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BOOK REVIEWS

WILLS AND WAYS - Miscellaneous Kentucky Records - compiled and published by the Kentucky Gen. Soc., Inc. of Frankfort, Kentucky - 1975. 100 pages, soft cover; \$4.30 per copy. Contains wills, marriage records, Bible records, deeds, and many miscellaneous records contributed by various members of the society. Very helpful and neatly presented. Would be much more helpful with a name index, but none the less, valuable research aid for those interested in the areas and localities presented. The nominal price makes it available for all. Some of the names picked at random by this editor include: PAYTON, RICHARDSON, QUINN, JENKINS, FRANK, JONES, TODD, plus many others. Should be a good reference aid for many. BARRICKMAN-BARRACKMAN OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA - published by Miss June B. Barekman, Genealogist - Genealogical Services & Publications - 3302 West Diversey - Chicago, Ill. 60647 - 1974. 37 pages, soft cover, \$5.00. With complete name index. As usual, Miss Barekman has done a very good job presenting the records of the family from Crawford Co. Penn. and moved to Ohio, Kansas and Nebraska. Contains census, service, biographies, etc. for those bearing the Barrickman (includes various spellings of the name). The allied names include: ALBAUG, ALIEN, BAKER, BENNETT, BOLERJACK, CALLAWAY, CRAWFORD, DEX, ECKART, ELLIS, FOLEY, GRANT, HAMILTON, HUGHES, JACKSON, KELLEY, LINDSEY, MAYER, MILLER, NEFF, NELSON, PATTERSON, ROBERTSON, ROBINSON and many others. Very useful, neatly done, and within the price range of many researchers.

BLUE RIDGE MOUNTAIN KINFOLKS - by Larry King - 1001 Lincoln St. - Manchester, TN 37355. The history of FISHER, GILBERT, HALL, HARTLEY, HILL, KING, KIRBY and LAWSON families of the Blue Ridge Mountains in Virginia. The geographical area covered is that in which so many pioneer families lived and from where numerous of their descendants migrated and settled in hundreds of communities throughout America. Information is recorded on principal families and members of descendant families over a period of up to twelve generations. Includes: ALLEY, ANDERS, ANDERSON, BARTLE, BEDWELL, BYRD, COLE, COMPTON, CORNETT, CORVIN, CROCKETT, DELP, EVANS, EVANS, FUNK, GRUBB, HARRINGTON, HASH, HITTLE, HUDDIE, HUFF, JACKSON, JENKINS, JOHNSON, KEITH, KILBOURNE, MARTIN, MATHEWS, McKINNON, MILLER, OSBORNE, POOLE, PORTER, REYNOLDS, RHODY, RICHARDSON, SCOTT, SEXTON, SHULER, SNOW, SUTHERLAND, TAYLOR, THOMPSON, TIPTON, VAUGHAN, VAUGHT, WADDELL, WALKER, WILLIAMS, WINGATE and WRIGHT. The 6x9 blue cloth bound book has gold lettering on front and spine and a blue ridge mountain scene in gold on front. 335 pages in 9 pt type on 60 lb paper with 414 photographs and 2 types of new and improved ancestral flow charts. Name index has more than 7500 people incl. Very, very good recording and should be on a lot of shelves for the price of \$15.00 per copy.

NOTE: These are all of the transactions I found for JOHN KENNEDY from 1794-1823. I included two other KENNEDY families as I thought they might have been relatives since they, too, lived in Locke. The writing, spelling and lengthy wording of the deeds of nearly 200 years ago is not easily understood today, particularly when they described NYS and Military Lots. I may have misinterpreted some of it, but believe names, dates, and places are correct.

Onon Gen Vol. II, by Bruce on p. 183 mentions a GEORGE KENNEDY JR. who moved from Saratoga Co., N.Y. to Marcellus, Onon. Co., N.Y. in 1816. GEORGE SR. came from Ireland to America in 1760. GEORGE JR.'s wife's father, Ebenezer Dibble, and GEORGE SR. fought in the Battle of Saratoga, where Ebenezer Dibble was killed. (I have seen many queries in the NUT-MEGGER on the Daboll-Dibble families.)

From Alice C. Moellenbeck: Surrogates Court, Columbia Co., N.Y. (Hudson) ROBERT KENNEDY, will dated 1847 mentions wife SUSAN and sons DAVID & WILLIAM. The petition mentions Jane Howland. Stockport.

ALEXANDER KENNEDY of Hillsdale, d. 1831. Letter of Administration, lists wife CORNELIA. Survived by a sister and two nephews. A sister in Ireland.

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. = a CAMPBELL KENNEDY d. March 25, 1838, aged 49, buried Jones Cemetery.

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A KENNEDY LEGEND

Contributed by M. W. Cannady - 2740 Los Amigos Dr. - Rancho Cordova, CA 95670: "I think that your Kennedy Klues is a great help to those searching for their ancestors. You may use the Kennedy Legend if you think that it will not offend our generation - I have not heard this story since about 1930; but it is about what was told when I was in high school."

LEGEND: The old folks called themselves "the Wolf Pack", and the Menfolk painted a wolf's head on their shields. They were warriors, who lived and, usually died by the sword.

They were kith and kin of the Old Men of Conal.

The Pack went over to Caladonia to chase the Cats.

Some of them had stayed with their kinsmen in Cowall; but most of them settled on the Ayr and the Doon. Kenneth's Bunch settled on the Cree.

In the time of Malcolm (?) they were sending help to their kinsmen in Antrim and Cowall.

Norman Conquest: This was said to be a new ball game. The Danes (Norse) had brought the pony. The Normans brought the horse. The Normans brought the Church of Rome; and the old folks did not, exactly, run a foot race to be first to accept the yoke of Rome.

