Over the past several years I have compiled a great deal of material on the history of the Finnell Family in America. One of the most valuable and important parts of that collection is the number of Family Bible records that contain vital records for Family members. Many of these records are available nowhere else and the original copies of several have been lost or destroyed. The records contained on the following pages, in many cases, have never been published before. Many of the Bible records have been annotated to identify family connections and provide more information to the reader. The value of these becomes apparent as you realize that only one person can own the original and many times they are hard to impossible to locate much less use.

The second part of this volume contains the transcripts of six Finnell Family Cemeteries. Almost all of these are now abandoned or have not been used for many years. Though some are small the records of who's buried here is important and valuable. The older stones many contain data not available elsewhere for these family members. Again the entries are annotated to further identify these individuals we can and provide additional information.

This sort of collections would not be possible with out the support and cooperation of a number of Genealogical Societies, Friends and Finnell Family members. The many individuals who supplied information, copies or visited and transcribed several Family cemeteries are thanked for their interest in preserving this part of the Finnell Family heritage. My personal and special thanks goes out to each and every one of them.

His name is not found on the list of Episcopical Church men after 1831. Information from the Historiographer of the Diocese of Pennsylvania.

2. Henry W. Snyder died at White Post, Clarke Co., VA 22 Nov 1840. A 1828 Graduate of the University of Maryland. His Obituary in the 30 Nov 1840 issue of *The American*. His will probated 29 Dec 1840 on oaths of Daniel B. Richards and George H. Evans. Hiram P. Evans named Executor, but refused to Qualify. The list of property sold for H.W. Snyder, deceased on 30 Dec 1840 lists a H.P. Evans as purchasing for 45 cents one lot of Books. Hiram P. Evans, born 28 Sep 1811; died 19 Jan 1867 and is buried in Silver Ridge, Earle Graveyard, two miles south of White Post.

3. In the 1840 Federal Census of Pike TWP, Coshocton Co., OH is listed a James Gardner as Head of Household

18 rough field stones were counted that seem to mark graves, one is believed to be the grave of Reuben FINNELL, a Revolutionary War Soldier and Methodist Minister, who died in 1823. One stone is broken and the top half is missing.
