LALLATHIN FAMILY BIBLE

The following information was written in the family Bible of Johannes and Caroline Lallatin [Lallathin]. It was translated from the original German and the Bible is in the possession of Dorothy 'Jones' Bayes of Sardin, Ohio.

John Lallathin of Balyholz, born February 28, 1817
Caroline Fredricka Nething of Beuren, born July 1, 1823

From Canton of Nurbingen, Kingdom of Wurtemberg [Germany]. We were married on September 13, 1844. Came to this Country March 15, 1847. Came to Baresville, [Hannibal], in Monroe County, Ohio where we soon joined the Methodist Church and were members for many years. In 1867 we moved from there to Lee township, and in 1887 in the West Union Christian Church, under Brother Hartins where we received the Holy Baptism to a new life. May the Lord keep us in his grace till the end. Amen.

There were 13 children born, 7 boys and 6 girls. Of these are 6 living yet. Three boys and four girls died. Fredrick died March 16, 1901. Aged 53 years and 1 month. Michael died August 26, 1888. Age 39 years and 3 months. Caroline died November 29, 1889. Age 27 years and 18 days. Katharine died September 13, 1862. Age 6 years and 10 months.

Hollister Obituaries

Spirit Of Democracy, published Woodsfield, OH, 26, Nov 1867

Died at his residence in Woodsfield, Nov. 15th, 1867, Jeremiah Hollister in the 72d year of his age. One by one are passing away the men who broke for us the forest and for years have been before us the exemplars of those virtues that are calculated to make society better and men happier. Few if any displayed those virtues in a more eminent degree than Judge Hollister, for nearly fifty years he had been a faithful and consistent member of the Methodist Episcopal Church which he loved with most ardent affection. His heart was always touched by the story of suffering and his hands always open to supply the need to the full of his means. A generous charity characterized him through life. Plain and unostentatious in his habits he early won the esteem of all who knew him and died as the good man dies with the love and veneration of an entire community fixed upon him. Oh how many hearts all over the land that he has made to rejoice by his kindly acts will shed bitter tears of sorrow when they hear of his death. He has left us full of years and of honors and gone to join the general assembly and Church of the first-born in Heaven. Farewell aged saint! Farewell faithful follower of the Lamb; the light of thy light still shines upon our pathway and we will try to meet thee in Heaven. H.

6 January 1868