In time, they became Normanized and Romanized; and things got better. The (Robert) Bruces becam Kinfolks.

There was a gathering of the Clan. Some of those who had been up in the Islands came back to Carrick (probably after 1266, when Alexander III ceded the Hebrides to Norway).

Reformation of the Church was said to have set brother against brother, and father against son. And of this struggle, it was said: "The Old Folks had their day, now it's time to let them rest. Dragging their bones over the embers will do no one any good."

From M. W. Cannady - 3/20/76: It has been called to my attention that a comment made in the Kennedy Legend is incorrect and after checking two other sources, I find that this is probably true. Relating to the gathering of the clan my comment was: (Probably after 1266, when Alexander III ceded the Hebrides to Norway). It should have been: "Probably after 1266 when Norway ceded the Hebrides to Scotland." I'm sorry for reversing history!.....

Contributed by Naomi E. (Twidwell) Perry - 3097 Wayside Loop - Springfield, Oregon 97477. From Vermillion Times newspaper - Vermillion Kansas - Thursday October 17, 1912:

JOHN WILLIAM KENNEDY was born in Plymouth, Hancock County, Illinois March 30, 1840, and died near Vermillion, Kansas, October 8, 1912. Age 72 years, 6 months, 8 days.

He was married to Miss Polly Myers, and to this union was born 1 child, CARRIE ELIZABETH. His wife died after they had been married about 3 years.

He afterward married Miss Catherine Hendrickson. To this union was born 7 children: MARY, ADELINE, JOHN WILLIAM, SARAH ANNE, MELISSA JANE, HATTIE BELLE, JESSIE and JAMES TAYLOR.

All of the children survive him except JESSIE, who died when 4 years old; JAMES TAYLOR, who died in infancy and CARRIE ELIZABETH who died at the age of 41 years. His second wife died in 1878.

The deceased came to Kansas about 12 years ago and made his home with his daughter, Mrs. Frank Twidwell, and it was here that he died. -----

1900 census shows JOHN W. KENNEDY living with his daughter, Mary Henderickson, in St. Mary's Township, Hancock County, Illinois. There were several children listed in the same household. The daughter, MARY, is listed as a widow.

NOTE BY BLP: Mrs. Mayes letter was quite interesting, so I am publishing it too!

"I am enclosing information concerning my maternal great-grandfather, LEWIS SMITH KENNEDY and a query. I would be so happy if I could just learn who his parents were! Have you done any research on the late JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY? ancestors? I have done a little that I would be happy to send you if you could use it. A second cousin of mine says her father tells her that his father used to have horses shipped to him in Nebraska from Ireland that were from J. F. K.'s ancestors, but I have no way of proving that this is true. All I know for sure is that my great-grandfather was born in Pennsylvania about 10 years before PATRICK KENNEDY, great-grandfather of J. F. K. emigrated to America at the age of 24 from Co. Wexford, Ireland, so our KENNEDY's were here ahead of them by several years. I will be anxiously awaiting my back copy of "KENNEDY KLUES" and also the February issue. I'm so glad I read about your publication in the Genealogical Helper. Thanks for everything."

P.S. Just in case you should happen to be curious, perhaps I should explain that MARY E. (KENNEDY) Henson was my grandmother, and Sarah Bolger is my mother, who is the only living member of her family and is now 84 years old, having been born July 21, 1891. I have some other KENNEDY bits of information not pertaining to my line, that I will send you at a later date. It would be a dreadful shame if your research bulletin couldn't keep on because of lack of material. In an emergency you could, of course, fall back on Who Was Who and Who's Who, couldn't you? I work at the local library and we have quite a number of old D.A.R. books that I've already checked for my line, but I think there may have been other KENNEDYs in them. Another very interesting letter received by EDMOND KENNEDY was from his brother in Abbeville District, South Carolina: MICHAEL KENNEDY. He can be found in the 1850 census of Abbeville, S.C., with a number of the children he mentions in his household. This letter is interesting because of all the names mentioned.

From MICHAEL KENNEDY's letter, it is obvious that JESSE's name is really JESSE FREMONT KENNEDY (for whom my great-grandfather was named), that there is also a brother JOHN KENNEDY, a brother ROBERT KENNEDY, a sister NANCY KENNEDY married to someone named Edward _____; and a brother JOSEPH KENNEDY, called "JOLLY". With Michael Kennedy and EDMOND KENNEDY, there are at least seven children. These could be the children of EDMUND KENNEDY mentioned in Abbeville District and whose inventory was made in 1805.

From this letter and the 1850 South Carolina Census for Abbeville District, the children of MICHAEL KENNEDY and his wife, Agnes Carlile KENNEDY, are as follows:

My direct KENNEDY line is through a son of EDMOND KENNEDY, JESSE FREMONT KENNEDY. He was born on 18 January 1834 in Pike County, Ga. and died in Newton Co., Mississippi on 25 August 1869. He was married on 17 July 1859 in Meridian, Lauderdale County, Mississippi, to Olivia Ophelia Trussell, born 3 December 1843 Lauderdale, Mississippi, died 21 March 1899 in Quanah, Hardeman County, Texas, daughter of James Madison Trussell and his wife Susannah Slaughter Parks.

My grandmother was the first child of JESSE FREMONT KENNEDY and Olivia Ophelia Trussell. SUSAN ALICE KENNEDY, born 30 November, 1860 in Lauderdale County, Mississippi, died 14 May 1920 in Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma. She married first Edgar E. Edwards in Llano County, Texas, and after his death she married my grandfather, William Wesley Cochran in Llano County, Texas.

