John Wall and Patsy Jay admrs. of Joseph Jay returned into court the amt. of sale of the personal estate of's decd. and amt. of books debts. Also an additional inventory of said Jays estate.

On motion the court appoints Patsey Jay guardian to Edward, Narcisa, Sall, James and Joseph Jay orphans minors of the said Joseph Jay decd. who come into open court & entered into bond with John Goode & Ric Goode in the sum of five hundred and fifty pounds for her faithful guardianship.

The court granted the petition of Patsey Jay widow of Joseph Jay decd. and orders that a surveyor and jury allowed under the act of assembly to lay off to the said Patsey Jay her dower in land.

October 1816

On motion ordered by court that the widow Jay now the wife of Joseph Scoggin be allowed the sum of two hundred dollars out of the estate of said dec'd for the maintenance of six children three years.

#### Notes for MARTHA "PATSEY" GOODE:

Martha was the daughter of Edward Goode, III born in 1749 in Lunenburg County, Virginia. He died in 1799 in Rutherford County, North Carolina. He was married in 1769 at Henrico County, Virginia, to Mary (Polly) daughter of Lusby Turpin and wife Sarah Redford. Edward Goode, III was the son of Edward Goode, Jr. and wife Judith Morton Goode. Martha Goode was the third child; born in 1772 in Mecklenburg County, Va. After Joseph Jay died, Martha "Patsy" Goode Jay married Joseph Scoggins. They married August 27, 1810 in Rutherford County, North Carolina. They had three children John N. Scoggins born Dec. 19, 1819, Turper Goode Scoggins born March 13, 1821, and Nancy Jane Scoggins born Oct. 31, 1825. Joseph Scoggins had married Joseph Jay's sister Lydia.

Cox NC Volunteers in the Quartermaster under command of M. O. Dickenson as in the Indian War, that her maiden name was Mary V. Jay and she married James Blanton February 28, 1822 in Rutherford Co., NC by Rev. Drury Dobbins. That her husband died in Wyndotte, Kansas 29 March, 1871; that her Post Office when making application was Green Hill, Rutherford County, North Carolina. Two witnesses to her signature were M. E. Walker and Mary Gibson.

Notes for AMOS WAGGONER:

From "The Waggoner Family" by John Garland Waggoner, et al:

"Amos, son of Isaac and Emsey Holeyfield Waggoner, was born in Rutherford County, North Carolina, October 11, 1804. He and Narcissa W. Jay were married March 28, 1822, and had three children, Martha (Jay), Isaac V(estal) and James M(onroe) at the time they left North Carolina in 1827 with the first caravan of Waggoners. Amos Waggoner was elected a justice of the peace and officiated as such at the first marriage in Moultrie County (Illinois), April 12, 1843. The contracting parties were David Strain, a widower of Moultrie County, and Mrs. Sarah Ball, a widow of Shelby County. They came to Amos' cabin on horseback where the ceremony was performed, and afterward went away on their horses in a handgallop, a very happy couple. Amos was also a farmer, stock-raiser and storekeeper of a county store in Whitley township; then with his family moved to Sullivan in the early part of 1850, where he kept a hotel, for two years on the corner where the opera house burned a few years ago. He afterwards owned a wagon repair shop, and also made new wagons, in connection with Owen Seaney, who owned a blacksmith shop. Amos Waggoner died in Sullivan, January 23, 1854 at the age of fifty years. At the time of his death he was Associated County Judge. His widow survived until July 17, 1881, dying in Sullivan at the age of seventy-six years. Her son, Dr E(lisha) F. Waggoner, later writing of his mother's death says, She was born May 7, 1805. She was a member of the Baptist Church. To her I am indebted mainly for whatever is in me that is good, but mother is gone-not dead, for the pure soul of a good, kind and loving Christian mother can never die-gone before to that Heavenly home, that House not made with hands. Thanks be to god for giving mother the power to swallow up death in victory. God bless the name of Mother."

