

*Jack*

This information was sent to the "YOUR FAMILY TREE", 1082 Maple St., Indiana, Pa. 15701, printed in Volume XII Page 30. It is hoped more data can be found about these JACK families because Susannah Jack married Christopher Cornelius in Zanesville, Ohio on Sept. 27, 1827. It is believed that her father was James Jack. See Page 22 of this "MOHR NEWS".

Many Land Owners in Pennsylvania were men by the name of JACK. Warrantees in the Pennsylvania Archives, 3rd Ser. Vol. XXVI:

Pg. 192 - James Jack - 400 acres in Northumberland Co on 11December 1784.

Pg. 199 - James Jack - 400 acres, 6 August 1794

Pg. 550 - James Jack - - 400 acres Bedford Co. 10 April 1794  
John Jack - 400 acres, same date and County.  
William Jack - 400 acres, same date and County.

Pg. 549 - All these men named JACK received 400 acres each in Bedford Co., 12march 1794: Benjamin, Francis, William, Moses, Jeremiah, Charles, Samuel, Henry, Richard, Robert, Joseph, John, Jonathan, Timothy, Joab, Saul, and Paul. Total of 8000 acres.

Reference from William's, "History of Washington Co., Md.": In 1739 Jeremiah Jack obtained 175 acres near Swede's Delight which he called "Jack's Bottom". In 1739 the second settlement owned by Thomas Cresap obtained 500 acres called "Long Meadows"

Jeremiah Jack m. Anna Swain in 1729 in Pa. In his will in 1785 in Berkeley Co., Va. mentions: James Jack; John Jack; Ann McGlaughlin; Elizabeth Pearce; and -----Shelby.

Jeremiah Jack b. 1750 d. Hune 1833 R.W. Soldier N.C. married Martha Gillespie.

\*\*\*\*\*

Capt. James Jack b 1731 d Dec. 18, 1822, R.W. Soldier, married Margaret Houston and lived in Charlotte, N.C.

\*\*\*\*\*

James Jack, Capt. in R.W. in S.C., died in Cambridge, Ohio January 10, 1839, buried in Founders Cemetery.

Reference from "History of Allegheny County, Pa": James Jack and his brother, Andrew Jack were among the early settlers in that County. Andrew's sons were James, John, Leslie, & Samuel.

He doesn't always answer letters because he's spending so much time trying to get his businesses going & working on gathering info for the Jack Book. There is no print date or price as yet. The Jack Newsletter is \$6.00 per year subscription & that is through me.

I have your Kilgores & Jacks on file. I'd like to get your descent from James William Kilgore if possible. The following data might be useful to you.

James William Kilgore born 1701 or 1720 in Donagheady, Down Ireland, son of John Kilgore who came to the U.S. in 1780 with sons James, Charles & Samuel & died in Chester Co, Pa 7 Mar 1731. He in turn was the son of James Kilgore. That's all I have on the ancestry of the Kilgore clan. One source claims James William had 5 step brothers, but does not name them. James William Kilgore was married in Newville, Pa, no date given. His will dated 23 Aug 1771 & proved 10 Sep 1771 in Cumberland Co Pa. He married Elizabeth Jack born 9 Sep 1727, died Feb 1792 in Newton Tp, Cumb., Pa, daughter of James Jack & Elizabeth McNulty. (See later for her ancestry.)

Children of James William Kilgore & Elizabeth Jack all born at Green Spring, Newton Tp, Cumberland Co, Pa were (given out of order, sorry):

7. Jesse Kilgore b 11 Dec 1873, died 1794, married (1) 26 May 1789 Jane Holmes, married (2) 19 Aug 1792 Jane Clark daughter of Robin Clark.
8. (Rev.) Robert Kilgore born abt 1760, married 20 Jan 1791 Margaret Kelly.
9. Dinah Kilgore no further information.
10. William Kilgore born 1755/56 died 11 Oct 1823, married Apr 1784 Isabella Mathers.
11. Benjamin Kilgore born 1740 died 1810 in Greenville SC married abt 1764 (1) Anne McCreary b ca 1745, d. 1766 SC, married (2) Jean McDavid.
12. Hugh Obed Kilgore died 23 Apr 1805 Tyrone Tp, Pa married Jean Forbes, daughter of Andrew Forbes.