JESSE FREMONT KENNEDY and Olivia Ophelia Trussell had three other children: EMMA F. KENNEDY, born 8 September 1864 Newton Co., Miss., married her first cousin, William H. Altman, Jr.; WILLIAM NEWTON KENNEDY, born 27 October 1866; and SARAH DORA KENNEDY, born 25 November 1868, married 13 November, 1884 Llano Co., Texas to James Stegall, and died 15 December 1899 in Quanah, Hardeman County, Texas.

JESSE FREMONT KENNEDY died on 25 August 1869 of a wound he suffered during the Civil War. After his death his widow married a widower, Henry Johnson Reynolds and moved with him to Llano County, Texas.

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KENNEDY BIOGRAPHIES

Contributed by Carl Holtz - 445 - A Heritage Vlg. - Southbury, Connecticut 06488, with the following comments: I am enclosing photocopies of three pages appearing in Holman's "Blackman and Allied Families" together with a few additional items on these Voluntown KENNEDYs researched by me. Also on a Tax list for the Cossackie District, Albany County, New York, dated March 6, 1780, and owned by the Greene County Historical Society, appears the name of JAMES CANADY. From the History of Saratoga County, New York we find on the Town of Ballston Tax list for 1779, we find the names of THOMAS KENNEDY and JOHN KENNEDY. Also in the Dutchess County New York Genealogical Society publication, Vol. 3, No. 4, on page 4: A list of members of Solomon's Masonic Lodge of Poughkeepsie 1771-1826, shows the name of WILLIAM KENNEDY, 1807.

Page 121 - 122 - 123 - 124 from Blackman and Allied Families:

WILLIAM KENNEDY, of Preston, New London County, Conn., clothier, made his will Sep. 23, 1727, in which he mentions his sons DAVID, HUGH, JOHN and ROBERT, and daughters AGNES Dixon and JENNET Love. (New London Probate Records, C-344.) The inventory of his estate was taken Apr. 8, 1728, and the witnesses appeared in "Preston April 9, 1728" (Ibid., C-345). No settlement of the estate is found and not until after the death of the son JOHN, about 1752, is there any trace of it. The brother ROBERT KENNEDY sold his share to his brother JOHN, who had already paid brother HUGH for his part, so HUGH deeds to widow and JOHN's six children.

Feb. 16, 1744-5. ROBERT KENNEDY of Norwich, New London Co., Conn., clothier, for £ 40, deeds to JOHN KENNEDY of Voluntown, Windham Co., Conn., one fourth part of land in Voluntown, the 7th lot in 6th tear in the first division of lots in Voluntown. (Voluntown Land Records, 2-53.)

May 15, 1752. HUGH KENNEDY of Voluntown, husbandman, for £80 already paid by JOHN KENNEDY, late of Voluntown, dec'd, deeds to JOHN KENNEDY, DANIEL KENNEDY, ANNE KENNEDY, MARY KENNEDY, JOSEPH KENNEDY and ELIZABETH KENNEDY, all of sd Voluntown, all right to the 7th lot of the 6th tear of lots in the first division of Voluntown lands. Charles Campbell & ROBERT KENNEDY, witnesses. (Ibid., 4-50.)

In 1756 division was recorded.

John Smith Esq. & Robert Dixon Esq. both of Voluntown, Conn., appointed by the Court of Probate for the District of Plainfield, with one John Kasson of Voluntown, to ascertain & distribute the real estate of Mr. WILLIAM KENNEDY Late of Preston deceased according to his last will, viz: the 7th lot of land in the 6th tear of Lotts in Voluntown ye 72nd in number originally laid out in the right of William Bennet and which according to the will was to be equally divided between four of the children of sd deceased viz:

HUGH KENNEDY of Voluntown, JOHN KENNEDY of Voluntown who is also deceased, ROBERT KENNEDY of Norwich, Conn., sons to the deceased and and to Jennet Love daughter of the deceased. And whereas the Part of sd Lott bequeathed in said will to sd HUGH and said ROBERT was purchased of them (as we understand) by sd JOHN in his lifetime, they set out to Jennet Love one quarter part, and the other three quarters to Jennet ye late widow and relict of sd JOHN deceased and to his six children, JOHN the eldest son, DANIEL and JOSEPH KENNEDY, sons, and to his three daughters, ANN, MARY, and ELIZABETH. ANN, the eldest daughter, MARY the 2nd daughter & ELIZABETH the third daughter.

Done by order of the Court Jun 8, 1756. (Plainfield Probate Records, 3-119, et seq.) The disposition of the share of the daughter Jennet Love was as follows:

Sep. 30, 1771. Jenit Love and Mary Aldrich (her daughter) both of Preston, Conn., late of Voluntown, Conn., for £ 35, sold to Joseph Gates of Preston, Conn., a tract of land in Voluntown, cont. 24 3/4 acres & 17 rods with a dwelling house, it being ye whole of ye land set out to Jenit as her part of her father KENNEDY's estate; being one fourth part of the 72nd lot in number, originally laid out in right of William Bennet. (Ibid., 5-226.)

No distribution of WILLIAM KENNEDY's estate was found, nor did his name appear on index to Voluntown land records; but as he left his land to four children, naming them, HUGH, ROBERT, JOHN and JENNET Love, these are the ones named in the above deeds. ROBERT and JENNET specify that each had a fourth part: ROBERT deeded his to his brother JOHN, who died about 1752, and HUGH deeded his part to JOHN's children, who are recorded to JOHN KENNEDY on Voluntown Vital Records.

WILLIAM KENNEDY had at least 6 children.

HUGH² KENNEDY, son of WILLIAM KENNEDY, lived in Voluntown, Conn., where he owned land partly in Voluntown and partly in Plainfield.

