# FOREWORD

The purpose of this compilation of cousins is to generate reactions to the information that I have included. I would very much welcome corrections and additions to the data, for inclusion in a future volume on the Milleman Family. Biographical information is especially desired, to add color and depth to the raw facts of birth, marriage and death. I plan to include family stories like the ones in the first generation, as well as information on education, military service, occupation, interests and hobbies, travel, publications, and other accomplishments, Also, if you have information on the spouse's ancestry back to the immigrant to this country, please send that to me, but only if the ancestry is known back to the immigrant. For example, ancestral information for Edna Grayum Koontz and Charles Austin is included, but not for Walter Robinson since the Robinson ancestry is not known back to the immigrant, although goodness knows not for lack of effort.

The numbering system used in this paper is known as the "Modified Register" system, which uses three types of numbers: a bold arabic number [3] to uniquely identify each individual, a small superscript [<sup>3</sup>] to indicate the generation into which that person falls, and a small roman numeral [iii.] to denote his or her birth order within the nuclear family. Each descendant is assigned a number, whether or not that child is known to have left progeny. Adult children who are not carried forward, for one reason or another, may be discussed where they appear as a child, although in most cases in this paper they are carried forward if there was more than a line or two of additional information. For purposes of this paper, William Henry Koontz was considered to be #1. The Milleman Genealogy will follow the descendants of Aaron Milleman, in which case Emily Mary Ames will be in Generation 7, her children Generation 8, and so forth.

Many thanks go to family members who contributed information on their branches of the family. I have tried to indicate who supplied the information for which family. Probably the most thanks should go to my grandmother, Edna (Grayum) Koontz, whose work inspired me to begin this project, as well as to my mother, Dorothy (Koontz) Robinson and Aunt Irene (Koontz) Reid, both of whom furnished me with compiled family stories and histories. Thanks, too, go to all the family members I cornered at weddings, funerals, and picnics, asking impertinent and nosy questions. With very few exceptions, they were patient with me and they have my great appreciation. And finally, thanks and appreciation to my husband, who accompanied me to cemeteries, paid the phone bills without complaint, and in general put up with me.

William Henry Koontz was a farmer. Henry<sup>4</sup> (Frances Rodecap' Lydia Myers' Barbara Wine' Michael<sup>2</sup> Georg') was descended from Johann Georg Wine who came on the ship 'Elliot' from Rotterdam, landing in Philadelphia in 1749. The family settled in Pennsylvania and later moved to Shenandoah Co., VA, near Forestville, in 1785. The family were members of the Church of the Brethren. Shortly after 1880, William Henry Koontz moved to Nebraska with his parents, brother and four sisters, where he met Emily Mary Ames. He and Emma eloped because Emma was not allowed to see him; his family was a little too earthy for Harriet Milleman Ames. Harriet said that Mrs. Koontz talked too plain in front of children. After their marriage they lived in Nebraska for five years, then homesteaded in Oklaboma shortly after the land rush in 1890, following the lead of Manny and Addie (Ames) Zegafuse who had moved there the year before. They had been living there for three years when a prairie fire came close to their home and the whole family had to fight it. Little Earl William who was seven years old at the time inhaled too much smoke and died shortly thereafter. Emma pined after his death, and it was decided that she should return to Nebraska for a visit with the family there. She took the four remaining children with her, making the trip north with Mack and Eliza Bonnie (Ames) Mason. After three months she was ready to return to the farm in Oklahoma even though it was winter by then and there was no one available to travel with her. She was determined to go, and she made the 400-mile trip by herself in a covered wagon with the four children-Jesse was 8, Charlie 5, Hattie 3, and Ella, 10 months. The trip took two weeks. She stayed with families along the way as she was afraid to stay in the towns. Harriet gave her \$5.00 which she used for feed for the mules. She carried food for the family (salt pork and tea) and they slept in the wagon. She had to cope with snowstorms, guicksand, loneliness, and hard work, but she made it and got home to Henry shortly after Christmas, 1894.

They lived in Oklahoma until about 1916, but felt that life would be better in Colorado. Malaria was a problem in Oklahoma at that time, and the farms weren't doing well. Word was that work was available on the railroad in Colorado. Many of the family moved to Alamosa, in the San Luis Valley. They stayed there until the early 30's, and then began to move to California family by family. Lola's family stayed in Colorado, and a few of the others, but most

of the family now live in Southern California.

The Koontzes were a fun-loving family and closeknit. They loved to play jokes on each other. Whenever the family gathered there was music. Those who couldn't play an instrument could sing, and they had great times. Emma was remembered as a warm and loving grandmother by all her grandchildren, and she made them all feel special. Marjorie Curtis remembers how horrified Emma was that she (Marjorie) was going to Japan with her two little boys, and said that she was just the bravest person ever, to go so far over the water.

She didn't tolerate any foolishness, though. One time she found out that Ralph and Charlie had begun hanging out at the pool hall in Alamosa (they were both grown men and married by then). So she marched in and sat herself down, saying that she wanted to see what it was all about. The 'boys' put down their cues and slunk home!