13. Joseph Kilgore born abt 1742, married Isabella Stephens
14. Oliver Kilgore born abt 1747
15. Daniel Kilgore born 1769 died 1850 married 1798 Rachel Reynolds
16. Charles Kilgore, no further info
17. James Kilgore, died Ala age 100+
18. Samuel Kilgore, died young
19. son Kilgore died infancy
20. son Kilgore died infancy
21. son Kilgore died infancy.

I have further info on descendants of some of these lines which I'll be glad to share.

Elizabeth Jack, b 9 Sep 1727 in MD or Chester, Pa died Feb 1792, wife of James William Kilgore was the daughter of James Jacques/Jack born 2 May 1705 Ballykelly, Londonderry, Ireland & his wife Elizabeth McNulty. There is some confusion with the wife & birth date of this James as there was a cousin James who married a McNulty & lived Chester Co, Pa also. Nevertheless, these children are probably correct:

1. (Capt.) John Jack born 11 Mar 1726, died Apr 1808, married Eleanor Stevenson.
2. Elizabeth Jack (as above)
3. (Capt.) James Jack born 1 Oct 1728, died 30 Sep 1776, married Jane or Mary Jane Carnahan
4. Martha Jack born 11 Aug 1729. She was unmarried in 1821.
5. (Col.) Patrick Jack born 4 Jan 1730, died 25 Jan 1821, married 27 Jun 1765 Martha Finley.
6. Andrew Jack born 9 May 1731, unmarried
7. Samuel Jack born 1736 Hopewell Tp, Cumb., Pa died 1818, married 29 Dec 1766 Martha Herron.

The parents of James Jacques/Jack were:

Patrick Jacques/Jack born 3 Dec 1678 near Cannongate, Edingburgh, Scot., died 1726, Chester Co, Pa, married 4 Dec 1699 perhaps in Ballykelly, Ireland, Eleanor/Ellen Jervis of Londonderry Co, Ireland, daughter of James Jervis. Their children all born in Ballykelly Ireland except the seventh who was born in Ardstraw, Tyrone, Ireland:

1. Patrick Jack b 19 Sep 1700, died 5 Oct 1780, married 1728 Lillis McAdoo.
2. James Jack b 2 May 1705 (as above)
3. Robert Jack b 19 May 1706 died after 26 Mar 1787 in Ardstraw, Tyrone, Ireland
4. Andrew Jack b 24 Dec 1706 (dates as cited in source, obviously a problem, perhaps these are christening dates) married 5 Sep 1728 Elizabeth or Mary Ann McNulty.
5. Samuel Jack b 1 Feb 1708, will dated 27 Jan 1739/40, married 13 Jun 1733 Jane White.
6. John Jack b 14 Jul 1710 died 1784 West Caln, Chester, Pa married Elizabeth \_\_\_\_\_. No issue.
7. Matthew Jack b 17 May 1711 died 4 Nov 1763, married 17 Sep 1751 Jane Wilson.

Parents of Patrick Jack b 1678 were:

Jacob Jack/Jacques, christened 19 May 1655 Chesney, France, married (1) 7 Apr 1678 Edinburgh, Midlothian, Scot. Nancy Farquhar born 4 Aug 1657 in Scot. or France died 14 Nov 1689, daughter of Alexander Farquhar & Margaret Leitsche. Married (2) 6 Apr 1701 Madelaine Dornand, daughter of Jacques Dornand & Marthe Fouchier. (They had 5 daughters for which I have dates & some marriages but will not give them here.)

Children of Jacob & Nancy Farquhar Jacques/Jack all born in Edinburgh, Midlothian, Scotland were:

1. Patrick Jack as above.
2. James Jack born 7 Mar 1680, died 21 Mar 1754, married Anne -----
3. Lancelot Jacques b 16 Oct 1683, died 14 Aug 1748, married 6 Jul 1709 Jane Gilbert.
4. Danton Jacques (twin) born 1 Jan 1687 died Cumberland Co, England (some confusion & disagreement on this.)
5. Mary Jack (twin) born 1 Jan 1687 married William Peairs/Pearce/Pierce
6. Jean/John Jack born 7 Mar 1688, died 1759, married Freeloove Ford.
7. Jeremiah Jack born 2 Jan 1689 died abt 1785, married 11 Jul 1724 Philadelphia Pa, Ann Swaine/Suane (my line)
8. David Jack born 14 Aug 1691 (these may be christening dates, if not, there must have been another wife of Jacob between Nancy & Madeline.)