Aug. 29, 1748, John Anderson and wife Margaret of Voluntown, Conn., sold for £ 800 to HUGH KENNEDY of Voluntown, Wheelmaker, land partly in Plainfield and partly in Voluntown, on a hill commonly called Egunk Hill, beginning at a tree which is the South East corner of the 19th hundred acre lot on said Egunk Hill, etc. (Plainfield Land Records, 4-127.)

HUGH KENNEDY married about 1725, Rachel Billings, who was born in Preston, Mar. 1, 1704, daughter of Capt. William and Hannah (Sterry) Billings.

HUGH KENNEDY of Voluntown made his will Aug. 13, 1778 (Plainfield Probate Records, 7-222B), which the witnesses made oath to at the Probate

Court held in Plainfield, Dec. 1, 1778 (*Ibid.*, 7-222A), and it was exhibited in Court, Feb. 6, 1781, by the executor (*Ibid.*, 5-422). His wife was living at the time he made his will.

His gravestone is in the Kinne Burying Grounds at Glasgo, in the eastern part of Griswold, Conn., the inscription being as follows: "In Memory of Mr. Hugh Kennedy who died Oct. 31st 1778 about 86 Years of Age."

HUGH and RACHEL (Billings) KENNEDY had 11 children.

DAVID³ KENNEDY, son of HUGH and RACHEL (Billings) KENNEDY, was born in Voluntown, July 6, 1730 (Voluntown Vital Records, 1-61), and married in same place, Jan. 10, 1759, Mary Campbell (*Ibid.*, 1-104), who was born in Voluntown, Aug. 19, 1734 (*Ibid.*, 1-20), daughter of Rev. Robert and Mary (McMains) Campbell.

DAVID KENNEDY of Voluntown was in the Revolution and is given a service of 5 days on the Lexington Alarm of Apr. 19, 1775. (Conn. in the Rev., p. 24.) Also, a service from Aug. 24 to Oct. 23, 1777, Capt. Daniel Clark's Co., Col. Jonathan Latimer's Regt. (*Ibid.*, p. 507) Also a service commencing Jan. 8, 1778, in Capt. Moses Branch's Co., Col. Obadiah Johnson's Regiment. (*Ibid.*, p. 527.)

October 1772, DAVID KENNEDY sold land in Voluntown. (Voluntown Land Records, 5-273.)

Oct. 19, 1778. He sold his grist mill to Robert Campbell. (*Ibid.*, 6-91.)

Shortly after this, he is said to have gone to New York State, and no record of his death, or the settlement of his estate, has been found. Several of his children settled in Half Moon, Albany Co., N. Y.

DAVID and MARY (Campbell) KENNEDY had 6 children, one of them being a daughter REBECCA, born June 5, 1769 (Voluntown Vital Records, 1-104), who married (1) Dec. 6, 1789 (Early Conn. Marriages, 3-129), William Green Rhodes; (2) Jan. 3, 1797 (*Ibid.*, 3-131), Elias Keigwin.

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JACOB KENNEDY OF HENDRICKS COUNTY INDIANA

Extracted from A Portrait and Biographical Record of Boone, Clinton and Hendricks Countys Indiana - 1895: page 1060-1061.

JACOB KENNEDY, a public spirited citizen and substantial farmer of Union township, Hendricks County, Ind., was born in Bourbon County, Ky., September 10, 1823. His great grandfather, JOHN KENNEDY, a native of Ireland, was kidnaped from the shore of the isle of his birth, when but seven years of age, by a piratical crew and sold for a term of years to a planter in Maryland. JOHN KENNEDY, his son, was born in Virginia, and JOSEPH KENNEDY, father of JACOB, our subject, was born in Bourbon county., Ky., where he passed the major portion of his life in a blacksmith shop. JOSEPH KENNEDY married Elizabeth Sharer, daughter of Peter and Elizabeth (Nunamaker) Sharer, to which marriage was born THOMAS, SOPHIA N., JACOB, NICHOLAS, PETER S., MARY J., DAVID and NANCY T. The parents passed the greater portion of their lives in Paris, Ky., but spent their declining years in Hendricks county, Ind.

JACOB KENNEDY acquired his education in the pioneer log school-house of his neighborhood and as he advanced in years learned blacksmithing. In 1853 he came to Hendricks county, Ind., and has since been identified with the history of this county. In 1856 he settled on his present farm, which was then in a dense wilderness, but is now a model farm of fifty acres, improved with a modern residence, a fine barn and a large orchard. He married Martha Rupard, daughter of Erasmus and Maria (Hoggard) Rupard, of Clark county, Ky., who were also the parents of Allen, David, Elizabeth, John W., Mary, Emeline, Millie M., Gusta A., and Manda. The children born to JACOB and MARTHA KENNEDY were named ELLEN, ROBERT E., CASSIUS C., THOMAS N., OLIVER O., CORA A. and EDGAR W. MRS. KENNEDY is a member of the Christian church and in politics MR. KENNEDY is a prohibitionist, although formerly a republican; he is also a dormant Mason, and with his family is highly respected and favorably known throughout the township.

GRIFFIN BAYNE KENNEDY, LIMESTONE COUNTY TEXAS

Extracted from: Reprint of Biographies from the Lone Star State, published by Lewis Pub. Co., 1893. Contains biographies of early settlers of Navarro, Henderson, Anderson, Limestone, Freestone & Leon Counties, Texas. By Stephanie H. Tally-Frost, 1966. Page 368:

GRIFFIN BAYNE KENNEDY, of Limestone county, Texas, is of Irish extraction, and a son of GEORGE W. KENNEDY. The latter's father, JOHN KENNEDY, was a native of North Carolina, but removed to Kentucky in an

early day, and later to Tennessee. He was an early settler of Maury county, that state, where our subject's father, GEORGE W. was born. The latter married Laura A. Bayne, a native of Tennessee, and a daughter of Griffin Bayne, also a native of Franklin county, Texas, and his death occurred here in March, 1885, at the age of seventy-three years. He was a farmer and stock-raiser all his life. After coming to this county he settled at Sulphur Springs, about four miles north of the present town of Groesbeck, where his father-in-law had bought 2,000 acres of land.