Emma could always laugh whether the joke was on her or someone else. Once she was trying to load some hogs to take to town and sell. She was wearing a big denim skirt and tried to head off a hog who headed right for her spraddled legs, and she fell across his back and took a real piggy back ride for awhile. She was born 6 Mar 1892, in Edmond, Oklaboma, OK, the daughter of Henry Samuel Stahl and Rose Ann Stanbrough. Mary Stahl was known to their grandchildren as "Grandma Whatsit" because of her propensity to marry. After her divorce from Jesse, she married 2) Ellsworth Nickerson, 3) John Keene, 4) Frank Westbrock, 5) Joe Dickman, 6) Clifford Sutton, and 7) Jeff Brooks. Mary died 25 Apr 1972, in Sanford, Conejos, CO. Jesse was a farmer and mechanic.

Chartie was greatly loved by all his family. He was a quiet man who enjoyed traveling, his family, and working in the orchard. He grew up on a farm in Nebraska on the Nemaha-Richardson county line. The family moved to Oklahoma about 1900, and he attended Normal School in Edmond where he met Edna Grayum. Later he worked on the railroad, usually as a brakeman but also as a conductor until they discovered that he was colorblind. About 1945 Chartie and Edna bought an avocado orchard in La Habra with Jim and Irene (Koontz) Reid, and built two houses on top of the hill. The grandchildren all remember "The Ranch" with great foodness. One of Charlie's greatest pleasures was having all of the family over for week-end breakfasts, which he cooked on the grill on the patio.

Edna was one of identical twin girls. Edna" Grayum (Charles William<sup>2</sup> William<sup>3</sup> Joseph<sup>3</sup> John<sup>3</sup> Joseph<sup>3</sup>) was descended from Joseph Graham who came to the United States about the time of the Freech and Indian War, probably from Ireland. Her mother was a teacher, and her father was a pharmacist, but had had to leave his profession when the fames of the prescriptions (which he had to prepare himself) caused his health to fail. At that time the family moved to a farm in rural Gallis County, Ohio. She was raised there until she was 12, when the decision was made to move to Oklahoma where the land was better, and it might be possible for the children to attend school regularly and even go to college. When they first arrived in Oklahoma, they farmed on the shares, and the children sarned money picking cotton. Her father became a rural mail carrier, and earned enough money to buy a farm and then send the children to Normal School. After Normal School, Edna taught school for two years before they were able to marry. After their marriage they stayed in Jones, OK, near the family for several years, but after other members of the family

moved to Colorado, they followed to Alamosa, where Charlie got work on the railroad. In 1930 they moved on to California, staying with Lester and Alice Koontz until they could get a place of their own.

During the Depression, times were hard for the Koontzs, just as for everyone else. Everyone in the family who was old enough worked. When times got better everyone in the family who wasted to, went to college. After all the children left home, Edna occupied her time taking creative writing classes and researching the family genealogy. She wrote many of the family traditions in story form as well as attempting some novel-length works. Her stories of her own childhood and the story she wrote about Emma (Ames) Koontz's journey are treasured by the family. Charles died 1 Feb 1963, in Yuma, Yuma, AZ, and was buried in Whittier, Los Angeles, CA, Rose Hills. Edna died 9 Jul 1971, in Downey, Los Angeles, CA, and was buried in Whittier, Los Angeles, CA, Rose Hills.

Ray was a railroad conductor for many years. After his retirement, one of his greatest pleasures was to be Santa Claus for one of the local department stores. He also was Santa for numerous family gatherings, and dearly loved to talk with the little children.

Ray's mother died when he was twelve years old, and he was deeply affected by her death. He never stopped missing her. He and his brother and sister were raised by his grandmother Harriet Milleman Ames and Aunt Addie Zegafuse, who moved into the home when his mother died.

He loved to joke and play games. He was an affectionate man and always greeted his children and grandchildren, as well as nieces and nephews, with a big hug. Ella was raised in Oklahoma on the Koontz homestead, and although she and Ray were first coosins they don't remember getting acquainted until they were over twenty years old. When they did, it wasn't long before they decided to get married. They waited several years, and when they did get married, they kept it a secret for several months.

They lived in Nebraska for a year or so, then moved to Colorado in 1918 when many other members of the family moved there, and Ray found work on the railroad. They moved to California in the 1940's.

Ella and Ray were loving parents and always the favorite aunt and uncle of their nieces and nephews. Ella died 7

When Irms was four years old the family moved to Alamosa, Colorado. They lived there for 10 years, then came to Los Angeles, California. She entered Bell High School in 1928, and met Jim Reid in Latin class. They graduated in 1931. It was during the Great Depression, and there were no jobs, and they went to UCLA-Renie worked for her room and board, and went there for one year. Jim could only afford one semester, then they took whatever jobs they could in order to help their families. Renie got a part time job as a janitor in a grammar school, and Jim started as a messenger in the Farmers and Merchants National Bank. He was 17 years old.

Their only child, Kathleen, was born handicapped-she was totally deaf and partially blind.

