BARENT JACOBS(Z)EN KOOL¹ (Marretje Leenderts de Grauw)

APPOLONIA BARENTS² (WILLEM ISAACSEN VAN VREDENBURGH)

BARENT JACOBS(Z)EN KOOL¹ b c 1605-1610; bp 18 May 1610 Nieuwe Kirk, Amsterdam, Holland; d 1676, NY; m c 1637/8, Flushing, NY, MARRETJE LEENDERTS (living at least until 1668) d/o Leendert de GRAU(W). He may have come to New Netherland with Peter Minuet; was there in 1626. On 8 Jun 1633 he, with five others besides Commissioner Van Cuyler, signed a treaty with the Sachem of Wapoyquart or Tattocpam, Chief of the Sickenames River and owner of the Fresh River of New Netherland. It was an agreement for the purchase of lands in what the Indians called Connettecuck. The tract purchased was Sickajook (now Hartford, CT), a plot extending about one league down along the river and one-third of a league in width to the high land and beyond the hill upwards. Consideration was "one piece of duffels 27 ells long, six axes, six kettles, 18 knives, one sword blade, one shears, and some toys." He was an officer of the West India Co.; was Capt. of a ship in the company's service. In 1654 he was appointed one of the excisemen whose official duty was to guard the wine and beer trade against fraud. He was enrolled a Burgher in New Amsterdam 14 Apr 1657. He signed the oath of allegiance to the English in 1664. In 1665 he lived on Bridge Street (Brugh Straat). In 1671 he acted as sponsor for a grandson. He may have been the Varant Coll who took the oath of allegiance in Ulster Co. in 1689. He was usually called Barent Jacobsen.