Griffin Bayne, our subject's maternal grandfather, was a native of Virginia, was a pioneer settler of Tennessee, and a distinguished Texan. He was an adventurous character, and was a soldier in the war of 1835-36, with the rank of Colonel. By profession he was a physician, was well educated, was a surgeon on a ship for many years, a privateersman in the War of 1812, took up a headright in Brazos county, Texas, after the revolution in 1835, was prominent in the politics of his State, and at one time was an unsuccessful candidate for Congress. His death occurred in Brazos county, in 1848 or 1850. Our subject's mother is still living, occupying the old homestead at Sulphur Springs with her sons. There were six children in the family of GEORGE W. and LAURA A. KENNEDY as follows: FELIX GRUNDY, who died in Limestone county, leaving a family; GRIFFIN BAYNE, our subject; CLEMENT P., deceased in the Confederate army; WILLIAM A. was the next in order of birth; BELIE, wife of S. T. Arnett, of Kosse, Limestone county; and EUGENE. Three of the eldest sons were soldiers in the late war. FELIX GRUNDY and GRIFFIN were in Company C, Eighth Texas Cavalry, and the former served through the struggle in this command. GRIFFIN B. was wounded in the right arm and lung at Murfreesborough, Tennessee, in July 1862, and was afterward promoted as First Lieutenant in Mann's regiment. CLEMENT P. was in Captain Tyus' company, and was captured at Arkansas Post. He died on board the steamboat on the Mississippi river, while he was being transported to prison in the north.

I don't know whether or not this has any bearing on our KENNEDY lines but I'll put it down in case: a John KENNERLY came to Brazil in 1871 from Mississippi; his wife was Elizabeth Heatherwick. They also lived in Santa Barbara, S.P.

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FOREWORD

From its Irish immigrant heritage to the achievement of the American dream, the Kennedy story is a colorful patchwork touching all of us in the human family. We are pleased to share a sample of this special family's history with you — may it provide inspiration as you seek your own roots.

This edition of *The Kennedy Family History* was prepared with an IBM personal computer and Hewlett-Packard LaserJet⁺ printer using COMMSOFT's *ROOTS II*, version 2, software. You will encounter a variety of genealogical charts as you explore this book.

The *Pedigree Chart*, perhaps the most common of all genealogical charts, traces the ancestors of a specified person in diagram form. The *Ahnentafel Chart* lists the same ancestors as a Pedigree Chart, using a text format rather than the familiar sideways tree diagram. The *Descendant Chart* starts with an early ancestor and shows all direct descendants and their spouses. The *Family Group Sheet* provides the most detail about the mother, father, and children in a family unit. The Family Group Sheet includes source documentation (critical for an accurate genealogy) and biographical text containing historical information and anecdotes which breathe life into the family story. A *Calendar* provides a day-to-day reminder of important family events throughout the year. *Subject, Marriage, and Source Listings* give the genealogist an opportunity to create custom lists of sorted names, dates, and places. A computer's power is especially useful for compiling statistics. The *Heredity Statistics* chart provides a statistical summary of a family line, including average ages at important events. No genealogical book would be complete without an *Index*, which alphabetically lists all names in the book as well as the page numbers where those names may be found.

All of the charts, text and lists in *The Kennedy Family History*, including the page numbers and Index, were printed automatically with *ROOTS II*. The appearance and information content of the charts can vary widely depending on your own needs, preferences, and printer you are using — the charts in this book are designed to be representative of those you can produce using your own family data.

We hope you will enjoy *The Kennedy Family History* as much as we have enjoyed preparing it.