In 1945 they went into partnership with Charlie and Edna Koontz and bought ten acres of avocados on a hillop in La Habra. Charlie and Jim built what was later to be a four-car garage, and they all moved into it on January 1, 1945, when it barely had the windows and doors. The inside was unfinished, and the heat all went up to the rafters. It was

during World War II. There was a gas meter on top of the hill, but because of government priorities, they could not get electricity. They managed to get a war surplus generator which would run for four hours on one filling of gasoline, and because they were farmers, they could get gasoline ration tickets for the generator. So they had candles and coal oil lamps and gas lights. Fortunately, Edna had an Electrolux refrigerator which operated on gas, so they had refrigeration, but when the generator started sputtering, it was bed time.

In 1950 Jim and Renie built part of their house and moved into it. In 1956 Jim was made Vice President of the bank, and had 45 years of service when he retired in 1977. Renie worked for the Santa Fe Railroad from 1939 until 1976. When she retired in 1976 she was Assistant Treasurer of Santa Fe Land Improvement Company.

Jim enjoys fishing, and he is also interested in the history of Los Angeles. He worked with many of the members of the early Los Angeles families, and can tell many stories about them. Irene has become a computer buff, and spends many happy hours with spread sheets, cooking programs, and is putting together a history of the family and writing her memoirs.

Dorothy was born in a little house in what is now a suburb of Oklahoma City but what was then a little farm town on the plains. She moved to Alamosa, CO when she was three years old and lived there among her sunts, uncles and cousins until they began hearing from Lester Koontz in Los Angeles that times were better there and work was available. They moved to California in 1928 and Dot attended Bell High School where she met Walter Robinson in a chemistry class. They went together for four years, until Walter found employment and they could marry. After high school graduation she attended the University of Southern California for a year on scholarship, then found clerical work with the Los Angeles City Schools to help support her family.

Walter was born in Texas, but the family moved to California in 1920 after losing several family members including his little brother, in the flu epidemic. His father, who was employed by the post office in Ft. Worth, transferred to the Los Angeles Post Office, and they built a house in Maywood.

Walter graduated from high school at the age of fifteen and attended Los Angeles Junior College for a year before transferring to Whittier College, majoring in engineering. However, the depression was at its height at the time and he had to drop out to go to work.

He worked for the Civilian Conservation Corps and the U.S. Forest Service, serving as a fire lookout on Grassy Mountain, where he and Dot spent their honeymoon in the lookout tower. Soon after, he found employment with the U.S. Postal Service, first as a clerk, then with the Railway Mail Service, on trains between Los Angeles and San Francisco. He and Dot bought a small house in Los Angeles, acquired a housekeeper to care for Carol, and Dot continued to work for the school department.

When World War II started, Walter was appointed as a Post Office Inspector and was sent first to San Francisco, then Sacramento, Tucson, Phoenix, and finally back to Southern California in 1946. The family struggled to find housing in the war years, and lived in some interesting places including a public housing project and (in Tucson) a converted chicken house.

In 1947 Walter transferred back to the Railway Mail when he was offered a post in Honolulu, serving the Territory of Hawaii and the Trust Territories of the Pacific. From 1947 to 1949, Walter traveled all over the Pacific, an aspect of the job that he enjoyed immensely. In those days mail was carried mainly by ship and only occasionally by air, and part of his job was to inaugurate new air routes. Dot worked at the time for the Credit Bureau of Hawaii. The family enjoyed Hawaii, especially the many different cultures and the opportunity to sample each one and observe the different life styles and customs.

In 1949 Walter transferred back to the Inspection Service and was posted to Missoula, Montana, and the family

reluctantly left the Paradise of the Pacific for an isolated town in the Rockies, experiencing culture shock in addition to climatic shock, arriving in Missoula in January without winter clothing.

The Missoula territory included assignments in Alaska, and Walter spent the summer of 1951 inspecting post offices in Alaska. He often flew with bush pilots into remote Arctic towns, and the family enjoyed his letters and the copies of the "Mukluk Telegraph" (published at Kotzebue), which he sent home, as well as his endless slides of the Brooks Range. Meanwhile Dot went to work for the U.S. Forest Service, which in that area serviced the Smokejumpers and the Remount Stations.

1952 found the family on the move again, to Seattle, Washington, this time. Dot found work with General Services Administration in their accounting department and began to take accounting classes to further her career. Walt transferred to the Real Estate department of the Post Office, and began negotiating for leases and post office sites. Later he transferred to the Portland office for several years, returning to Seattle in 1961, and finally to San Francisco in 1965, where he was in charge of Real Estate for the west coast states, Alaska, and the Pacific Islands. Meanwhile Dot was moving up in GSA, finally managing her own section of Accounts Payable clerks. They retired in 1972 and moved to Rancho Bernardo, in northern San Diego County.

After formal retirement, Walt spent 15 years as a consultant to the Postal Service, Corps of Engineers, GSA and other agencies, writing manuals, teaching real estate courses, and appraising commercial real estate. Dot accompanied him and assisted with research and accounting, which provided the couple with many interesting trips throughout the west, and to Hawaii and Samoa. They travel extensively, and have visited 69 countries as well as all 50 states. Richard joined the company in 1982, and carried it forward after Walt's full retirement.
