Elisha, a ship's captain, was shipwrecked on a voyage from Maryland to London 29 Mar 1699 on the Isle of Sables. They built a boat from the many wrecks and were rescued by a fishing sloop, out of Salem, John Webb, Master.

Joseph was his father's heir and inherited an estate of about 1800 pounds, in 1724.

Joseph Ilsley, Jun, was one of the men put under command of James Jackman on 15 Jun 1707. On 12 Feb 1739, Joseph had a share of the township in NH, laid out to "Soldiers in the Expedition to Canada 1690" under the command of Capt John March, Capt Stephen Greenleaf and Capt Philip Nelson. In 1755, Joseph Ilsley, Jun, was in Capt Richard Kents Co, in the Crown Point Expedition.

Samuel Sewalls's diary February 1712/13 entries mentioned that a William Ilsley was a boarder in the house of Samuel Jr and Rebecca (Dudley) Sewall. Rebecca was the dau of Gov Joseph Dudley of MA. Samuel Jr went home to his parents due to his wife's attention to William Ilsley. Rebecca had a son, born 9 Dec 1716. This son was probably William Ilsley's as Rebecca Sewell had not lived with her husband since January 1715.

William participated in the planning, surveying, and layout of home lots for the plantation of Boscawen, NH. He was on a committee with Joseph Gerrish, John Coffin, Tristram Little and Joseph Noyes. He willed his rights in the Township of Boscawen to his grandsons, Richard and Jonathan. [History of Boscawen].

23. Isaac Ilsley b. 3 Jul 1698, Newbury, MA, m. 16 Mar 1720/21, in Newbury, MA, Abigail Moody, b. 30 Sep 1703, (daughter of Joshua Moody and Mary Greenleaf) d. 5 Dec 1773, Portland, ME. Isaac d. 15 Apr 1781, Back Cove.

Removed to Falmouth (ME) about 1735. Isaac and sons, Joshua and Isaac, went on the expedition to Louisburg, in 1745.

Isaac and Mr Pearson built a meeting house in Kittery in 1726-27. He built and lived in a garrison house in Back Cove (ME) in which he died. It was taken down by his grandson Henry Ilsley about 1860. When Willis History of Portland was written in 1864, a portion of his farm belonged to the heirs of his grandson Isaac. He was bold and enterprising man; was an officer in the Expedition to Cape Breton, was frequently engaged as leader of scouts against the Indians. He built two boats to resist the Indians on Lake Sebago. He destroyed their boats. In 1750 he had 100 men to go against them at Saco and Grimes. His prompt action did much to protect the settlements. He superintended the building of the First Parish Church tower (1761).