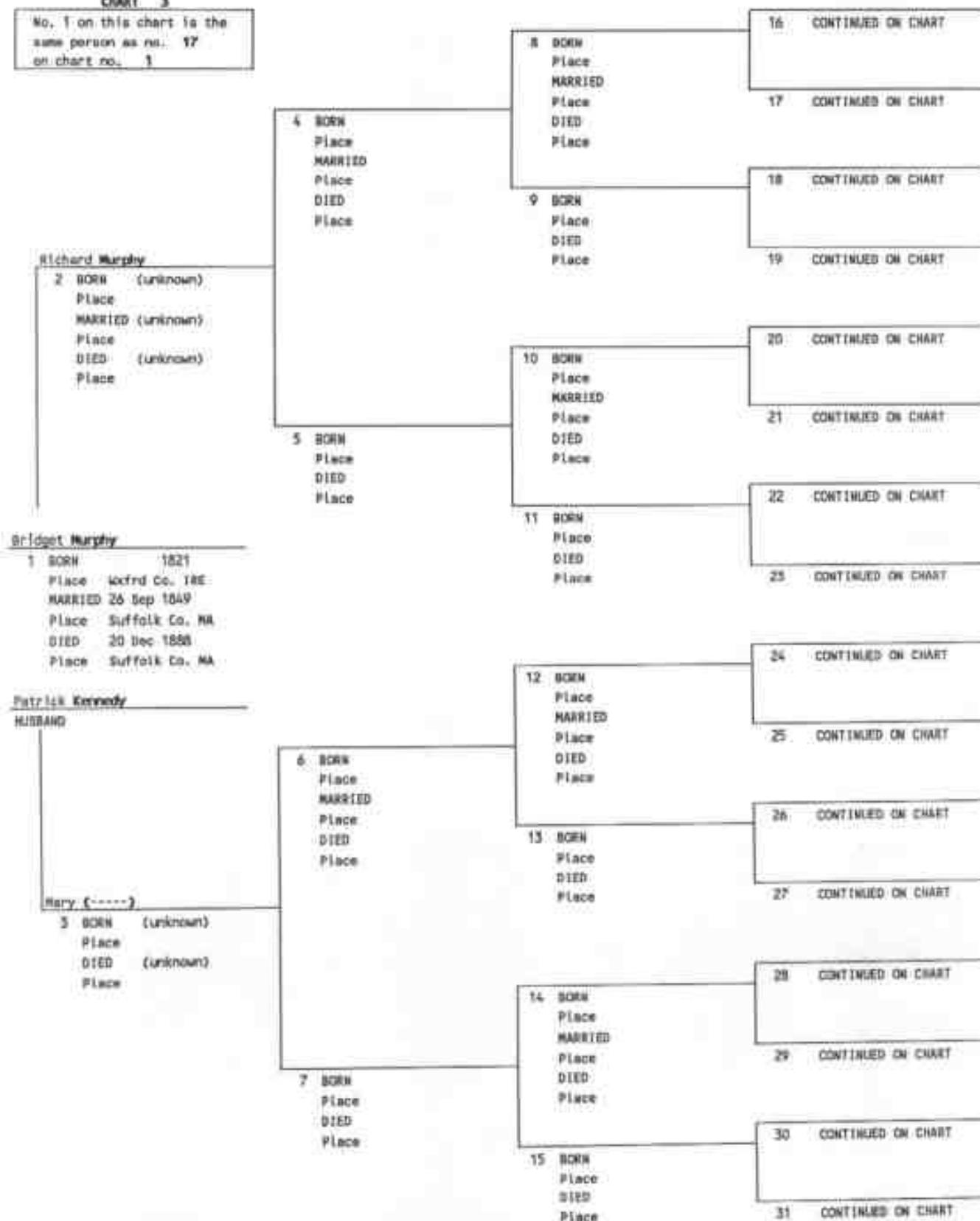

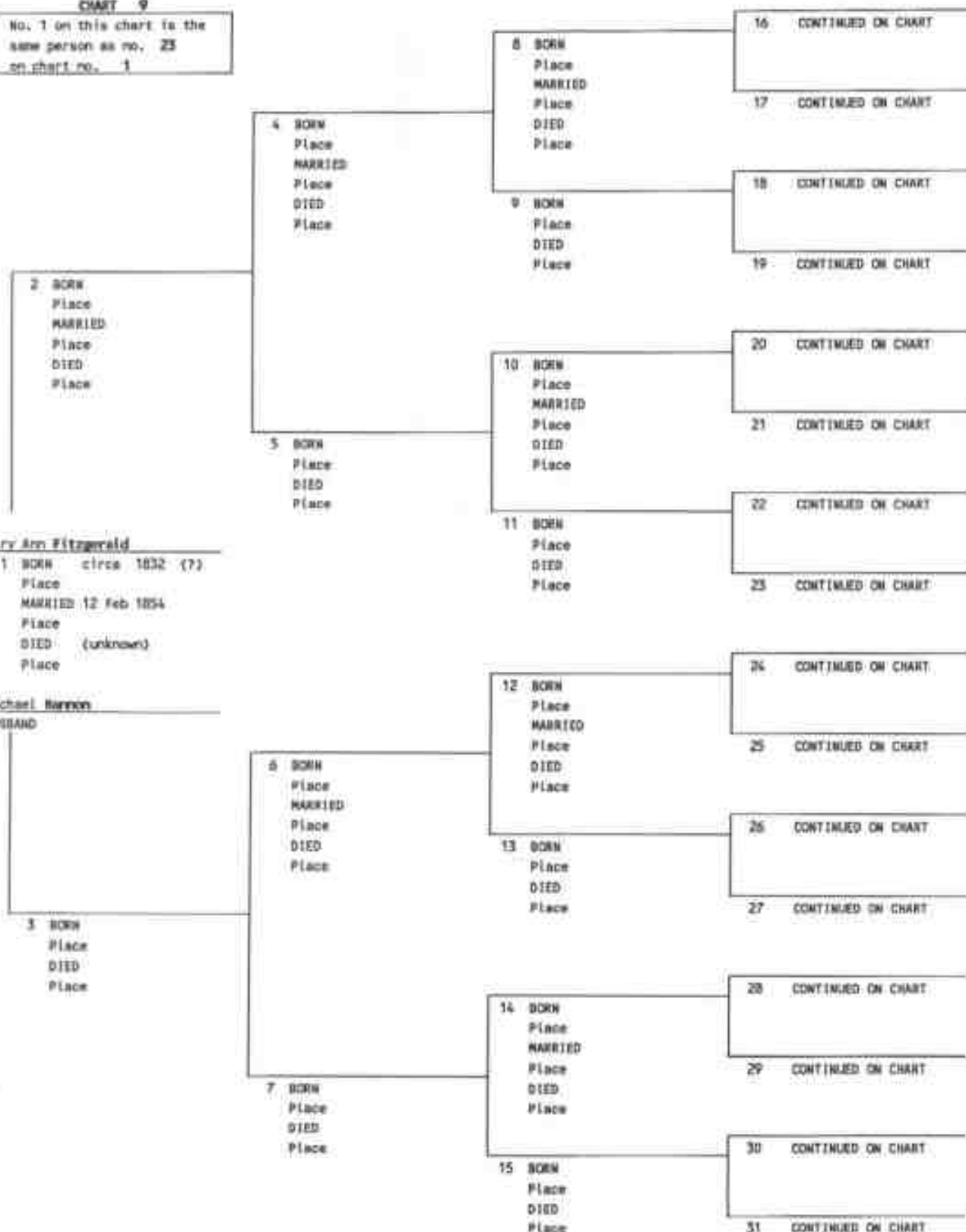

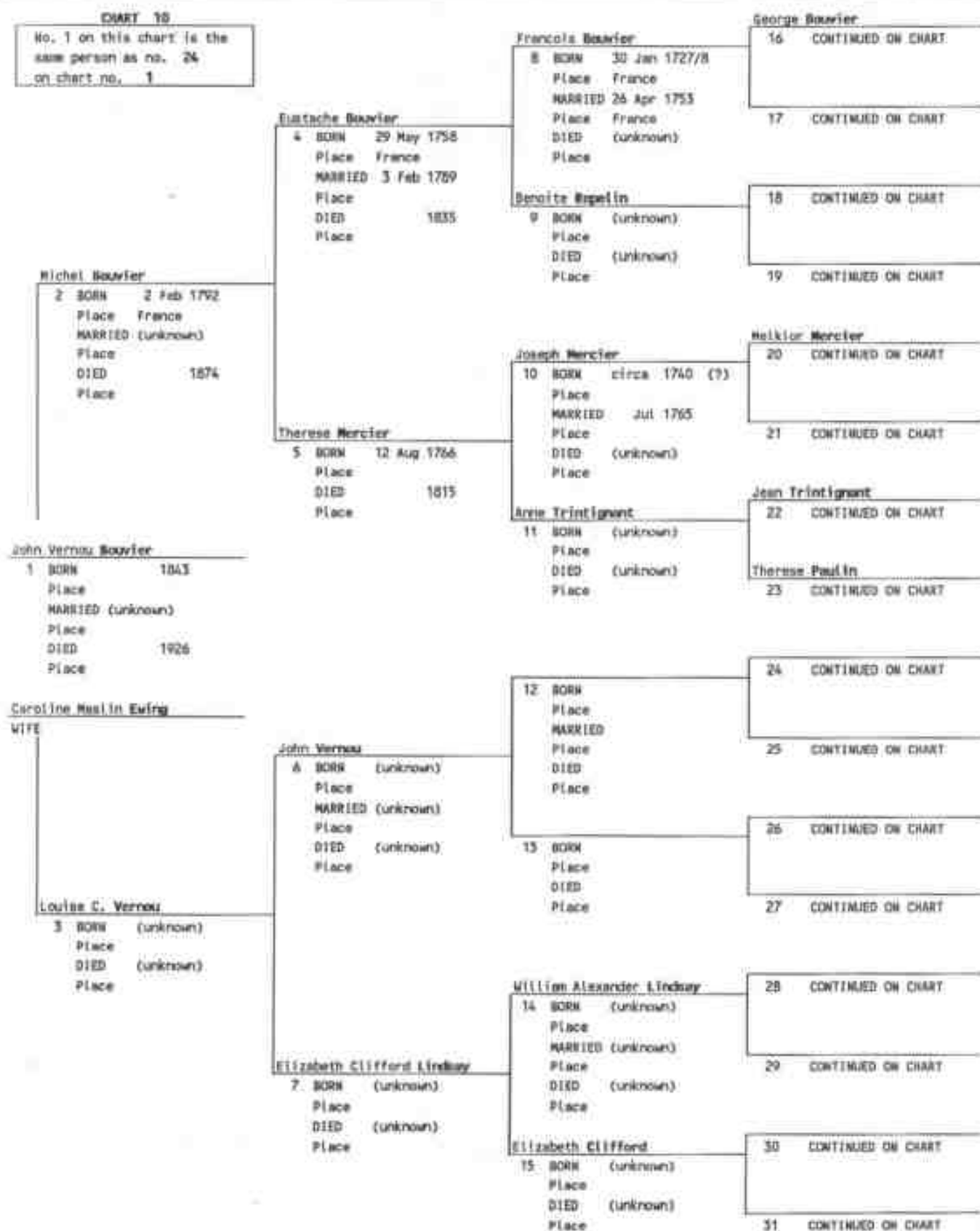

Born in 1888, the grandson of an Irish immigrant, Joseph Patrick Kennedy had enormous drive and ambition to acquire both fame and fortune. He attended parochial school and Boston Latin School and went on to graduate from Harvard University. He was extremely athletic and excelled at football, basketball and particularly baseball.

By the age of 25, he had become the youngest president of a bank in the U.S., the Columbia Trust Company in East Boston. His often cited goal was to be a millionaire by the age of 35, a goal he achieved many times over. He engaged in a variety of financial enterprises including real estate, the stock market, banking and motion pictures.

Kennedy had accumulated enough wealth by 1929 that he was able to establish one million dollar trust funds for each of his children. In the 1930's, already a multi-millionaire, he entered into the political arena. He contributed his support to the Roosevelt campaign in hopes of a cabinet post that never materialized. Roosevelt later appointed him to head the Securities and Exchange Commission in 1934 where he effectively organized a regulatory body to govern the financial community and insure against manipulation and fraudulent trading practices. He headed the Maritime Commission to revitalize the merchant shipping industry and increase foreign trade. Perhaps his most famous appointment was that of ambassador to the Court of St. James. He served from 1937 until November of 1940. After returning to the United States he retired from public service and returned to the business world.

In 1961 he suffered a debilitating stroke followed by relapses and heart attacks that left him virtually incapacitated. He died in 1969 and is buried in Holyhood Cemetary in Brookline, Mass.

John F. Kennedy, the 35th President of the United States, was born the second son to Joseph P. Kennedy. John was personable and fun-loving as a child, but with an inherent competitiveness and singleness of purpose dominating his personality.

Jack, as his family called him, went to elementary schools in Brookline, Massachusetts, and Riverdale, New York. At age 13 he entered Canterbury School in New Milford, Connecticut where he stayed for one year. Jack graduated "most likely to succeed" from Choate Academy in Wallingford, Connecticut, in 1935.

