POLLY R. EDGAR, born ca 1798, m 22 Aug 1820 in Jefferson Co., to James P. Balch.

SAMUEL H. EDGAR, born ca 1800 in Jefferson Co., died prior to 1850. He married ca 1826 to Sarah Rodgers born ca 1816 in Tenn., daughter of George Eodgers. Thier children were: Martha b ca 1834 (m a Judson?); Sarah E. b 12 Sep 1827, d 4 Nov 1832 buried in Rodgers Cem, Rankin Co., Tenn.; Harriett b ca 1832; Dorthola b ca 1837; Emily b ca 1840; Salina Jane b ca 1843; and Samuel H. born ca 1845.

JOHN H. EDGAR, born ca 1802 in Jefferson Co., presumedly died in the 1850's. He married 27 Jul 1824 in Jefferson Co., to Elizabeth Martin born ca 1806 in Tennessee. Thier children were: George born ca 1830; Samuel born ca 1836; Mary Margaret born ca 1839; Sarah born ca 1842; William born ca 1845; Martha A. born ca 1849 and Robert born ca 1832 who married ca 1864 to Martha M. \_\_\_\_\_ born 1844 in Tennessee.

ROBERT EDGAR, born ca 1834, son of John H., had the following known children: Verona E. b ca 1865; John M. b ca 1870; Elly J. b ca 1867; Louisa P. b ca 1874; James P. H. b ca 1877; Thomas H. b ca 1880; William A/H boca 1880.

GEORGE D. EDGAR, born ca 1804 in Jefferson Co., died prior to 1840. He married 8 Aug 1826 in Jefferson Co., to Elizabeth D. Morrow b ca 1806 in Tennessee. Thier children were: Juliet E. b ca 1829; Harriett b ca 1832 and William Isaac Irving born ca 1836.

WILLIAM ISAAC IRVING, born ca 1836 m/1 unknown and had George D. born ca 1857 m ca 1874 to Annas L. \_\_\_\_\_ born ca 1856 in Tenn., ch: Mollie A. b 1875, F. Lula E. b 1877, Adda H. b 1879; Andrew b ca 1859 and John H. b ca 1860. William I. I. m/2 to unknown and had Julia A. b ca 1862; Eliza B. b ca 1863; Samuel B. b ca 1866 and William G. b ca 1867. He m/3 ca 1870 to Rebecca Jane Riggs born ca 1834 in Tenn., died ca 1895 and had Paralee b ca 1871 and Jesse Dewey b ca 1873.

JESSE DEWEY EDGAR, b ca 1873 m/1 to Roberta Roberts who died in 1907. They had one daughter Hazel who married a Davis. He m/2 to Beulah Overstreet born in 1891, Fisher Co., Texas, died in 1937. They married in 1910 and he died in 1951. They had Jesse Louis and Mary Grace b ca 1920 in Pampa, Tex.

MARY GRACE EDGAR, b 1920 m Roy E. Nix, Sr., they have two sons, Roy E. Nix, Jr., and Robert Edgar Nix.

EMALINE EDGAR, dau of Andrew Edgar, born ca 1808 in Jeff. Co., m 9 Dec 1828 in Jeff Co., to Thomas Carbeck.

ISABELLA W. EDGAR, born ca 1814 in Jeff. Co., m 11 Mar 1834 in Jeff. Co., to Nathaniel Hood.

ANDREW EDGAR<sup>†</sup> was a large land owner in Jefferson Co., Tenn. having purchased his first tract of land in 1794, a 126 acre farm from Hugh Kelso. Through the years he had many dealings in real Estate, receiving Lang Grants from the State of Tennessee in 1809, 1810, 1812 and 1831. He transferred land to most of his children, either by gift or by sale. He also purchased many acres from his sons Geo. D. and Andrew B. He provided very well for his family considering the hazards of the "Times". His descendants are now scattered all through-out the west, leaving legacies of their own.

"THE PIONEER" San Jose, California 15 Oct 1897

DR. WM. F. EDGAR died at Los Angeles. The name of Dr. William F. Edgar is identified with early history of the State (Calif.), for he was a '49er and came to the state of Oregon as an Army Surgeon attached to one of the detachments "of Uncle Sam's Troops". A Mexican veteran, he saw some hot work across the southern border, and to the time of his death, at the ripe age of 73 years, he retained a warm spot in his heart for all that pertained to "The boys in Blue," and particularly to the Medical Department of the United States Army. For quite a long time Dr. Edgar was stationed at Drum Barracks at San Pedro, and in latter life became identified with business interests at San Bernardino and Los Angeles.

Second Pension Application # 12058

State of Maryland Cecil County to witt on the eleventh day of September 1820 personally appeared in open court being a court of record for the second second judicial district of the state of Maryland proceeding according to the court of common law with a jurisdiction unlimited in amount and keeping a record of its proceedings, James Edgar age? (?) Seventy years. resident in Cecil County in said district who being duly sworn according to law doth on his oath declare that he served in the revolutionary war as follows; That he enlisted in March 1776 at the Yellow Springs in Chester County Pennsylvania in the company commanded by Capt Patrick Anderson attached to the Second Pennsylvania Regiment commanded by Colonel Atlee that after the term of Eighteen months for which he had enlisted had expired he was discharged when he reenlisted for three years. That he served out the said term of three years when he was discharged at Penington in New Jersey and received a discharge from Gen Wayne which he hath since lost. That he made a declaration in conformity to the act of the 18th March 1818 in Lancaster County Court on or about the 27th August 1818 and obtained a pension under said act his certificate being numbered 12058 And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent there by so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled as Act to Provide for certain persons engaged in the land and Naval Forces of the United States in the Revolutionary War passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or security contract or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed by me subscribed

Two old cows, one small Heifer; 4 old Horses and a colt, 5 sheep, one old plow and 2 Harrows, pr Singletrees, one ladder, a lot of Hay, one old shaft cart and gear, small lot of wheat in sheaf and a small lot of oats in sheaf, small lot of Flak, one wheel Barrow, one cutting Bord, 2 pitch forks and dung forks, 2 mattocks, 3 hoes, Fan (?), 2 pr plow gear, Scythe and cradle half bushel, 4 small Hogs 2 old saddles, pr Hobbles, old case Drawer, 1 do (?). 2 old Tables, 4 old chairs, five pieces cedar ware, 3 flour casks, small wheel and reel, pr andirns shoved and tongs Gridiron, pot rack griddle, frying pan, 3 old iron pots tea kettle, dutch oven, ladle and fork, 3 \_\_\_\_\_ set of tin ware, 1/2 doz knives and forks, 2 hand saws \_\_\_\_\_ knife, set of old chisels, 1/2 doz cups & saucers 2 bowls, 2 dishes, 1/2 doz plates, 1/2 doz tea spoons of pewter, 1 kit of tools not exceeding in value one hundred and eighty dollars and forty five cents; and that I am indebted to different persons to the amount of one hundred and eighteen dollars eleven and one half cents that I am by trade a shoemaker but am unable from loss of eyesight and bodily infirmity am unable to pursue it. That I rent a small Farm at the yearly rent of twenty seven dollars That I have no family but my wife aged fifty two years and infirmed
