Carl L. Dolan of near Sullivan, Illinois was killed Tuesday, November 7, 1952 in a hunting accident. He was the son of Jerry C. and Grace Dolan and was born in Moultrie County, April 5, 1912. He was survived by his wife Mary and three children, Ralph, Terry, and Sandra and two brothers, Paul and Hugh Dolan.

Charles Winchester died in 1942. He worked at the shoe factory and City Sewer Construction. He was married and had two sons, Charles and Jerry. They are both married and each have two children.

Hugh L. Righter worked at his home with his parents for two years after graduation. Then he entered the sales field and served as distributor of various fire extinguisher equipment. His health which was never good, continued to fail and he died March 11, 1935 at the age of 24 years.

County Clerk Ralph Hanrahan passed away at 7:30 on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1948. He was born June 28, 1912 and had resided in Sullivan many years. After graduation he was employed in a shoe store here for several years. Later he was employed in the local Brown Shoe Company plant. In 1938, he was elected County Clerk of Moultrie County and was re-elected in 1942 and again in 1946. He was survived by his wife, Velma and two daughters, Peggy Joyce and Margie Ellen.
