confirmed in the above church on April 6, 1798. He married twice. His first wife was Maria Bihlmeier, daughter of Michael Bihlmeier. We have no record of their marriage but they appear, under the names of Jacob and Maria Epperts, as the parents of Michael Epperts, born on October 1 or 6, 1802 and baptized on October 19, 1802 in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Frederick, Maryland with Catha. Epperts and Michael Bihlmeier, grandparents as sponsors. (Ev. Luth. Trans.) Jacob Eberts and Maria Eberts had appeared as communicants of this church on April 15, 1802. The family bible in the possession of Fred Ebert of Columbus and Mc Luney, Ohio, lists Edward Ebert, born September 5, 1806 and Mary Ann Ebert, born December 28, 1808 as Jacob's children but makes no mention of his first wife, maria, or of Michael. This bible is in the family of the second wife. No further reference to Maria has been found.

On November 11, 1809, Jacob Ebert married Susanna Stimmel, at the home of her father, Jacob Stimmel. (Ev. Luth. Gettysburg, p. 347, Ev. Luth. Trans. p. 359, Frederick Co. Md. Rec.) By his second wife he had six children: Catherine, Amos, Beal, Levi, Ellen and Jacob. It is not clear just when Jacob and Susanna left Maryland. They were sponsors at a baptism in Frederick, Maryland on February 13, 1813 and a Jacob Ebert appears as a communicant as late as 1815. However, when Jacob secured land in Muskingum County, Ohio on August 19, 1812, he gave his address as Jefferson County, Ohio, the county in which the land office was located. He deeded this land to Elizabeth Ebert (presumably his mother) of Muskingum County" on January 4, 1814. (Muskingum Co. Deeds.) Beal Ebert, his son was born in Ohio in 1815. From these facts it is inferred that Jacob made a trip to Ohio in 1812 to buy land and that the family moved to the state in 1815. (The will of Elizabeth Ebert was probated in Frederick, Maryland in 1816 and Jacob's brothers evidently stayed in Maryland.)

When Jacob came to Ohio he located first in Muskingum County, in the neighborhood of Crooksville, but soon thereafter moved to adjoining York Township, Morgan County. He built a house there and voted in the first election held in that township, on September 24, 1819. In that election he received three votes for justice of the peace. He owned various tracts of land along the west line of the township. He is buried in a private cemetery on a hill on the farm where he lived. This farm was occupied by a Mr. May in May, 1948. It lies just east of the county line, in York Township, Morgan County, Ohio - east of Mc Luney - east of the railroad, north of Route 669 (to Deavertown.) In this cemetery there is also a portion of the gravestone of Susanna, his wife, with no date, and that of Jacob Ebert, a child. Susanna was living in November, 1863. (Will of Jacob Ebert, Jr., Morgan Co., Ohio.) The family bible of Fred Ebert lists Jacob Sr., Edward, Mary Ann, Catherine, Amos, Beal, Lev and Ellen. The Census of 1850 lists Jacob Sr., Susanna, Beal and Jacob Jr. in one household.

least, and in Morgan County in 1838. It may be inferred from available information that they lived in Perry County curing nearly all of the time between 1832 and 1857. In 1848 when Jacob and Susanna Ebert deeded land on which to build the Fairview United Brethren Church, south of Crooksville, Ohio, Edward was a trustee. Edward and Sena appear to have sold their land in Perry County in 1857, preparatory to moving to Indiana. This move was made in 1857 or 1858. It is presumed that they moved to Clay County at this time. The family did not remain long in Indiana but moved on to Missouri, where they engaged in sawmilling. It appears probable that this trip was made in 1858 or 1859. The family was living in Clay County, Indiana, in 1862 when a son, George W. Ebbert went into the Unior a my. The family moved to Illinois about 1875. A son, George, moved to Montrose at that time and other members are presumed to have come at or about this Edward Ebert was buried in Center Point, Clay County, Indiana. Sena Ebert came to Illinois and lived, first with her son Levi (Lee) and with Rachel, after the Latter's marriage. She died on December 10, 1889 and lies in Island Creek Cemetery, Grove Township, Jasper County, Illinois,

Proof that Edward was the son of Jacob is found in the femily bible of Fred Ebert which records Edward and Jacob Jr. as sons of Jacob Sr., the will of Jacob, Jr. mentioning his [half]-brother, Edward, and the 1850 Census, Morgan County, Ohio.

Catherine Ann was known as "Aunt Kit." John Brewer was born July 20, 1835, in Center Point, Indiana and died there in February 1881. He is buried in Center Point. Ralph Moss lived in Clay County, Indiana, and operated a large farm. He served four years as State Senator and represented the 5th District in the 61st, 62nd, 63rd, and 64th Congresses. He was a member of a Congressional Committee sent to Europe to study rural credit systems.