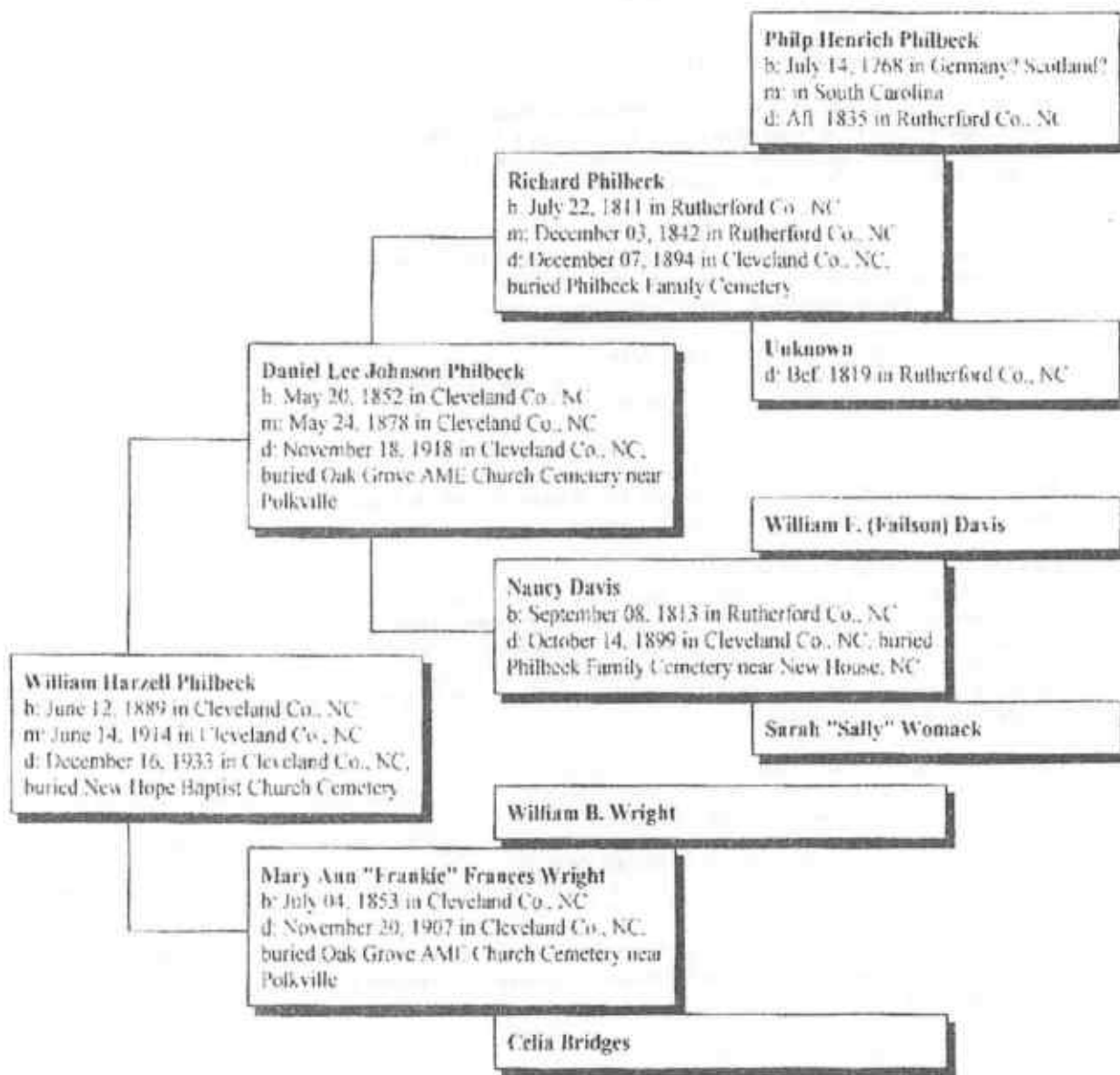