Jack entered Princeton University in the fall of 1935, but he had to leave after Christmas due to illness. He entered Harvard University in 1936 where he majored in government and international relations. Kennedy graduated cum laude in 1940 and then enrolled in the business school at Stanford University.

After dropping out of business school, Jack enlisted as a seaman in the United States Navy. The Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, prompted him to volunteer for sea duty. He was assigned to a patrol boat squadron late in 1942. On August 2, 1943, a Japanese destroyer cut his boat in two. Jack's heroic efforts to save his crew won him the Navy and Marine Corps Medal and the Purple Heart.

The eldest Kennedy son, Joseph, had been destined for a political career, but he had been killed during World War II in 1944. John had been headed for a career in literature and journalism when the family's political ambition was transferred to him.

Jack's political career was launched in 1946 when he ran for the U.S. House of

Representatives for the 11th Congressional District of Massachusetts. His easy defeat of an Republican opponent set the pattern for future political victories. He was re-elected to the House in 1948 and 1950.

In April, 1952, Kennedy set his sights on the Senate by announcing that he would go after the seat held by the popular Henry Cabot Lodge, Jr. Even though the Republicans, under the leadership of Dwight D. Eisenhower, carried Massachusetts, Kennedy upset Lodge by a wide margin.

Senator Kennedy at first concentrated on issues of interest in New England and then served on the Senate Labor Committee, and the Government Operations Committee. His efforts for the labor committee included the famous verbal battles with James R. "Jimmy" Hoffa, head of the teamsters' union.

Jack's entry into presidential politics started in June, 1956, when there was a movement to nominate him for Vice-President with the former Governor Adlai E. Stevenson of Illinois. Kennedy lost the bid to Senator Estes Kefauver of Tennessee, although the race was close. This near defeat spurred him to start campaigning for the presidential nomination for the 1960 election. In 1958, Kennedy easily won a new term in the Senate.

The 1960 presidential election was hard fought, and Kennedy defeated Richard M. Nixon by fewer than 120,000 popular votes. It was during this campaign that Jack first referred to the "New Frontier" to emphasize his belief that the United States had lost ground to Russia in the Cold War. Kennedy was inaugurated President on January 20, 1961.

During Kennedy's brief tenure in the White House there were many important world events that have shaped the course of history. On April 12, 1961, cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin was the first man to fly in space. From April 17 to 20, 1961, Fidel Castro crushed an invasion of Cuban exiles in what became known as "The Bay of Pigs." On May 5, Alan B. Shepard, Jr., made the United State's first suborbital flight. Also in 1961 the Berlin Wall was erected, and Dag Hammarskjold, United Nations Secretary-General died in a plane crash. On February 20, 1962, John Glenn, Jr., became the first American to orbit the earth. Algeria gained its independence from France after a long battle. The Cuban crisis in October, 1962 brought the US and Russia close to the brink of war. In 1963, Pope John XXIII died and Pope Paul VI succeeded him. In South Vietnam, military officers overthrew and killed President Ngo Dinh Diem.

President Kennedy's accomplishments while he was in the White House are many. In 1961, he established the Peace Corps. The 23rd Amendment to the Constitution gave residents in the District of Columbia the right to vote. In 1962 and 1963 the Supreme Court ruled that the reading of the Bible and prayers in public schools were unconstitutional. Kennedy was effective in disarmament talks, foreign affairs and domestic concerns.

On November 22, 1963, John F. Kennedy was shot to death by Lee Harvey Oswald in Dallas, Texas.

Robert F. Kennedy has been described as being shy as a child and as a man. He was intense and introverted with a black-and-white philosophy of life. Things, ideas and people were either good or evil and his purpose was to expiate the evil. He was very religious and at one point considered entering the priesthood. He graduated from Harvard University and the University of Virginia Law School.

After graduation he worked for McCarthy's subcommittee on internal security and then for the committee of inquiry into racketeering and corruption in the labor movement. It was based on these hearings that he wrote his book The Enemy Within on union corruption.

Bobby was actively involved in Jack's political career and played an

instrumental part in his presidential election. Jack appointed him Attorney General despite adverse public reaction. He presided over the Department of Justice for 44 months, gaining respect as he dealt firmly with civil rights and labor issues. He was responsible for gathering the evidence that led to the conviction of the head of the Teamster Union, James R. Hoffa.

After JFK's assassination Bobby became the head of the Kennedy clan and the inheritor of the Kennedy legacy. Elected to the Senate from New York in 1964, he used that office to gear up for a 1968 presidential bid. He became the champion of the dispossessed and tried to forge a coalition of the young, the poor, blacks and intellectuals.

On March 16, 1968, Bobby announced his candidacy for the presidency. By June 4 he had won five out of six presidential primaries, including the California race. Shortly after midnight on June 5 in Los Angeles, Bobby was fatally wounded by Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, an Arab immigrant.

KENNEM32.TXT:

Edward M. Kennedy is the youngest and only surviving Kennedy brother. He attended Milton Academy and graduated from Harvard University in 1956 after serving in the army. He received a law degree from the University of Virginia and then worked for JFK's campaign. In 1962, at age 30, he won the Massachusetts Senate seat once held by his brother, John. With one brother the President and the other the Attorney General, Teddy's political future seemed assured.

After Bobby's assassination in 1968, Teddy became a substitute father to Bobby's children. He became the focal point of the Kennedy family and the one to carry on the political legacy. The Chappaquiddick Island incident in 1969 resulting in the death of Mary Jo Kopechne marked the end of his presidential possibilities for the 1972 election. It was not until 1979 that he returned to the presidential arena, announcing his candidacy for the 1980 race.
