Also public papers of George Clinton, V. 3 p. 159. Calendar of Historical Manuscripts relating to War of Revolution V. 1, p. 28, V. 2 p. 7, 50 V. 1 p. 69. John Forman lieutenant 2nd Reg. of the N.Y. line allotted 600 acres, lot No. 87 township No. 25 (Circumstances) July 9, 1790. Also allotted 600 acres lot No. 67 township No. 21 (Hector) July 9, 1790. The above is in Manuscript & History Section, New York State Library. John Forman mentioned in N.Y. soldiers of Colony and State by Roberts Vol. II p. 70. His hand holding an Iron Flail is on a Two Dollar Continental bill 1777. He served in Westchester Co. Militia.
