 earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the
 discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general
 Resurrection I shall recover the same again by the mighty power
 of god and as touching such worldly Estate which I have
 please god to bestow upon this my god give devise and bequest
 of the same in the following manner and form
 I give and bequeath to my Son Daniel Lake all and
 Singular my whole Estate of lands tenements and liberties
 privileges hereditaments and appurtenances in the town ship of
 Gravesend in Kings County on the Island of New York or else where
 where any Estate shall be found in my name with him the said
 and assigns for ever to have and to hold all said Estate and
 every of the appurtenances hereditaments in any way appertaining
 unto my said son Daniel Lake his heirs and assigns for ever to the
 sole and only proper use benefit and behoof of my said son
 Daniel Lake his heirs and assigns for ever by their presents
 and in consideration of the above said Estate my said son Daniel
 Lake shall pay to my four then Children my daughter John Lake
 Thomas Lake Nicholas Lake and to my daughter in law now the
 wife of Constant van Fishden the following legacies to wit
 my son Daniel Lake shall give and pay to my daughter John Lake
 or to her heirs the full and just sum of one hundred & ten
 pounds Current money of new york within one year after my
 decease and also my son Daniel Lake shall pay or cause to be
 paid to my son Thomas Lake the full and just sum of one hundred
 pounds Current money of new york within two years after my
 decease and also my son Nicholas Lake shall hold and truly pay
 or cause to be paid to my son Nicholas one hundred pounds Current
 money of new york within three years after my decease and also
 my son Daniel Lake shall hold and truly pay or cause to be paid
 unto my daughter in law now the wife Constant van Fishden or to her
 heirs the full and just sum of seventy pounds Current money of



of New York within four years after my decease and I give
 to my said daughter like a negro boy named Frank and Luchoy
 and three cows or waggons and a plough and harness and tubbing
 three mts of fowling and also my gun and I give to my son
 Nicholas a horse or mare and all the rest of my goods
 and Chattels rights good Credits shall after my decease be
 equally among my four children above named except
 my share I give to my son John's share he and his heirs upon
 it and I give further my will and order that my son David's wife
 shall have maintenance and provide for my Lovers wife's mouth
 with necessaries and necessary things of food and Rayment belonging
 to her naturall body or Livelood ^{during} ~~and~~ widowhood but if she
 not remarried during her naturall life and he shall so
 maintain her in his own house but if my said Lovers wife
 shall have no mind to live with my son David's wife then
 my said Lovers wife and my said son David shall agree
 together with the assistance of indifferent men what he shall
 give her for her maintenance when she goes from him but
 if she dies in his care and in his house and bedding then my
 said son shall give her a decent and Christian buriall upon
 his own cost and charge and she Consulate and appoint my
 son Samuel Lake to collect and see execution of this my
 last will and testament and to see that it be duly and lawfully
 performed according to the true intent and substance thereof
 and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and
 every other former testament wills and Legacies bequest and
 donations by me in any way or by any other hand made
 and bequeathed touching and concerning this and no other last
 my last will and testament the which which of I have
 and I do hereby published pronounced
 and declared by the said John Lake
 in the presence of us subscribers