Parents of Jacob Jacques/Jack were:

Guillaume Jacques chr. 16 Sep 1633 Chesney, France, died Edinburgh, Scot. married Jeanne Daniel who had married (1) Jean Beman & (2) Henri De Ronde. Their children:

2. Thomas Jacques chr 3 Aug 1657 Chesney, France married 1693 Mary M'Ghie
3. Margaret Jacques chr 5 Sep 1663 Nouzon, France, married 4 May 1687 Daniel McFarland.

Parents of Guillaume Jacques were:

Guillaume Jacques chr 7 Feb 1592 Chesney, France, died 1675, Nouzon, France, married 4 Apr 1627 to Margueriete De Gasque of Miolet & Prendemmis, France who will is dated 3 Dec 1683, daughter of Louis De Gasque & Clair De Frudhomme. Marguerite md (2) 4 Aug 1677 Jean Charpentier. Children of Guillaume Jacques chr 1592 were:

1. Robert Jacques chr 18 Mar 1628 Chesney, married Elizabeth McCay
2. Jacob Jacques chr 13 May 1631 Chesney no issue
3. Louis Jacques (twin) chr 7 Oct 1632 Chesney, died 29 Aug 1692 St Pierre de Loudun, Poitiers, Poitou, married 3 Nov 1661 Adelaide Dufernell. No issue.
4. Nicholas Jacques (twin) chr 7 Oct 1632, married 3 Nov 1661
5. Guillaume Jacques (as above)
6. Jean/John Jacques chr 12 Aug 1634, married 7 Sep 1658 Jeanne Morgan, daughter of John Morgan

7. Thomas Jacques chr 2 Jul 1635, married 10 Aug 1664 Marie De La Croix
8. Jeanne Jack/Jacques chr 17 Feb 1736 Nouzon, France married 11 Aug 1651 Godfrey Kirke.
9. Sarah Jacques (no date) married Stephen Warne
10. Grace Jacques (no date) married Thomas Barton.

Parents of Guillaume Jacques chr 1592 were:

Jean Jacques, a jeweler or goldsmith in Chesney, France, chr there 3 Aug 1551, died 19 May 1643, married 3 Jun 1590 Marguerite or Marie DeRonde who died 14 Aug 1644 in Chesney, France, daughter of Adrian DeRonde & Marguerite Duford.

Parents of Jean Jacques chr 1551 were:

Jacobus Jacques/James born 4 Oct 1528 Utrecht, Holland, will dated 4 Aug 1609 Chesney, France, married 19 Dec 1549 to Corinne Bloedel born in Hesdin, Artois, France, died after 1609, the eldest daughter of Guillaume Bloedel & Jeanne Beauprez. Jacobus James/Jacques was a grandson of Roger Jacques/James & is mentioned as such in his will. Jacobus went to England 1558 then Hesdin, Artois, France, to Bavay in French Flanders near Valenciennes at Chesney or Le Quesnoy Manor abt 1559. Their children were:

1. Jacobus/Jacques Jacques chr 1 May 1550 Hesdin, Artois, France, married 7 Aug 1572? Marie Bascom
2. Johannis/Jean Jacques chr 1551 (as above)

The Jack/Jacques were Presbyterians, French Huguenots & their devout faith accounts for their many moves as political pressures & persecutions were brought to bear on the "non-conformist" religions. Sources for the above information are the Jacques Family by G. Anjou (available on microfilm from the LDS library), will of Jacobus Jacques, deeds, marriage contracts, & a 28 volume collection of genealogical journals kept by Josiah Van Kirk Thompson (1854-1933). The journals have just been typed & indexed, but ~~no~~ copies are not yet available. They will eventually be in the LDS library in Salt Lake City, we hope. I have one of the three existing copies.

Hope this has been of some use. There are some holes & things that need to be proven, but your line is one that is fairly well documented except for the McNulty wife problem & some confusion between the two James both given birth dates in 1705. We think we have all their children straight, but deeds are a mess to work with & we may be missing some children also.