39. GEORGE WASHINGTON⁴ EBBERT (Edward ³, Jacob ², Matthew¹), b. Perry Co., C., July 20, 1841; d. Grove Twp., Jasper County, Ill., Jan. 3, 1925; m. first, Clay Co., Ind., Mar. 19, 1863, Nancy Jane Gibbons, second, Effingham Co., Ill., Mary Frances Gibbons, as her second husband, third, Wheeler, Jasper Co., Ill., Mrs. Emma Eagleton Linthicum, as her second husband.

George W. Ebbert was born in Harrison Twp., Perry County, Ohio. He moved to Indiana with his family about 1858 and shortly thereafter went to Missouri, where he engaged in sawmilling for a time. They returned in a wagon with a yoke of oxen. George W. went into the Union army from there and served in the Fifty-fifth Indiana Regiment for three months in 1862 (July 15 - Sept. 14.)

His first wife, Nancy Jane Gibbons, was born at Center Point, Indiana, February 16, 1846 and died April 25, 1878 in Illinois. Her father, Nathan Gibbons, (or Gibbens) was the son of Jacob Gibbens (son of Jacob Gibbens) and Mary Ann Pierce, (dau. of Michael Pierce, Jr. and Elizabeth Grove. Michael Pierce, Jr. was the son of Michael Pierce Sr. and Lydia _______.) Her mother, mary Hicks, was the daughter of Uriah Hicks (son of Solomon Hicks and Prudence West) and Clara Presnell. Prudence West was the daughter of Levi West (believed to be the son of George West) and Mary Williams, (believed to be the daughter of Andrew Williams and Prudence ______.)

His second wife, Mary Frances Gibbons, was a first cousin of his first wife. She was the daughter of Thomas Gibbons (brother of Nathan) and Elizabeth Davenport. She had previously married John Whittington, by whom she had two children, Thomas and Oscar, who grew to manhood in the home of their step-father. Thomas Whittington married Effic Wallace, by whom he had four children, Dorsey, Ruth, Beulah, and Mary. He is deceased but his wife survives him. Oscar Whittington married Adelia Kibler, by whom he had two children, Eva (m. Elmer Steele) and Helen (m. J. B. Lasher.) Both live

in Oregon. He married, second, wrs. Marie Shamhart. He died while living at Bend, Oregon. His wife survived him.

George W. Ebbert's third wife, Mrs. Emma Eagleton Linthicum, was born, November 11, 1852. She was the daughter of Wm. Eagleton and Sarah Kern.

George W. Ebbert brought his family to montrose, Lffingham County, Illinois, in 1875 and moved to a farm which he had purchased south of that village in 1872. On March 10, 1884 he purchased from William Hurley Wishard a farm north of Gila in Grove Township, Jasper County, Illinois, and in April of that year moved to it. Except for one short period when he lived in Gila he resided on this farm until his death. He was a member of the United Brethren Church (Kerns Congregation in later life) and was a lifelong Republican. He is buried in the Faunce Cemetery, one mile west and one mile north of montrose, Illinois.

Levi M. Ebbert, commonly known as "Lee", moved from Ohio to Indiana about 1858, to Missouri and back to Clay County, Indiana. He entered the Union army on May 17, 1864 and served 100 days in Company K of the 153rd regiment and in Company A of the 42nd regiment from Nov. 7, 1864 to July 21, 1865. Upon his return from the Civil War he engaged in sawmilling for a year or a season in Alabama and later, with one of his brothers, in Missouri, Iowa and

north central Illinois. The family group bought land in Illinois and went back to Indiana and cut a house pattern, which they shipped to montrose, Illinois, where they erected it. George moved to a farm south of montrose and Levi moved to a farm (later known as the Market place) south of Woodbury, where he ran a sawmill. It appears probable that the house in Montrose was sold after the marriage of Rachel to Samuel Wilson. Sena Ebbert and sons, Levi and Edward A., ran a sawmill in Grove Township, east or northeast of Gila about 1880. It is not known whether they established a permanent residence here at this time. In April and August, 1881 Levi bought land in Grove Township, Jasper County, and moved to the farm on which he lived until his death.

Edward A. Ebbert moved with the family to Indiana, Missouri and Illinois, where he engaged in sawmilling. He purchased land in Grove Township, Jasper County, Illinois, in 1883. For many years he lived on a farm on Island Creek, Grove Township. Later he lived in the extreme southern part of Illinois and in Effingham. Nancy Jane Epperson (dau. of Dr. Lewis Epperson and James), was born Feb. 28, 1845 and died in the fall of 1924.
