Naturalization Record for Hannah Carolina Bahrd Herzog

Petition for Naturalization—Circuit Court of Crook County, Oregon

The petition of Hannah Carolina HERZOG formerly Hannah Carolina BAHRD. My place of residence is Cline Falls, Crook County, Oregon. My occupation is farming. I was born on the 2nd day of December, 1866, at Skenninge, Sweden. I emigrated to the United States from Gottenburg, Sweden, on or about the 10th day of March 1885, and arrived in the United States, at the port of New York, on the 31st day of March 1885, on the vessel *Rickmond*. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 20th day of October, 1904 at Blackfoot, Idaho, in the District Court of Bingham County. I am not married. I am a divorced widow.

I have two children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows: Rosie Wilhelmina HERZOG, born May 28, 1906 at Idaho Falls, Idaho, and Violet Carolina HERZOG, born November 6, 1908 at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Both reside with me at Cline Falls, Crook County, Oregon.

I have resided continuously in the United States of America since the 31st day of March 1885, and in the State of Oregon since the 30th day of October 1910.
