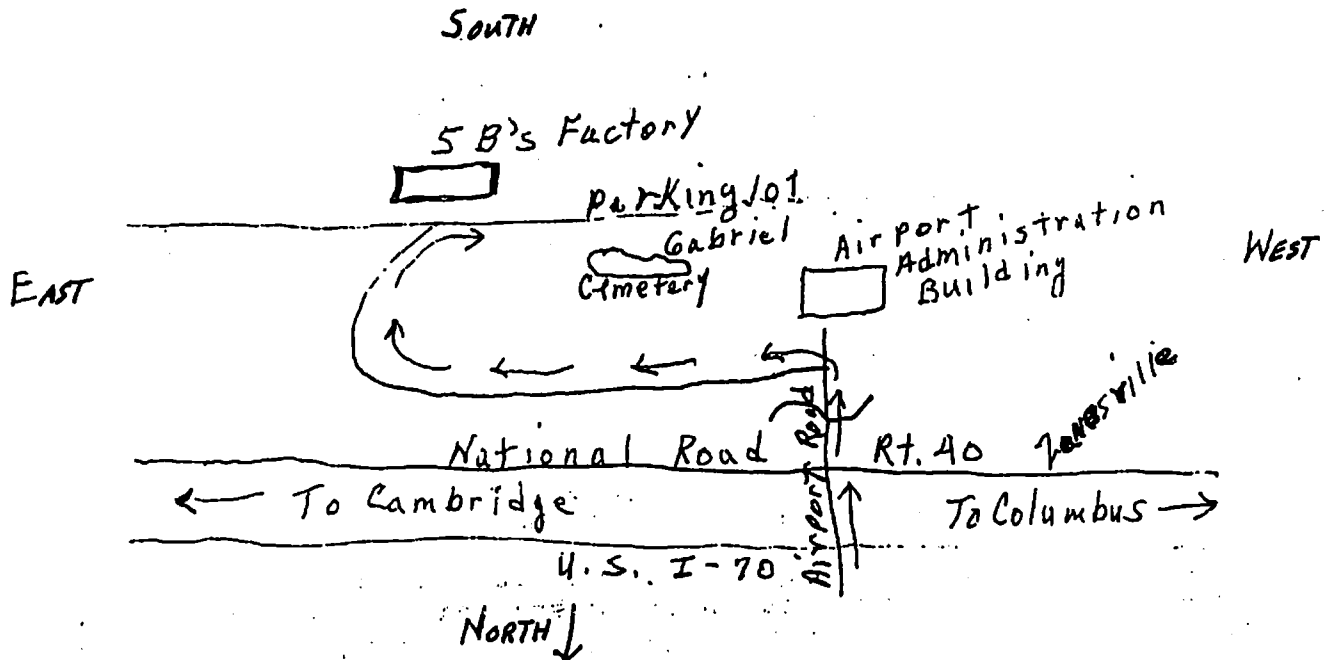

### GABRIEL FAMILY CEMETERY

Located near the Zanesville Municipal Airport, Perry Township, Muskingum Co. Ohio, across the road from the 5B's factory parking lot, in a wooded glade that can be seen from the road. The cemetery was restored in 1997 by Bruce, John and Thomas Gabriel, and their nephew, Matthew McCulla, and was dedicated July 13, 1997. Historically, this is the oldest cemetery in Perry township.



#### BURIALS, Gabriel Cemetery:

ABRAHAM GABRIEL, b. 1738, Md. d. 1808, Oh.; Revolutionary War Vet. 1777-1781. First death in Perry Tp. Muskingum Co.

JONATHAN GABRIEL, b. 1768, Pa., d. 8 Aug. 1850, Oh., 82 yrs. son of Abraham.

MARY GABRIEL, b. 1768, Pa. d. 1850, Oh., 85 yrs., wife of Jonathan

ARCHIBALD GABRIEL, b. 1797, Pa., d. 1832, Oh., son/ Jonathan & Mary

DELILAH GABRIEL, b. 1807, Pa., d. 25 July 1865, 58 yrs., Dau./J. & M. Small dau. of Delilah Gabriel, buried near her mother.

#### NOTE:

New stones have been erected for Abraham, Jonathan, Mary, Archibald and Delilah's daughter. Delilah's white obelisk was reclaimed from the debris that covered it, was cleaned and reset as was the foundation stones and the wrought-iron fence that surrounded the plot.

This information has been submitted by Ione Bradford Supplee, a direct descendant from Abraham, Jonathan and Archibald Gabriel. Dated November 1, 1997.
